**Report for the Week of Wednesday, June 29, 2022, through Monday, July 4, 2022.**

**WEDNESDAY**6/29/22<sup>1</sup>**ENTRY DAY**

Steward Richard Lewis was on duty today overseeing all racing matters for the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB). Seventy (70) horses were entered today for Saturday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>. Nine (9) races are slated to be contested.

6/29/22<sup>2</sup>**ENTRY PANEL**

Steward Richard Lewis participated in the 'Entry Panel' for Friday, July 1, 2022. He was joined on a 'Zoom Call' by Dr. Tim Grande, Dr. Mark Christin, Dr. Karen Hassan, and Dr. Forrest Franklin.

**THURSDAY**6/30/22<sup>1</sup>**HORSERACING INTEGRITY AND SAFETY ACT (HISA) MEETING**

There were over one hundred (100) participants throughout the country that took part in a 7:00 a.m. (PST) 'Zoom Call' with several members of the Horseracing and Safety Authority. New York Steward Dr. Jennifer Durenberger spoke about the HISA Stewards Handbook. Other speakers included Ann McGovern (HISA Director of Racetrack Safety), John Forgy and Lisa Lazarus, who is the Chief Executive Officer of HISA. Many questions were asked by the national group of Stewards during this call after these

individuals gave their presentation. The meeting lasted one (1) hour and thirty (30) minutes.

**DR. KENNETH ALLISON COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 22SA0054)**

Dr. Ken Allison appeared in the Stewards Office to answer to charges of alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1581.1(b)(2)(C) (Entries) and Rule #1842 (Veterinarian Report). The twenty (20) page complaint in this matter reads as follows:

Veterinarian Kenneth Allison failed to comply with CHRB Rule 1581 (b)(C) and 1842. No veterinary exam was reported to the CHRB Electronic Treatment Reporting System (ETRS) within 72 hours before race entry for the horse "Stanford Bay." The horse was entered in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race on April 8, 2022, at Santa Anita Park.

Steward Will Meyers chaired today's proceedings. CHRB Investigator Noe Longoria presented the complaint he prepared for this tape-recorded hearing. Dr. Allison testified that, in fact, he pre-race examined STANFORD BAY for Trainer Jonathon Wong. Dr. Allison speculated that his Veterinary Assistant forgot to electronically submit the results of that examination to CHRB Veterinarian Forrest Franklin. After deliberating the Stewards contacted Dr. Allison by telephone and issued an 'Official Warning.'

**SERGIO LEDEZMA COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 22GG0102)**

CHRB Supervising (North) Investigator Louis Quezada appeared in the Stewards' Office today and presented his thirty-four (34) page complaint that was filed against Trainer Sergio Ledezma. Alleged rule violations in this case include Rule #1843 (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), Rule #1840 (Veterinary Practices and Treatments Restricted), Rule #1843.1 (A) (Prohibited Drug Substances), Rule #1868 (A)(1) (Authorized Medication During Workouts) and Rule #1887 (A) (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse). Trainer Ledezma was in our office today for this hearing. The cover page of the complaint reads as follows:

The official work blood sample #NC47159 taken at Golden Gate Fields in Berkeley, CA. was reported by U.C. Davis Laboratories to contain 470 ng/mL of Phenylbutazone. The work sample was obtained from the horse "Fairy Tale Bliss" with Sergio Ledezma being the trainer of record. No Split Sample was requested. Phenylbutazone at 470 ng/mL at the time of testing is a Class 4, Penalty Class C violation.

Testimony was given and documents were marked and placed into evidence. Decision to follow.

**SERGIO LEDEZMA RULING (Ref. 6/30/22<sup>3</sup>)**

ACF Ruling #8

Trainer **SERGIO LEDEZMA** who worked the horse **FAIRY TALE BLISS** at Golden Gate Fields on May 29, 2022, is fined Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1868 (Authorized Medication

During Workouts) and Rule #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances – Phenylbutazone 470 NG/ML (Class 4).

