Report for the Week of Monday, August 22, 2022, through Sunday, August 28, 2022

TUESDAY **SCRATCH DAY**08/23/22¹

Steward Luis Jauregui was at work today overseeing scratches and changes for racing on August 25, 2022. Assistant Clerk of Scales Charles McCaul handled the 'scratch board' in the Del Mar backside racing office. All changes were activated after the 10:00 a.m. deadline.

WEDNESDAY **ENTRY DAY**08/24/22¹

Racing Secretary David Jerkens and his staff were on duty today accepting entries for Saturday, August 24, 2022. Ten (10) races were carded with Ninety-One (91) horses scheduled to start. Steward Luis Jauregui is overseeing entries this week.

08/24/22²**SCHEDULED TRAINER THOMAS RAY BELL HEARINGS (CASE NO.22SA0121, CASE NO.22SA0126, CASE NO.22SA0127 & CASE NO. 22SA0154)**

Four (4) hearings were scheduled for today in the Del Mar Stewards' office. These complaints were filed against Trainer Thomas Ray Bell. Stewards Baker and Jauregui were in the office. The cover pages of these complaints read as follows.

CASE NO.22SA0121

Trainer Thomas Ray Bell failed to comply with CHRB Rule #1878-Workouts. On May 26, 2022, the horse 'KRISTI'S TIGER' performed a 5 furlong workout at Santa Anita Park. No veterinary exam was reported into the CHRB Electronic Treatment Reporting System (ETRS) within 72 hours prior to workout in violation of Rule #1878-Workouts.

The alleged rule violation in this case is #1878.

CASE NO. 22SA0126

The official blood sample #NC50742 taken on May 12, 2022, at Santa Anita Park was reported by Ben Moeller, PhD of UC Davis Laboratories to contain Hydroxy Dantrolene (87.) ng/ml). The sample was obtained from the horse 'PAWNEE" who performed a workout on May 12, 2022., to be removed from the from the Vet's List. The trainer of record is Thomas Ray Bell (#07010-12/31/2023). A split sample was not requested. The violation is a Class 4 drug with a Penalty Category C.

The alleged rule violations in this case are #1842.5, #1843, #1843.1 (b), #1843.4, #1844 (d)(1), #1866 (h)(i) & #1887.

CASE NO. 22SA0127

The official blood sample #NC50745 taken on May 19, 2022, at Santa Anita Park was reported by Ben Moeller, PhD of UC Davis Laboratories to contain Hydroxy Dantrolene (40.0 ng/mL). The sample was obtained from the horse 'PAWNEE' who performed a workout on May 19, 2022, to be removed from the Vet's List. The trainer of record Thomas Ray Bell. A split sample was not requested. The violation is a Class 4 drug with a penalty category C.

The alleged rule violations in this case are #1842.5, #1843, #1843.1(b), #1844 (d)(1), #1866 (h)(i) & #1887.

CASE NO. 22SA0154

Trainer Thomas Ray Bell failed to comply with CHRB Rule #1878-Workouts. On June 2, 2022, the horse 'KIRISTI'S TIGER' performed a 5-furlong workout at Santa Anita Park. No veterinary exam was reported into the CHRB Electronic Treatment Reporting System (ETRS) within 72 hours prior to workout in violation of Rule #1878—Workouts.

Yesterday, Tuesday, August 23 CHRB Investigator Garrido sent the Stewards a text message stating that she received an email from Trainer Bell (received Tuesday afternoon). Trainer Bell stated that he had an emergency up in Arcadia, CA and couldn't make the August 24 hearings. This morning (August 24) the Stewards contacted Trainer Bell, who was spotted by Safety Steward David Nuesch at his Del Mar barn. He was asked if he was going to appear at today's hearings. While working at his barn, he said "No" he had an emergency that needed his attention. He was told that a continuance for a hearing should be requested through the Stewards' office and not the Investigator's office. He failed to appear at today's four (4) scheduled hearings. JUAN HERNANDEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Juan Hernandez appeared in the Stewards' office to review his winning ride aboard #7 Kin Cause in the sixth race on Sunday August 21. This race was contested at one (1) mile on the turf. Today's tape recorded film review shows Jockey Hernandez use his riding crop seven (7) times from the ¼ mile marker to the finish. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision, determined that this was a HISA rule violation and issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #29

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey JUAN HERNANDEZ, who rode KING CAUSE in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 21, 2022, is suspended for one (1) day (September 1, 2022) and fined FIVE HUNDRED AND FOUR DOLLARS (\$504.00)* for one (1) strike over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey JUAN HERNANDEZ is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on February 25, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties).

JAMES MARSDEN COMPLAINT (CASE NO.22DM0010)

A hearing was scheduled for yesterday, August 25 for Owner James Marsden alleging a violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). The complaint, prepared by CHRB Investigator Steve Manila, reads as follows:

James Marsden failed to pay K C Horse Transport for services provided. The total amount owed is \$343.75.

Owner Marsden failed to appear at yesterday's hearing. The following ruling was issued in a unanimous decision.

DMTD RULING #30

Owner JAMES MARSDEN, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Race Track on August 25, 2022, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer to charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility- \$343.75 to KC Horse Transport). Suspension to commence on September 2, 2022.

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of James Marsden are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

JOE BRAVO FILM REVIEW

Jockey Joe Bravo appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #1 Kazuhiko (AUS) in yesterday's eighth race. This horse finished fourth in a one (1) mile turf course event. Today's film review shows Jockey Bravo use his riding crop eight (8) times from the ¼ mile marker to the finish. Jockey Bravo was very candid and acknowledged he violated HISA Rule #2282. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #31

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey JOE BRAVO, who rode KAZUHIKO (AUS) in the eighth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 25, 2022, is suspended for one (1) day (September 2, 2022) and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)* for two (2) strikes over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey JOE BRAVO is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on February 26, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – second offense August 11, 2022).

