ENFORCEMENT UPDATE 9-12-12

SACRAMENTO, CA – This is the California Horse Racing Board's regular update of all complaints and stewards' rulings involving Class 1, 2, and 3 medication violations and other significant matters.

The CHRB filed two complaints against trainer Carla Gaines alleging violation of CHRB Rules 1843 (a) (b) (d) and 1844 (b) (e) (14) pursuant to Rule 1887 after the Maddy Laboratory at UC Davis determined the urine samples collected from two horses in her care, A Little Luckier and Winding Way, both contained testosterone in excess of the authorized decision levels. The University of Florida Racing Laboratory confirmed the excess levels of testosterone in the split samples. Testosterone is a naturally occurring anabolic steroid. These are Class 3 violations. A Little Luckier finished second in the first race at Hollywood Park on July 14, 2012. Winding Way finished first in the fourth race at Del Mar on July 21, 2012. Hearings for Gaines, the disqualifications of the two horses, and the redistribution of the purses are pending.