The ruling above was issued in a unanimous decision by the Stewards. Trainer Ledezma stated that he gave Phenylbutazone to FAIRY TALE BLISS two (2) days prior to a workout. Hearing testimony indicated that a groom of Trainer Sergio Ledezma's put Phenylbutazone in this horse's feed tub less than two (2) full days before a May 29, 2022, workout.

### **RETIRED INVESTIGATOR**

Former CHRB Supervising Investigator (north) Bob Gai stopped by the Stewards' Office to say "hi" today. Mr. Gai, who worked for the CHRB for twenty (20) years, told us he is enjoying retirement.

### **JOCKEYS ROOM MEETING**

The Stewards' met with the Pleasanton jockey's colony today, which is Day 7 of our thirteen (13) day meeting. This is our second meeting (Ref. 6/17/22<sup>3</sup>) with this group of riding professionals. Today (July 1<sup>st</sup>) we begin enforcement of new statutes (#2282 & 2283) which are HISA Riding Crop Use and penalty guidelines. HISA is the acronym for the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Act. The Stewards also talked about the new riding crop which will be required for usage on August 1, 2022. This new crop will have a smooth foam cylinder without reinforcements or additions. The Stewards' answered all questions and did our best to accurately articulate these new rules.

### **PROSPECTIVE HORSESHOER**

Twenty-one (21) year old Brooks Bonde appeared in the Stewards' office this morning. Mr. Bonde told the Stewards he was interested in taking the Farrier's Test given by the California Horse Racing Board. Some information regarding the testing procedures of this two-portion exam (written and practical) were explained to Mr. Bonde.

### **SECOND RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following this second race which was contested at 5 ½ furlongs. The horses involved in the Inquiry were:

- #4 OUR EXPECTATION – Jockey Assael Espinoza – Original 1<sup>st</sup> place
- #6 MINOSO – Jockey Evin Roman – Original 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- #3 POTENTE ALBA – Jockey Irving Orozco – Original 4<sup>th</sup> place

Approaching the 1/16<sup>th</sup> pole #4 OUR EXPECTATION drifts in and steps directly into the path of #3 POTENTE ALBA forcing Jockey Irving Orozco to steady his horse. (Note: #3 POTENTE ALBA was beaten ½ length for third position). Following this initial incident #4 OUR EXPECTATION continues to drift in and forces #6 MINOSO off his straight path and severely impedes that rival.

The Stewards reviewed all camera angles of the incident, received a Patrol Judge report, and spoke to the three jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision #4 OUR EXPECTATION was disqualified and placed fourth.

### **FIFTH RACE – STEWARDS REVIEW**

Today's fifth race was contested at six (6) furlongs on the main track. In mid-stretch the first-time starter #2 MACHO CHROME (Santos Rivera) had a lead of approximately five lengths. Suddenly, this horse props either due to crowd noise or reacting to the riding crop. This incident significantly slows down the racing action of this horse and what once appeared to be a sure winner ended up being a surprising third place finish. No other horses were involved in this single horse incident and the Stewards did not conduct a formal Inquiry.

### **SEVENTH RACE – INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the start of the Oak Tree Sprint (\$75,000 Guaranteed) which was contested at six (6) furlongs. In this race post time favorite (Odds: 4/5) #1 HOWBEIT stumbled at the start unseating Jockey Evin Roman. A video review showed that this was an incident that only involved #1 HOWBEIT. Second place finisher #8 ULTIMATE BANGO (Catalino Martinez) was forced wide by #1 HOWBEIT as he raced riderless and wide at the ¼ pole. The Stewards made 'No Change' in the order of finish. Both horse and rider were reported to be in good condition after this race.

**IRVING OROZCO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Irving Orozco appeared in the Stewards' Office to review his ride in yesterday's (July 2) first race which was contested at one (1) mile and seventy (70) yards. Of particular interest were the actions of second place finisher #6 KALINE (Irving Orozco).

Today's film review shows #6 KALINE drift out and bump #5 GOVERNOR ARTHUR (Evin Roman) in mid-stretch. Both horses were tipped sideways after the significant contact. #5 GOVERNOR ARTHUR drifted in prior to contact. His culpability in this matter was to a lesser extent. The majority voted for a warning to Jockey Orozco. Steward Baker dissented voting for a three - day suspension.

