Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of March 14, 2022, through March 20, 2022.

**Monday**

03/14/2022

**(1) DUTY STEWARD**

**(2) HEARING**

A hearing was held on C.H.R.B. complaint #22LA0044 filed against Trainer Ricardo Guillen for violation of C.H.R.B. rule #1878, having a vet exam before a workout. A decision is forth coming, and if needed, a ruling will be issued.

**(1) CAL-BRED REPORT**

The first race in the book, for two year old California Breds going 220 yards, attracted 4 entries and was used open with 6 horses.

**(2) THE DRAW FOR SATURDAY 03/19/2022**

Entries were light necessitating the box to remain open until Thursday morning. Thursday morning, 8 races were drawn with 52 horses making up 4 Thoroughbred, 1 Quarter Horse and Thoroughbred, and 3 Quarter Horse races. Saturday is highlighted by the first 2 year old race of the year.

The first race in the condition book, for California Bred two year old maidens going 220 yards, attracted 4 entries and was used open with 6 horses.

#6 Terrible Ted (trainer Jesus Uranga) was scratched (Vet-injured) Refund \$1,083.50

9<sup>th</sup> Race #4 Nap Time (trainer Robert Lucas) was scratched (Vet-injured) broke through the gate and was examined by Dr. Becky Fitzgerald and she advised the horse be scratched. Refund \$27,614.38

JOCKEY JUAN E. SANCHEZ IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688 (b)(8) (USE OF RIDING CROP – MORE THAN SIX TIMES DURING THE RUNNING OF THE RACE) WHILE RIDING TEE SHOT IN THE FIFTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MARCH 13, 2022.

**Ruling # 43**

TRAINER RICARDO GUILLEN IS FINED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1878 (b)(1) (WORKOUTS – HORSE NOT EXAMINED BY ATTENDING VETERINARIAN WITHIN 72 HOURS OF WORKOUT).

(6) **INCIDENTS**

A steward's review was conducted for the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> race involving the #4 horse Surprise Party. As was believed by the stewards, the horse dwelt at the start on his own accord. During the running of the 7<sup>th</sup> race, at 30 or so yards before the 1/16 pole, #5 Fastidious (trainer James Glenn, Jr.) lost his action behind and was pulled up, fell on the track, and was vanned off.
