

CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD
AMENDED NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF
LOCATION OF REGULATORY HEARING
FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF
BOARD RULE 1846.1, VETERINARY RECORDS
FOR HORSES SHIPPING INTO AN INCLOSURE TO
RACE

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(b) of the California Code of Regulations, the California Horse Racing Board is providing notice that the hearing for the proposed adoption of Board Rule 1846.1, Veterinary Records for Horses Shipping into an Inclosure to Race, will be held by teleconference only based on recommendations from the Governor's Office and California public health officials. The telephonic hearing will take place on **April 22, 2020 at 9:30 a.m.**

In accordance with the guidance from Executive Order N-29-20, a physical location will not be provided. Members of the public are strongly encouraged to participate using the teleconference phone number provided below so as to minimize the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the risk of infection during this current state of emergency.

The proposal to amend Board Rule 1846.1 was originally noticed to the public on February 21, 2020. The proposed amendment was originally scheduled to be heard at the Department of Consumer Affairs, 1st Floor Hearing Room at 1625 N Market Blvd on Wednesday, April 22nd, however due to the COVID-19 threat, a physical location will not be provided and the meeting was moved to a teleconference meeting only.
