RULING #115

TRAINER ADAN FARIAS, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "CHISELLED IN GLORY," SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE EIGHTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FEBRUARY 24, 2008 IS FINED THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)* AND SUSPENDED FIFTEEN (15) DAYS (APRIL 18, 2008 THROUGH MAY 2, 2008) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887 (A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1843 (A) (D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND # 1844(C) (AUTHORIZED MEDICATION – 6TH NSAID VIOLATION).

DURING THE TERM OF SUSPENSION, ALL LICENSES AND LICENSE PRIVILEGES OF ADAN FARIAS ARE SUSPENDED AND PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1528 (JURISDICTION OF STEWARDS), SUBJECT IS DENIED ACCESS TO ALL PREMISES IN THIS JURISDICTION.

*California Horse Racing Board Rule #1532 states that all fines shall be paid to the paymaster of purses within seven (7) days of imposition (04/18/08) or the license of the person upon whom the fine was imposed shall be suspended.
