

COMPLAINT

CASE NUMBER: 16SW0007

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Marissa Tyler** for violation of CHRB Rule **1843(a)(d), 1843.1(b) and 1887(a)**. The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **Trainer**, license number **320133, 11/17**.

The offense alleged occurred on or about **January 17, 2016** and
is as follows:

On January 17, 2016, the horse "Yankee Flyer" ran in the 8th race at Cal Expo finishing 1st. CHRB Official blood sample #CE25937 was taken from "Yankee Flyer" and tested at the UC Davis Maddy Laboratory. The sample was found to contain Cobalt (64.9ng/ml) in excess of 50ng/ml. This drug is a Class 3/Penalty B.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 19420, 19440, and CHRB Rules, the stewards are empowered to impose penalties for violation of any provision of the CHRB Rules. Such penalties may consist of suspension of any license, fines, and exclusion from all racing enclosures under the jurisdiction of the Board or by any combination of these penalties.
