**BERNARD FORMAL HEARING CASE 22SR0017**

A formal hearing was held at Del Mar Race Track before the BOS, Luis Jauregui and Kim Sawyer who were also available by Microsoft Teams. In addition, via Microsoft Teams, were CHRB Chief Counsel, Robert Brodnik, Court Reporter, Michelle Derieg, Administrative Hearings Coordinator Sidney Villareal and CHRB Steward Grant Baker who chaired the hearing. The matter involved an appeal of ruling LATS #54 issued on April 28, 2023, at Santa Anita Race Track to trainer Lisa Bernard for failure to appear for a scheduled hearing. The original date for the hearing was August 18, 2022, but was actually held on August 17, 2022 (Del Mar Race Track). At this time Ms. Bernard in attendance, asked for a continuance to acquire an attorney (Suzanne Porrazzo). The hearing was rescheduled for September 8, 2022, counsel for Ms. Bernard was only available with a start time of 8:00 am (2 hours before normal start time). Owner of the horse in question, April Vaillancourt gave her testimony in person on this date. The next hearing date was listed for October 20, 2022, again, counsel for Ms. Bernard requested another continuance.

The next hearing date was December 1, 2022 (Del Mar Race Track) and CHRB Chief Counsel Robert Brodrik was unavailable. The hearing was then moved to December 7, 2022 (Los Alamitos Race Course) and Ms. Bernard's counsel was again unavailable.

Once more the hearing was moved to April 18, 2023, wherein neither the respondent nor her counsel appeared, at that juncture, LATS ruling #54 dated April 28, 2023, was issued. Counsel for Ms. Bernard filed an appeal of LATS #54 with the California Horse Racing Board. The BOS received a certified letter dated July 20, 2023, stating, the firm representing Ms. Bernard will no longer appear on her behalf.

After waiting for approximately twenty minutes past scheduled hearing time, Ms. Bernard failed to appear, the record was opened, information pertaining to the case and the failure to appear again were cited into the record. Decision to follow.

#### DMTD RULING #21

Trainer LISA M. BERNARD, having failed to respond to written notice, to appear for a formal appeal hearing before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Racetrack on August 8th, 2023, remains suspended as ordered in LATS Ruling #54 dated April 28th, 2023, issued at Santa Anita Park, Hollywood Meet.

Furthermore, Lisa M. Bernard is fined One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1840 (Veterinary Practices and Treatments Restricted - non-prescribed Acepromazine) and Rule #1842.5 (Trainer to Maintain Medication Treatment Records) at San Luis Rey Downs.

Prior to reinstatement of licenses Ms. Bernard is required to participate in a Fitness for License Hearing in addition to payment of fine.

\*During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Lisa M. Bernard remains suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board, Rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

Present at the hearing were Respondent Brian Koriner, (via telephone) California Horse Racing Board Investigator Ann Dillon and the Board of Stewards, Kim Sawyer, Luis Jauregui, and Rich Williams. Testimony in the hearing given by Brian Koriner, stated that errors in his protocols for dispensing medications may have caused or

contributed to the positive test. Mr. Koriner has since changed his procedures to avoid further violations. The following ruling is issued.

**DMTD RULING #18**

Trainer BRIAN KORINER, who worked out the horse RESILIENT at Santa Anita Park May 18, 2023, is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* and assessed one half (1/2) point in accordance with California Horse Racing rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medication Violations – Expires 2/10/24 pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances - Methocarbamol [Class 4] Second Offense in the last 365 days).

**LUIS ARMANDO AGUILAR HEARING**

A hearing was held for California Horse Racing Board complaint #23SA0088 filed against Luis Armando Aguilar. During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of HUMBERTO PEREZ are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

Jockey Kent Desormeaux after admitting full responsibility for his actions in the 6<sup>th</sup> race on Friday 8/11/2023, is issued the following ruling.

**DMTD RULING #22**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX, who rode LORD PRANCEALOT in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on August 11, 2023, is suspended for (1) day (August 19, 2023), and fined SIX HUNDRED NINETY TWO DOLLARS & FIFTY CENTS (\$692.50)\* (Graduation Stakes) for two (2) strikes over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on February 12, 2024, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and penalties) – first offense. Jockey KENT DESORMEAUX has accrued a total of three (3) points.

Pursuant to California horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of Suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.
