# OFFICIAL RULING

Acting upon a report from the University of California, Davis Laboratory, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample R35836, obtained from the horse AT A BOY LUTHER, the second place finisher in the fourth race at Hollywood Park Race Track on December 1, 2005, contained the presence of the prohibited drug Scopolamine (Class III), it is ordered that AT A BOY LUTHER be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the owner of AT A BOY LUTHER, JOHN McGARY, return all purse monies earned in said race (\$2,600.00) to the Paymaster of Purses at Hollywood Park Race Track for redistribution.

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), neither the pari-mutuel payout nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.
