SUBJECT: DEFINITION OF ENTRY AS USED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF CHRB RULE 1843.5

The California Horse Racing Board (CHRB or Board) at its March 26th, 2020 regular meeting, has utilized its authority under CHRB Rule 1406 to partially suspend its rule under any condition it may impose. The Board has decided to suspend the definition of “entry” under subsection (a) of 1843.5 under the recently enacted emergency regulation upon the condition that the previous definition of “entry” found in Rule 1843.5 be reinstated. As such, Rule 1843.5(a) will now read:

(a) In this rule, a horse is deemed “entered” in a race 48 hours before post time of the running of the race.

The definition will remain in effect until further action of the Board is taken.
