NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF LOCATION OF REGULATORY HEARING FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 1688. USE OF RIDING CROP

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(a) of the California Code of Regulations, the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB) is providing notice that the adoption of the proposed amendment of Rule 1688, Use of Riding Crop, will be the subject of a regulatory hearing on **Thursday, May 21, 2020**, or as soon thereafter as the business before the Board will permit, **held via teleconference**, in accordance with Executive Order N-29-20. The proposal to amend Rule 1688, Use of Riding Crop, was originally noticed to the public on April 3, 2020. The proposed amendment was to be heard at the Department of Consumer Affairs, 1625 N.
