

COMPLAINT

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Trainer Douglas F. O'Neill, Owner Reddam Racing, LLC & Jockey Armando Ayuso** for violation of CHRB Rule **1859.5 (Horse Disqualification)**. The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **Trainer/Owner/Jockey**, license number **See below**. The offense alleged occurred on or about **May 1, 2022** and is as follows:

The official blood sample #GG40114 taken on May 1, 2022 at Golden Gate Fields was reported by Dr. Ben Moeller, PhD of UC Davis, to contain 3-Hydroxy Lidocaine (180 pg/mL). This sample was obtained from the horse "Worse Read Sanchez" which ran in the 5th race at Golden Gate Fields, finishing 3rd. The trainer of record is Douglas F. O'Neill. A Split Sample request was conducted by Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory which confirmed U.C. Davis' original findings. The presence of 3-Hydroxy Lidocaine in Worse Read Sanchez' system at the time of testing is a Class 2, Penalty Class B violation.
