Based on a report from Maddy Laboratories, University of California, Davis, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #SA02506, obtained from the horse SUPER HARMONY, the second place finisher in the first race at Santa Anita Park on January 28, 2007, contained the prohibited drugs Hydroxyzine and Cetirizine (Class III), it is ordered that SUPER HARMONY be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that owner Nick Cafarchia return all purse monies earned in said race (\$5,400.00) to the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita Park for redistribution.

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), neither the parimutuel payout nor the distribution of any parimutuel pool shall be affected.
