- Auxiliary stables: San Luis Rey Downs and Los Alamitos Race Course.

Four (4) graded stakes races are scheduled including two (2) "Win and You're In" Challenge races. Ten (10) races are slated. Ninety (90) horses are scheduled to start. Steward Kim Sawyer was on duty for the CHRB.

**BALTAZAR CONTRERAS INFORMAL HEARING**

Exercise Rider Baltazar Contreras appeared in our office to address a violation notice that was issued by Santa Anita Stable Security on September 13, 2023. Mr. Contreras was on a horse for Trainer Tim Yakteen. The violation notice in this matter says that he was using a cell phone from the 1/8<sup>th</sup> pole to the 1/16<sup>th</sup> pole while on horseback. Mr. Contreras told us that he was "taking a picture of the scenery". Decision to follow.

**HUMBERTO PEREZ COMPLAINT (CASE #23SA0109)**

Groom HUMBERTO PEREZ appeared in our office for an informal hearing today. CHRB Investigator Jeanne Garrido presented a fifteen (15) page complaint package that she prepared. Groom Perez has been charged with violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and Rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers). The cover page of the complaint reads as follows.  
*On June 11, 2023, Santa Anita security informed CHRB Investigators that groom Humberto Perez was possibly under the influence of alcohol and performing his respective duties. Perez was contacted by CHRB Investigators, and after performing a standardized field sobriety test, was determined to be under the influence of*

*alcohol. Mr. Perez was prohibited from working the rest of the day by investigators, but he disobeyed and went back to work at the barn.*

Groom Perez failed to appear for a hearing at Del Mar in August (REF: DMTD Ruling #17). He appeared in front of the Los Alamitos Thoroughbred Stewards and was reinstated (REF: 9/22/23-LATL Ruling #11) with the understanding today's hearing would take place. This hearing was chaired by Steward Luis Jauregui.

**ROLANDO QUINONEZ COMPLAINT (CASE #23DM0035)**

Private Veterinarian Michael Manno filed a complaint against Owner ROLANDO QUINONEZ for services rendered for horses 'Golondrino' and 'Mama's Got Cash' since September 14, 2023. The Stewards were informed the amount of \$316 has been paid in full and this complaint has now been withdrawn. The cover page of the complaint read as follows.

*Owner Rolando Quinonez was sent invoices and account statements from complainant veterinarian Dr. Michael Manno, for services rendered for horses "GOLONDRINO" and "MAMA'S GOT CASH" since September 14, 2022. Mr. Quinonez received a monthly invoice statement via email for these charges since October 2022 and continuing until present day. On December 9, 2022, Mr. Quinonez was contacted by phone regarding his outstanding balances from September, October, and November 2022. On August 23, 2023, Mr. Quinonez was contacted by phone and by email regarding the overdue balances and that his account would be referred to the CHRB investigators for non-payment if he did not reply within 5 business days. On August 30, 2023, a final attempt was made to contact Mr. Quinonez by sending his invoices and account statement via text message with a request to call Dr. Manno's office to make payment on his past due balance. Mr. Quinonez has not responded to the emailed statements or any attempt to contact Dr. Manno.*

**CESAR ORTEGA RULING**

On closing day of the Los Alamitos Thoroughbred Meet Jockey CESAR ORTEGA was ordered to a film review that was scheduled for today at Santa Anita. Jockey Ortega waived his right to a hearing and 'pled guilty' to violation of HISA Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties). The following ruling was issued.

**LATC Ruling #01**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey CESAR ORTEGA, who rode FAST PER SE in the third race at Los Alamitos Race Course on September 24, 2023, is suspended for ONE (1) day (October 6, 2023), and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for two (2) strikes over the limit. Furthermore, Jockey CESAR ORTEGA is assigned three (3) violation points that will be expunged on March 29, 2024, six (6) months from the date of final adjudication pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties) – third offense. Jockey CESAR ORTEGA has accrued a total of nine (9) points.

Pursuant to California horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

**JOSE VALDIVIA, JR. RULING**

The Stewards were informed by the CHRB that Jockey JOSE VALDIVIA JR. has dropped an appeal of a ruling that was issued at Del Mar the second week of their summer meet. Del Mar Stewards suspended Jockey Valdivia three (3) days for

violation of CHRB Rule #1699 (Carless Riding). Today Santa Anita Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #02**

Having received notice from the California Horse Racing Board that the appeal of DMTD Ruling #07 (July 22, 2023) has been withdrawn, the original ruling is reinstated. Jockey JOSE VALDIVIA JR. is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 14, 15 and 20, 2023).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

9/29/23<sup>3</sup> **BALTAZAR CONTRERAS RULING (REF:9/28/23 (3))**

Exercise Rider BALTAZAR CONTRERAS was issued a 'Violation Notice' by Santa Anita Security September 13, 2023. Yesterday he appeared in our office and pled guilty to being on his cell phone while exercising a horse. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATC RULING #03**

Exercise Rider BALTAZAR CONTRERAS is fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1437 (Conditions of a Race Meeting – using a cell phone on horseback) at Santa Anita Park on September 13, 2023.

