**RULING # 149**

TRAINER MARIO LOZA WHO STARTED THE HORSE "WHISKEY AND YOU" IN THE ELEVENTH RACE ON OCTOBER 15, 2010, AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE IS FINED TWENTY-FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00)\* AND SUSPENDED FIVE DAYS (DECEMBER 3RD, 4TH, 5TH, 6TH, AND 7TH, 2010) PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1887(A) (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1843 (A&D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) AND # 1844 (C-1) AND (C-2) (MORE THAN ONE APPROVED NSAID - PHENYL BUTAZONE (7.93 UG/ML) AND FLUNIXIN (2,399 UG/ML) ADMINISTERED TO A HORSE ENTERED TO RACE) - CLASS IV - SECOND OFFENSE.

\*California Horse Racing Board Rule #1532 states that all fines shall be paid to the paymaster of purses within seven (7) days of imposition (12/05/2010) or the license of the person upon whom the fine was imposed shall be suspended.
