**RULING NO. #53**

Acting on an Order of Remand following the adoption of a proposed decision by the California Horse Racing Board, Owner **Samuel G. Galeote** who owned **Bowyer**, winner of the second race at The San Joaquin County Fair (Stockton) on September 11, 2015 is suspended sixty (60) days, March 25, 2016 through May 23, 2016 and fined the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a), (b) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Prohibited Substance-Clenbuterol [Class 3]), #1843.1 (Prohibited Medication), #1844 (a) and (e) (6) (Authorized Medication) and #1902 (c) (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **Samuel G. Galeote** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

\*Rule #1532-Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling or license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.