9/29/23<sup>4</sup> **HUMBERTO PEREZ RULING (REF: 9/28/23 (4))**

The Stewards issued the following ruling after Groom HUMBERTO PEREZ appeared for an informal hearing in our office yesterday September 28.

**LATC RULING #04**

Groom HUMBERTO PEREZ is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – under the influence of an alcoholic beverage while performing his duties) at Santa Anita Park on June 11, 2023.

Furthermore, HUMBERTO PEREZ must be evaluated by the Winners Foundation, abide by the terms set by their recommendations, and ordered to sign a testing agreement while holding a license with the California Horse Racing Board.

9/29/23<sup>5</sup> **GEOVANNI FRANCO/EPIFANIO GARCIA FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/24/23 (2))**

Jockey's GEOVANNI FRANCO and EPIFANIO GARCIA were involved in a Stewards' Inquiry on closing day of the recently concluded Los Alamitos Thoroughbred Meet (September 24, 2023- Ninth Race) Jockey Franco was in our office today. Jockey Juan Hernandez represented Jockey Garcia who rides on a full-time basis in Northern California.

Jockey Franco was aboard sixth place finisher #2 LUKA GRAZIE, who drifted out entering the backstretch, in this one-mile race. Jockey Garcia was aboard fourth place finisher #7 JERRY JEFF WALKER who stepped in at this same location. Jockey Franco was issued a warning in a unanimous decision. In a majority vote Jockey Garcia was also issued a warning. Steward Jauregui voted for a three-day suspension.

9/29/23<sup>6</sup> **JOCKEY'S ROOM MEETING**

The Stewards went to the Jockey's Room to meet with the jockey colony prior to this nineteen (19) day Autumn meet. Four (4) members of Santa Anita management spoke and then departed. The Stewards then had a 'back and forth' with the Jockeys. The Stewards will visit the Jockeys Room again Breeders' Cup weekend November 3 and 4.

9/29/23<sup>7</sup> **VOIDED CLAIM-RACE TWO**

In today's second race #2 AMERICAN LILY was claimed for \$50,000. CHRB Veterinarian Nolton Pattio contacted the Stewards and told us this horse was unsound and was to be placed on the Veterinarian's List. The Stewards voided this claim.

**ENFORCEMENT CHIEF VISIT**

CHRB Chief of Enforcement/Licensing Marc Shaw met with the Stewards yesterday. We reviewed several items including details of happenings involving this year's Breeders' Cup which will be held November 3 and 4 at Santa Anita.

9/30/23<sup>2</sup>

**HEAVY RAINS/TRACK SURFACE CHANGES/DELAY**

Earlier this morning a strong storm hit the San Gabriel Valley. At 12:49 p.m. (11 minutes before first post time) Santa Anita Director of Racing/Racing Secretary Jason Egan informed the Stewards that management would make some track surface changes. Races 1, 3 and 5 were moved to the main track. The first race was delayed nineteen (19) minutes for two reasons. Track Superintendent Robert Moore needed time to 'float' the racetrack following the heavy rain. The Stewards allowed a total of thirty (30) minutes, after the initial announcement, for the wagering public to amend wagers if they wished due to the important track surface changes. Another change was that today's ninth race (Eddie D Stakes-Grade 2) would be run at 6 ½ furlongs turf (out of chute). Originally this race was to be contested down the hill on the Hillside Turf Course.

9/30/23<sup>3</sup>

**PROBLEMATIC CHAIN OF COMMAND**

At 1:24 p.m. Public Address Commentator Frank Mirahmadi announced that the seventh race would be taken off the turf and contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the main track(dirt). Normally we receive all course changes from Director of Racing Jason Eagan. That did not happen in this situation. Neither the Stewards nor any licensed Racing Official gave out this important wagering change to Announcer Mirahmadi. He apologized and then said he knows the proper procedures, and then stated it wouldn't happen again.

Mr. Miahmadi told us the seventh race change was given to him by Santa Anita Senior Vice President & Executive Producer Amy Zimmerman. We immediately called Ms. Zimmerman and respectfully told her that it is our responsibility to disseminate official program changes to the Announcer. Ms. Zimmerman came up to the Judges' Stand and apologized.

