In the Matter of: Driver Gerald Longo

Ruling # 18

Driver Gerald Longo, who drove #7 A MAJOR OMEN in the 4TH race on Friday, February 11, 2022, is hereby fined the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for violating California Horse Racing Board Rule #1721 (j) (commit any act which shall impede the progress of another horse and causing said horse to break stride). While driving A MAJOR OMEN, Mr. Longo did change course during the stretch drive, causing interference by striking the legs of #4 DANCIN LANCE, driven by Luke Plano, causing this horse to break stride. A MAJOR OMEN finished 1st and was placed 7th for the violation.

In the Matter of: Driver James Lackey

Driver James Lackey, who drove #6 ALBERGO HANOVER in the 5th race on Friday, February 11, 2022, at Cal Expo Harness is fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1731 (g). Mr. Lackey did fail to come up into position before the start of the race.
