Thursday's eleven (11) race card drew eighty two (82) entries. No Cal-Bred races were used.

Driver Representative Rocky Stidham came in to represent Driver David Siegel for Saturday's 9th race accident. Stidham stated that Mr. Siegel had

reviewed the race and understood his error. Because of the severity of the incident, the following ruling was issued:

Ruling # 05

Driver David Siegel, who drove "Check Raisin" in the Ninth Race on Saturday, January 08, 2011, is hereby Suspended five (5) racing days, Thursday, January 20, 2011, Friday, January 21, 2011, Saturday, January 22, 2011, Thursday, January 27, 2011 and Friday, January 28, 2011 for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1721(K) (Driving Rules – Drove In a Careless or Reckless Manner) which resulted in an accident.

01/13/11 (2) **Qualifiers**

Seventeen (17) of twenty (20) horses made the grade in today's three (3) qualifying races.

01/13/11 (3) **Fourth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

The inquiry sign was posted to review the stretch drive in which #3 "Maledictorian" (Gary Barbere) went off-stride, finishing sixth (6th). After review, it was determined that #3 failed to lose sufficient ground. #3 was disqualified and placed last (8th) for the violation.

01/14/11 (1) **Second Race – Inquiry/No Change**

The inquiry sign was posted to review two horses going off-stride at the top of the stretch. After review it was determined that #4 "Silver Bloom" (Rick Plano) suffered broken equipment (hobble hanger), which caused him to go off stride in front of #5 "Persuade Me", which caused Driver Lemoyne Svendsen to pull #5 off stride to avoid a collision. #5 finished fourth (4th) ahead of #4, so no disqualification was warranted.

01/14/11 (2) **Fourth Race – Inquiry/No Change**

The inquiry sign was posted to assure fourth (4th) place finisher #6 "Exquisite Gem" (James Kennedy) did not violate the breaking rule while off stride after the start. No violations or interference was detected. No change.