**CHRB RULE 1527. General Authority Of Stewards**

**The Stewards have general Authority and supervision over all licensees and other persons attendant on horses, and also over the inclosures of any recognized meeting. The stewards are strictly responsible to the Board for conduct of the race meeting in every particular.**

9/30/23<sup>4</sup>

**FOURTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following an incident in the final furlong of this 6 ½ furlong main track event. This incident involved second place finisher #1 MR. LEASURE (Ramon Vazquez) and third place finisher #5 BARTHOLDY (Antonio Fresu). Race replays show #1 MR. LEASURE drift out and make slight contact with #5 BARTHOLDY. The contact did not appear to be overly significant but the margin between these horses was only a 'head'. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made 'no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Ramon Vasquez was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**RAMON VASQUEZ FILM REVIEW (REF: 9/30/23 (4))**

Jockey Ramon Vasquez appeared in our office to review his ride in the fourth race yesterday September 30. In this 6 ½ furlong main track event, Jockey Vasquez was aboard second place finisher #1 Mr. Leasure who was involved in a Stewards' inquiry along with third place finisher #5 Bartholdy (Antonio Fresu). Jockey Vasquez drifted out slightly in this race and made contact with the third place finisher who was only beaten by a 'head'. The Stewards cautioned Vasquez that this was close to being a suspension worthy ride. In a unanimous decision a 'warning' was issued.

10/1/23<sup>2</sup>

**LATE JOCKEY CHANGES**

Jockey Agent Ron Andeson called us and requested permission to make jockey changes on all of John Velasquez' seven (7) mounts. We granted this permission. Agent Anderson told us that Belmont Park cancelled their entire Saturday, September 30 racing card and moved it to today October 1. Mr. Anderson's other client, Jockey Joel Rosario will 'pick up' seven (7) mounts that Jockey Velasquez was scheduled to ride.

**SECOND RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following an incident involving three (3) horses, took place approaching the 1/8-mile marker in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. The (3) horses involved were:

- A. #2 Where's My Ring- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place- (Edwin Maldonado)
- B. #3 Esprit Enchante-1<sup>st</sup> Place- (Mike Smith)
- C. #4 Ur in Trouble-2<sup>nd</sup> Place- (Tiago Pereira)

Film review shows #2 Where's My Ring shift out after Jockey Maldonado uses his riding crop (left-handed). This action forced Jockey Tiago Pereira (#4 Ur in Trouble) to steady sharply while closing strongly from between horses. When #4 Ur in Trouble lacked racing room, he was forced into the hind quarters of the eventual winner #3 Esprit Enchante knocking that rival sideways.

The Stewards received a Patrol Judge report, viewed all camera angles, and spoke to the Jockeys involved. The Stewards all felt this incident was caused by the horse that finished behind her other two (2) rivals. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made no change in the order of finish. Jockey Edwin Maldonado was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**THIRD RACE INQUIRY/ DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident in the stretch run of this six (6) furlongs turf race. Film review shows third place finisher #1 SEA OF CORTEZ (IRE) (Abel Cedillo) shift out and bump #7 PETCOFF (J.G. Torrealba\*\*) repeatedly and taking his path at about the 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile maker while racing in tight quarters.

The Stewards received a Patrol Judge report, viewed all race replay camera angles spoke to both the Jockey and Apprentice Jockey involved. #7 PETCOFF was beaten a 'nose' for third (Show) position. In a unanimous decision #1 SEA OF CORTEZ (IRE) was disqualified and placed fourth. Jockey Abel Cedillo was ordered to review films with the Stewards.

**FIFTH RACE JOCKEY'S OBJECTION**

Jockey Joe Bravo lodged a Jockey's Objection following the running of the fifth race which was contested at 6 ½ furlongs on the Hillside Turf Course. Jockey Bravo was aboard fifth place finisher #2 LUNAR IMPACT (GB), and he lodged an objection against third place finisher #3 FREE AND HUMBLE (Antonio Fresu) for an incident at about the 5/16<sup>th</sup> mile marker.

The Stewards reviewed several camera angles of the incident where Jockey Bravo checked his mount while racing in tight quarters along the rail. #2 LUNAR IMPACT

was getting outrun slightly by #3 FREE AND HUMBLE at the time of the incident. #3 Free and HUMBLE did brush his rival to the inside however this horse was receiving 'pressure' herself from rival #7 WED (FR) (Umberto Rispoli) who was racing extremely close to her outside. The Stewards spoke to Jockey Bavo and Jockey Fresu. We also received a Patrol Judge report. We could not place blame exclusively on #3 Free and Humble. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made 'no change' to the order of finish.

**VOIDED CLAIM- RACE 8**

#10 Positivity was claimed for \$50,000 following a five-way 'shake'. Following the race, CHRB Veterinarian Nolton Pattio informed us this horse was unsound. The Stewards voided this claim and the horse returns to the barn of original trainer Kristin Mulhall.
