A hearing was held for California Horse Racing Board complaint #23DM0016, filed against Trainer Quinn Howey for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule 1876 (Financial Responsibility). Present by telephone was Respondent Quinn Howey, and in person, California Horse Racing Board Investigator Ann Dillon and the Board of Stewards, Kim Sawyer, Luis Jauregui, and Rich Williams. Don Lockwood, who filed the complaint, failed to appear. Quinn Howey presented a check for the entire amount in question and this matter is resolved.

SERAFIN ROMERO HEARING

A hearing was held for California Horse Racing Board complaint #23DM0014 filed against Serafin Romero for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule 1874 (Disorderly Conduct). Present were Serafin Romero, California Horse

Racing Board Investigator Ann Dillon, and the Board of Stewards Kim Sawyer, Luis Jauregui, and Rich Williams. Serafin Romero admitted to being intoxicated and stated that there has been an ongoing dispute between himself and Rudy Cruz. There was no witness to the verbal altercation presented even though one existed. Having some discrepancy in the complaint and testimony and no rebuttal, the Stewards instructed Mr. Romero to stay clear of Mr. Cruz and maintain the peace. A ruling will be issued to address any potential alcohol related issue.

Jockey Ramon Vasquez Jr. was in to review his ride in the 1st race where he moved over without clearance and interfered with #1 Ace of Clubs ridden by Antonio Fresu . After reviewing the race and talking with Mr. Vasquez the Stewards determined that for the interference Mr. Vasquez was at fault. A ruling will be issued.

JOCKEY ANTONIO FRESU

Jockey Antonio Fresu was in to address his use of the crop in the 7th race on Sunday 8/27/23. Mr. Fresu reviewed the recording of the 7th race and witnessed the 7 strikes of the crop. In addition, this violation will elevate his multiple violation points to trigger an additional 7 day suspension. Rulings for both offenses will be issued.

JOCKEY HECTOR BERRIOS

Jockey Hector Berrios was in to discuss his ride in the 7th race on Sunday where he failed to maintain a straight course, making contact with the horse to his outside. The horse on his outside Sanger ridden by Antonio Fresu was the winner of the race. Mr. Barrios was issued a warning by the Stewards.

FIRST RACE INCIDENT / ACCIDENT / INQUIRY

In the first race #5 Single Track Mind (IRE), clipped heels unseating his jockey Umberto Risoli. The Stewards caused the inquiry sign to be posted and an inquiry into the accident was conducted. It was determined by the Stewards that #1 Tom And Jazzy, ridden by Armando Aguilar after running up on heels of the horse in front of him, made contact with and pushed #5 Single Track Mind (IRE) out causing him to clip heels. Consequently the #1 was disqualified and unplaced, Mr. Aguilar has an appointment to see the Stewards Friday. Umberto Risoli was off his mounts for the remainder of the program and in both races, replaced by Juan Hernandez.

Original Order: 8-(1)-4-9-2-6 & 5 did not finish

After Disqualification 8-4-9-2-6-7 & 5 did not finish and #1 was disqualified to unplaced.

Jockey Agent JACK CARAVA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1481 (b)(4) (Occupational Licenses and Fees – Conducting business with an expired license).

DMTD RULING #36

Groom SERAFIN ROMERO is ordered to be evaluated by the Winners Foundation, abide by the terms set by their recommendations, and ordered to sign a testing agreement while holding a license with the California Horse Racing Board.

DMTD RULING #37

Trainer AGGIE A. ORDONEZ is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1845 (Authorized Bleeder Medication – late registration–off Lasix) of QUINCEY in the seventh race on August 27, 2023, at Del Mar Race Track.

DMTD RULING #38

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey ANTONIO FRESU, who rode SANGER in the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 27, 2023, is suspended for (1) day (September 8, 2023), and fined TWO HUNDRED FIFTY TWO DOLLARS (\$252.00)* for one (1) strike over the limit.

Furthermore, Jockey ANTONIO FRESU is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on March 2, 2024, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – fourth

offense). Jockey ANTONIO FRESU has accrued a total of twelve (12) points.

DMTD RULING #39

Jockey ANTONIO FRESU is suspended SEVEN (7) days, September, 9,10,11,12,13,14, & 15, 2023, having accumulated twelve (12) violation points in the last six (6) months, pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) rule #2283 (a) (1) (Multiple Violations) for violation of HISA rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop).

DMTD RULING #40

Jockey RAMON VASQUEZ, JR. who rode MR. DREAMCYCLE in the first race at Del Mar Race Track on August 27, 2023, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (September 8, 9 and 10, 2023) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the turn, causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Jockey Armando Aguilar was in to review his performance in the 1st race. Present were Jockey Armando Aguilar his Agent Patty Sterling, and the Board of

Stewards Kim Sawyer Luis Jauregui and Rich Williams, to address where he rode into tight quarters and moved out and forced Jockey Umberto Rispoli out causing him to clip heels and become unseated. Mr. Aguilar was just in the previous week for the same type of incident where he himself clipped heels. (See Stewards Minuets for the week of Tuesday, August 22, 2023, through Sunday August 27, 2023, entry on Saturday 8/26/23 film review). Armando Aguilar argued that he was not at fault. The Stewards unanimously felt it was his fault. In addition, Mr. Aguilar's agent Patty Sterling accused the Stewards of being unfair and not treating Jockeys the same. In a unanimous decision the Stewards felt a penalty was in order and a ruling will be issued.

TRACTOR DELAY

In preparation for the 10th race while dragging the track, one of the implements suffered some type of malfunction. After several minutes the track crew was able to raise the harrow and exit the track. The track at this point had a ridge of dirt left by the malfunction. The track crew brought another tractor out to repair the surface. During this time the horses were being held behind the gate. A delay of approximately 12 minutes ensued. The horses were loaded in the gate and the #4 United A. P. was fractious and injured herself in the gate necessitating a scratch. This caused a further 4 minute delay.

MOTHER NATURE

Because of the delays caused by the tractor ordeal, the time delay made sunset, the sun shining on the horizon, impairing visibility, a safety concern for the jockeys. The post time for the 11th race was delayed 10 minutes to allow the sun to clear.

ANTONIO FRESU RULINGS

Jockey Antonio Fresu was issued ruling DMTD #42 for a HISA Multiple crop violation ruling and given a seven day suspension. The Board of Stewards had been instructed by HISA that the issuance of suspension days was to follow state guidelines. State guidelines have been that a suspension for riding violations, start one week from the day the person appears in front of the Board of Stewards and that the suspension days be racing days. Antonio Fresu's agent Tom Knust contacted HISA and was told that HISA's intent was for the days to be calendar days. The Stewards and The California Horse Racing Board Chief Steward, Darrel McHargue contacted HISA who informed us that their intentions were for calendar days not racing days and other states were issuing calendar days. The Board of Stewards after considering the facts and getting direction from higher powers, amended Rulings DMTD #39 dated 08/31/2023, DMTD #41 dated 09/01/2023 and DMTD #42 dated 09/01/2023 to reflect the correct suspension days.
