#### **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO was called in to review Sunday's second race in which he floated out in the stretch, causing another horse to steady and alter course. Mr. Maldonado argued that his horse was lugging in, and he had to use his crop left-handed to correct him. The majority felt that he guided his horse out, causing the #4 to steady, therefore he was issued a suspension. Steward Kim Sawyer believed the horse was culpable for the shift. The ruling will be issued tomorrow when our secretary is in the office.

#### **ORANTES HEARING (case#22SA002)**

Groom DESIDERIO ORANTES failed to show for his scheduled hearing regarding a complaint filed by the CHRB for violation of CHRB rules 1902.5 (Animal Welfare) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) when he was witnessed kicking his horse in the belly at the barn by a coworker. Mr. Orantes failed to appear for the original hearing and was suspended then for failing to appear (February 25, 2023, ruling LATS # 51) and requested another hearing, and failed to show again. Therefore, Mr. Orantes will remain suspended.

**MALDONADO RULING**

The following ruling was issued after reviewing yesterday's film involving Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO when he was issued a three-day suspension. Steward Sawyer voted for a warning.

**LATC RULING #06**

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO, who rode WHERE'S MY RING in the second race at Santa Anita Park on October 1, 2023, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 14, 15 and 20, 2023) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO was in to review Sunday's third race in which he was disqualified from third to fourth place for an incident in the stretch. After viewing it several times we unanimously voted to issue Mr. Cedillo a three-day suspension. We felt that he attempted to push out from behind the lead horse, making contact several times throughout the stretch with the outside horse. He blamed both horses, he stated that the lead horse did not maintain a straight course and the outside side came in slightly, which caused him to alter course, we disagreed with his assessment.

**LATC RULING #07**

Jockey ABEL CEDILLO, who rode SEA OF CORTEZ (IRE) in the third race at Santa Anita Park on October 1, 2023, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (October 14, 15 and 20, 2023) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch, causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to fourth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.
