Jockey F. J. Rubio is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1683 (Maximum Overweight), causing a late rider change at Los Alamitos Race Course on February 3, 2024.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey Rubio was unable to get within the five pound overweight limit.

INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry following the sixth race to review the start. #6 Call Me Winner (DNF – R. Luzano) whipped his head to the right just as Starter Brinson dispatched the field. When he attempted to break, Jockey Lozano pulled him around until he was ultimately facing the gate. The incident was the fault of horse and rider prompting the Stewards, in a unanimous decision, to declare him a starter.
