The following ruling amends HRTH #18, dated May 6, 2006, to include the correct race number and case number:

Acting upon a report from the University of California Davis, an Official Testing Laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #SA00732, taken from the horse "Spectacular Bay", the first place finisher in the fourth race at Santa Anita Race Track on February 18, 2006, tested positive for Clenbuterol (Class III) in excess of permitted levels, it is ordered that "Spectacular Bay" be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race in accordance with the California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$16,800.00) earned by owner Souheil Bisharat and Raed Saleem Bisharat, trainer Gary Stute (\$1,680.00) and jockey Felipe Martinez (\$1,680.00) be returned to the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita Race Track for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize To Be Withheld). Revised order of finish is as follows:

- 1st Who's Kidding Who
- 2nd Harbour Town
- 3rd Daywood
- 4th Modern Viewpoint
- 5th Mysto's

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