**ASSAEL ESPINOZA FILM REVIEW (REF. 7/2/22<sup>2</sup>)**

Jockey Assael Espinoza appeared in the Stewards' Office to review his ride in yesterday's (July 2) second race. Jockey Espinoza was aboard #4 OUR EXPECTATION who finished first but was disqualified and placed fourth.

Today's film session shows #4 OUR EXPECTATION drift inward during the stretch drive of this race. This action led to interference to two (2) rivals in this race which led to the subsequent demotion of Jockey Espinoza's mount from first to fourth. Jockey Espinoza felt he made an effort to straighten his mounts errant path but agreed with the Stewards' unanimous assessment that the effort was not strong enough. Jockey Espinoza's most recent riding suspension (3 days) was issued on May 29, 2022 (REF. Golden Gate Fields Ruling #61). In a majority decision (Steward Meyers dissent - five (5) day suspension) the following ruling was issued.

ACF Ruling #9

Jockey **ASSAEL ESPINOZA** who rode **OUR EXPECTATION** in the second race at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on Saturday, July 2, 2022, is suspended four (4) racing days, July 10, 15, 16 and 17, 2022 for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to fourth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

**WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI III FILM REVIEW**

Jockey William Antongeorgi III appeared in the Stewards' Office to review his use of the riding crop in yesterday's (July 2) eighth race. Jockey Antongeorgi rode #2 SHEZAGHOST to a first-place finish in this race.

Today's film review shows Jockey Antongeorgi use his riding crop seven (7) times between the ¼ mile marker to the finish line. Today's informal hearing was our first hearing involving enforcement of the Horseracing and Safety Authority (HISA) Riding Crop Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop). In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

ACF Ruling #10

Jockey **WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI III** who rode **SHEZAGHOST** in the eighth race at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on Saturday, July 2, 2022 is suspended one (1) racing day, July 10, 2022, fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY Dollars (\$250.00) \* and assigned three (3) violation points that will expire on December 3, 2022. For violation of Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop – 7 times) Pursuant to HISA rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3).

**SEVENTH RACE ACCIDENT/INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an accident at the ¼ mile marker. In this race #1 JUNGLE CRY (Brayan Pena) was trailing the field and was in the process of being eased. In a sudden action #1 JUNGLE CRY stumbled, fell, and unseated Jockey Brayan Pena. Jockey Pena was examined by Nurse Practitioner Breena Siliznoff, and it was recommended he be removed from his lone remaining mount of the day. Track Veterinarian Casille Batten examined #1 JUNGLE CRY who eventually walked off the racetrack. No signs of lameness were reported.

Jockey Pedro Terrero appeared in the Stewards' Office this morning to review his ride in yesterday's (July 3) fifth race. Jockey Terrero was aboard #1 ANNIE'S CHIEF who finished fifth in this six (6) horse event. Today's film review shows Jockey Terrero raise his wrist and riding crop up over his helmet during the stretch drive of this race. In a unanimous decision we determined that HISA Rule #2280 (c)(1) was violated and the following ruling was issued.

#### **ACF Ruling #11**

Jockey **PEDRO TERRERO** who rode **ANNIE'S CHIEF** in the fifth race at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on Sunday, July 3, 2022, is fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY Dollars (\$250.00) \* for violation of Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) Rule #2280 (c)(1) (Use of Riding Crop – wrist above helmet).

#### **DAN FRANKO RULING**

We contacted our video production company (Pegasus Communications) to make a graphic stating that #1 GOVENOR'S PARTY would race unshod in the sixth race on July 3. Track Announcer Craig Braddock also publicly notified horseplayers. Trainer Franko was penalized relating to the improper declaration of horseshoes use at the time of entry.

#### **ACF Ruling #12**

Trainer **DAN FRANKO** who started the horse **GOVENOR'S PARTY** in the sixth race at the Alameda County Fair (Pleasanton) on Sunday, July 3, 2022, is fined ONE HUNDRED Dollars (\$100.00) \* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer – failure to conduct business in a proper manner).
