NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF DATE AND LOCATION  
OF REGULATORY HEARING  
FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF  
RULE 2049. DESIGNATION AND APPROVAL OF HORSEMEN'S WELFARE FUND

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(a) of the California Code of Regulations, the California Horse Racing Board is providing notice that the adoption of the proposed amendment of Rule 2049, Designation and Approval of Horsemen's Welfare Fund, will be the subject of a regulatory hearing on **Wednesday, January 22, 2020, at the Department of Consumer Affairs, 1625 North Market Boulevard, 1st Floor Hearing Room, Sacramento, California**, or as soon thereafter as the business before the Board will permit.

The proposal to amend Rule 2049, Designation and Approval of Horsemen's Welfare Fund, was originally noticed to the public on November 29, 2019. The proposed amendment was to be heard on January 23, 2020, at the Santa Anita Park Race Track, 285 West Huntington Drive, Arcadia, California. However, the date and location of the hearing have been changed to Wednesday, January 22, 2020, at the Department of Consumer Affairs, 1625 North Market Boulevard, 1st Floor Hearing Room, Sacramento, California.