JOSE VALDIVIA JR. FILM REVIEW

Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. appeared in our office to review his actions following the running of the 2nd race yesterday August 26. This race was contested at five (5) furlongs on the turf course. Jockey Valdivia was aboard second place finisher #9 Mi Mimita who drifted in considerably while 'pulling up' just past the finish line. Today's film review shows fifth place finisher #6 Loana (Umberto Rispoli) steady sharply when blocked by #9 Mi Mimita. This leads to contact with fourth place finisher #8 Bye Bye Bugsy (Drayden Van Dyke).

The Stewards all felt that Jockey Valdivia was careless in his actions during the 'gallop out' of this race. Careless riding is addressed in CHRB Rule #1699 (Riding Rules). However, the first five (5) words of this rule read '*During the running of the race:*

The Stewards' unanimously felt a riding suspension was not possible after reading this rule. In a fortunate outcome for Jockey Valdivia, the only action we took was a word of caution to the veteran reinsman.

EIGHTH RACE INQUIRY/ACCIDENT/NON-STARTER

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after Jockey Ramon Vasquez (#8 A Good Law) fell off his horse after not being properly mounted prior to the start of this race. Jockey Vasquez appeared to be getting his right foot into his 'iron' when the field for this race was dispatched. Jockey Vasquez' head struck the side of the starting gate, and he was unseated. Outrider Junior Alferéz captured this loose horse while racing down the backstretch. Jockey Vasquez walked off the track to the Del Mar first aid office. He was reported to be in good condition and will be re-examined tomorrow before being allowed to ride.

The Inquiry sign was posted, and the Stewards conducted a video review of the incident. The Stewards felt that #8 A Good Law did not receive a fair start through no fault of its own. The Stewards, in a unanimous decision declared #8 A Good Law a non-starter as we felt was allowable and necessary per CHRB Rule #1696 (The Start). DMTC Mutual Manager Bill Navarro reported the refund to be in the amount of \$256,968.37.

DR. JOHN 'WADE' BYRD COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 22SA0171)

A twenty-seven (27) page complaint filed against Veterinarian John 'Wade' Byrd was heard today in our office. CHRB Investigator Steve Manila presented the complaint for the CHRB. Official Veterinarian Nolton Pattio appeared as a witness at this tape-recorded hearing. The cover page of this complaint reads as follows.

Veterinarian, Dr. John 'Wade' Byrd submitted late veterinarian reports to the CHRB Electronic Treatment Reporting System (ETRS) for dates May 24, June 21, and June 22, 2022. Veterinary confidential reports are due in the Receiving barn by 10:00 A.M. on the day following treatment(s). On May 28, 2022, Dr. Wade Byrd was advised to submit timely veterinary reports to avoid violations. Dr. Byrd continued to make late entries on June 21 and June 22, an excess of 4-6 days after treatment.

Testimony was given by Dr. Byrd and Dr. Pattio. The Stewards asked several questions, and the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

JAY SLENDER MEETING (REF: 08/26/22(4))

Del Mar Starter Jay Slender appeared in our office today to review the start of yesterday's (August 26) eighth race which was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. The Stewards declared #8 A Good Law a non-starter in this race. The jockey on 'A Good Law', Ramon Vazquez, was not ready for the start of this race as he was attempting to put his right foot in his iron when Starter Slender dispatched the field. Apparently both the jockey, and the assistant starter attending to this horse, did not yell that they weren't ready prior to the start. Hopefully film review such as these will help the quality of all starts going forward.

SECOND RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW

The Stewards conducted a 'Stewards' Review' into the running of the second race which was conducted at 5 ½ furlongs on the main track. Film review of this event shows eighth (last) place finisher #3 Angela's Angel (Kyle Frey) break out and impede #4 Chaokoon (3rd Place), #5 King Zog (5th Place) and #7 Reef City (4th Place). Several horses were hindered, and the Stewards unanimously determined that the interferer finished last, and that no inquiry was necessary.

RUBEN ALVARADO COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 22SA0168)

An informal hearing was held this morning in the Stewards' office. CHRIB Investigator Jean Garrido prepared the paperwork for this matter. The cover page of this complaint reads as follows:

On June 19, 2022, the horse 'ANMER HALL' trained by Ruben Alvarado, was entered into the 8th race at Santa Anita Park as a 3 year old Colt. A pre-race check by the Horse Identifier revealed that the horse was a gelding. The racing program listed 'ANMER HALL' as a 'Dark Brown or Bay Colt'.

Rueben Alvarado told the Stewards that Trainer Peter Miller had originally turned 'Anmer Hall' out at Bonnie Acres Farm (R.K. Mitchell). This horse then was shipped in to Trainer Alvarado at Santa Anita Park. Nobody told Mr. Alvarado about the castration of this horse at Bonnie Acres Farm. Trainer Alvarado told the Stewards he will check new horse arrivals closer when they ship-in from farms. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

DMTD RULING #32

Trainer RUBEN ALVARADO is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) and for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse) for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse ANMER HALL who was scheduled to run in the eighth race at Santa Anita Park on June 19, 2022, which resulted in a late declaration.

THOMAS RAY BELL HEARINGS

Four (4) hearings for Trainer Thomas Ray Bell were originally scheduled for Wednesday August 24, 2022. Trainer Bell did not appear at those hearings.
