**Report for the Week of Monday, August 29, 2022, through Monday, September 5, 2022.****WEDNESDAY**08/31/22<sup>1</sup>**COMPLAINTS WITHDRAWN-CASE 22DM0020, CASE 22DM0011 & CASE 22DM0009**

The three financial complaints filed against owner Thomas Var Reeve (\$1,370.70-KC Horse Transport, Inc.), owner Mersad Metanovich (\$2,848.37 KC Horse Transport, Inc.) and owner Peter Michael Rinato (1208.50-KC Horse Transport, Inc.) were paid in full prior to their hearings and the complaints were withdrawn.

08/31/22<sup>2</sup>**QUINTERO HEARING CASE 22SR0032**

The CHRB filed a complaint against groom Daniel Quintero for alleged violation of CHRB rule 1874 (Disorderly Conduct) for intoxication and a verbal altercation, threatening comments towards San Luis Rey Training Center Security Guard Felimon Alvarado. Representing the CHRB, Investigator Ryan Russell and also in attendance, Mr. Alvarado both were located at San Luis Rey and available by Microsoft Teams, Respondent Quintero joined the Stewards in the Del Mar Stewards' office. After taking into consideration mitigating testimony from Darin Scharer of Winners Foundation and witness Security Guard Felimon Alvarado the majority believed a two hundred dollars fine, a signed testing agreement and evaluation by Winners Foundation was an appropriate penalty. Steward Baker voted for a one week suspension. Ruling to follow.

The CHRB filed a financial complaint (1876) for Southern California Equine Foundation, Inc. against owner Keron Thomas in the amount of \$1,252.93 for services rendered. Mr. Thomas failed to appear for the scheduled hearing, a ruling will be issued.

**STEINER HEARING CASE 22LT0002**

Official Veterinarian Nolton Pattio filed a complaint against trainer Jack Steiner for an alleged violation of CHRB rule 1581.1 (Entries). The report stated there was not a timely veterinarian examination conducted on the horse Warrior's Moon who was entered on July 6 to race in the sixth race on July 9, 2022, at Los Alamitos Race Course. The horse was examined on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 8<sup>th</sup>, but these examinations were not applicable by CHRB rules. The horse was declared from the race. Mr. Steiner was available by telephone for the hearing. Warning.

Ms. Jacobson stated, she, Ms. Garner replied yes two times and went behind the starting gate until it was time to only gallop her horse. Ruling to follow.

examined by attending Veterinarian within 72 hours of workout) on May 26, 2022, and June 2, 2022, at Santa Anita Park.

**BELL II CASES 22SA0126 & 22SA0127(ref 08-24-22<sup>2</sup>/ref 08-28-22<sup>3</sup>)**

Again, the two complaints were combined as the two positives occurred seven days apart. In a majority decision both complaints were dismissed as it was believed without CHRB rule 1868 (d) (Authorized Medication During Workouts) listed on the complaint a penalty was not applicable. Also, CHRB rule 1843.3 (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) defined in CHRB rule 1868 was not listed on the complaint. Steward Baker voted for a five-hundred-dollar penalty for violation of CHRB Rule 1866 (h).

**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW**

Kyle Frey met with the Stewards to discuss the use of his crop in the eighth race yesterday. Jockey Tyler Baze testified on Frey's behalf via telephone, he stated one of

Mr. Frey's seven strikes got tangled up with his crop, Frey stated that particular strike did not make contact with the horse. It was hard to verify one way or another and Mr. Frey received the benefit of the doubt. Warning.

Juan Lopez was summoned to the Stewards' office to discuss the use of his crop in the sixth race yesterday. Upon review it was apparent Mr. Lopez went three times over the limit. He stated he did not know the strikes with the crop turned down counted. He is now aware of the specifics of the rule. His penalty is listed in the following ruling.

#### **DMTD RULING #38**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey JUAN D. LOPEZ, who rode RESPECT THE UNION in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on September 1, 2022, is suspended for one (1) day (September 9, 2022), and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for three (3) strikes over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey JUAN D. LOPEZ is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on March 2, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties).

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA, who rode SQUILLIONS in the ninth race at Del Mar Race Track on September 2, 2022, is suspended for one (1) day (September 10, 2022) and fined TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for one (1) strike over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on March 3, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties- second offense since August 18, 2022).

Following the running the race the inquiry sign was posted to review two incidents soon after the start. Involved were #10 Fun to Dream (J. Hernandez 2<sup>nd</sup>) and #11 Awake At Midnyte (M. Gutierrez 1<sup>st</sup>). Also, jockey Ramon Vasquez who rode #8 Taming the Tigress (5<sup>th</sup>) claimed foul against the outside horses. After a review of the available videos, a report from the Patrol Judge and conversation with both jockeys involved in a unanimous decision pertaining to the first incident #10 was disqualified from second and placed last behind #6 for impeding several horses to his inside. The second incident involved #11 who crossed inward in front of #10 without sufficient clearance. This action did not affect the original placing of #10.

Mario Gutierrez and Juan Hernandez met with the Stewards together to review the tenth race yesterday in which they were both involved in an inquiry, jockey objection and a disqualification. After a review of the race and obtaining everyone's opinion both jockeys received suspension penalties in the following rulings. In a unanimous opinion Mr. Gutierrez was sanctioned for crossing over without sufficient clearance and Mr. Hernandez was penalized for failure to maintain a straight course.

**DMTD RULING #40**

Jockey JUAN HERNANDEZ, who rode FUN TO DREAM in the tenth race at Del Mar Race Track on Sunday, September 4, 2022, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (September 16, 17 and 18, 2022) for failure to maintain a straight course out of the starting gate and causing interference which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from second to ninth place. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

**DMTD RULING #41**

Jockey MARIO GUTIERREZ, who rode AWAKE AT MIDNYTE in the tenth race at Del Mar Race Track on Sunday, September 4, 2022, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (September 16, 17 & 18, 2022) for altering course without sufficient clearance shortly after the start and causing interference.
