ADDED DAY OF RACING

A racing day was added for Friday 01/20/23 to make up for one of the two canceled rain days from the previous week.

A hearing was held on Friday 1/20/23 that was scheduled before the additional racing day was announced, for QUINTIN MILLER on a financial complaint, case #22DM0053. An agreement was reached that both parties were pleased with.

JOCKEYS IN TO ADDRESS INFRACTIONS

Jockey Victor Espinoza's agent Tom Knust was in to address multiple violation points for crop violations and its relationship to his Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA. In speaking with Tom Knust it was determined that one of the past crop violations was not subject to multiple violation points and the latest violation would not trigger an additional suspension.

Jockey LANFRANCO DETTORI was in to address his use of the crop in the fourth race on 1/15/23. Mr. Dettori stated he realized he had violated the rule and would accept the penalty.

Jockeys LANFRANCO DETTORI and MARIO GUTIERREZ were in to discuss the 4th race from 1/15/23. In watching the race the #7 LOW EXPECTATIONS (Jockey Mario Gutierrez dropped in sharply applying pressure from the outside and # 1 LOOKS RARE (Jockey Lanfranco Dettori) moved out causing the #4 DEEP RIVER (Jockey Tiago Pereira) to be in very tight quarters. Jockeys Lanfranco Dettori and Mario Gutierrez were told to ride with more awareness and that safety was the most important part of the race. Steward Sawyer felt suspension days were in order for both jockeys.

RULINGS

LATS Ruling # 12 Lanfranco Dettori

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey LANFRANCO DETTORI, who rode LOOKS RARE in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on January 15, 2023, is suspended for (1) day (January 27, 2023) and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$250.00)* for one (1) strike over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey LANFRANCO DETTORI is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on July 20, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and penalties) – first offense.

Pursuant to California horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

*Rule #1532. Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling, or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.

LATS Ruling # 13 Victor Espinoza

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA, who rode ANGEL NADESHIKO in the seventh race at Santa Anita Park on January 15, 2023, is suspended for (1) day (January 27, 2023) and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$250.00)* for two (2) strikes over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on July 20, 2023, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and penalties) – third offense since August 18, 2022. Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA has accrued at total of nine (9) points.

Pursuant to California horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

*Rule #1532. Fine shall be paid to the Paymaster within seven calendar days from the date of this ruling, or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.

OBJECTION / INQUIRY

Following the 4th race the Stewards caused the inquiry sign to be posted for an incident where #4 SIX FEET (Jockey Roman Vazquez) interfered with #1 IRONDALE (Jockey Geovanni Franco) causing #1 IRONDALE to check sharply. #4 SIX FEET finished 4th and was disqualified to 6th with Steward Jauregui dissenting.
