**RON E. BREWER COMPLAINT (CASE # 24SA0080)**

CHRB Southern California Investigator Mike Barker was on hand to present a complaint against Owner Ron Brewer for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Private Veterinarian Michael Manno was also in attendance. The cover page of this complaint reads as follows.

*The San Dieguito Equine Group (Dr. Michael Manno) performed veterinary services for Mr. Ron Brewer's horse BRUTTO at various Southern California CHRB facilities from May 10, 2023, to May 31, 2024. Mr. Brewer received monthly statements via email from June 2023 and have continued on a monthly basis. Mr. Brewer received an invoice via USPS Certified Mail dated May 22, 2024. Mr. Brewer paid \$200 on May 28, 2024, and has an outstanding balance of \$1,215.77, and continues until this day.*

Owner Ron E. Brewer failed to appear for this hearing. More to follow.

**ALL HANDS DEL MAR PRE-MEET MEETING**

Del Mar Vice President Racing Tom Robbins invited thirty (30) individuals to a pre-season meeting held in the Board Room here at Del Mar. Mr. Robbins chaired this meeting where call-in capabilities were made available for those that could not attend the live meeting. CHRB Equine Medical Director Jeff Blea DVM gave a comprehensive purview of the CHRB/Del Mar veterinarian duties. There will be at least seven (7) examining veterinarians working here at Del Mar this meet.

**PETER MILLER COMPLAINT (CASE #SA240098)**

Trainer Peter Miller appeared in our office for an informal hearing today. Trainer Miller has been charged with an alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). CHRB Investigator Octavio Vergara Jr. prepared the complaint in this matter. The cover page of today's complaint reads as follows.

*The horse 'Style Cat' was entered to run on June 16, 2024, in Race 7. The horse was listed as a Colt on the program, but it was determined to be a Gelding prior to racing.*

The investigative report in this case reported that Style Cat was gelded in New Mexico prior to arrival at the Miller barn at San Luis Rey Downs. Miller's assistant trainer, Jehobany Catalan, knew that this horse was a gelding prior to entry. Trainer Miller did not. Mr. Miller accepted full responsibility for not listing the true sex of Style Cat at time of entry. More to follow.

**CHRB/DEL MAR VETERINARIAN MEETING**

CHRB Veterinarian Nolton Pattio requested and organized a meeting for all of the veterinarians who are working at Del Mar at this time. A total of nine (9) veterinarians attended this meeting in the Stewards office. Assignments and responsibilities were reviewed. We thank Dr. Pattio for bringing everyone together today. Safety Steward David Nuesch was also present.

**ARTURO GAMBOA COMPLAINT (CASE #24SA0096)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Hot Walker Arturo Gamboa for alleged violation of CHRB Ruling #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), Rule #1489 (a) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) and Rule #1900 Grounds for Suspension or Revocation). The cover page of today's complaint reads as follows.

*Hot Walker Arturo Gamboa consented to a urine sample that tested positive for Methamphetamine, Amphetamines, and THC (Marijuana). Gamboa admitted to being in possession of methamphetamine while working at Trainer Tim Yakteen's barn on June 13, 2024. Subsequently, during a search of Gamboa's vehicle I located a glass smoking pipe.*

CHRB Investigator Octavio Vergara Jr. was in-person today and presented his fifteen (15) page Complaint packet before the Stewards. CHRB Enforcement/Licensing Chief Marc Shaw and Investigator Anne Dillion were also present for today's hearing. The Stewards read the investigative report included in the complaint and asked Mr. Gamboa several questions. We also observed many color photographs in the report. Included in the complaint is a 'Denial of Access' (Security File 24-218) issued to Arturo Gamboa by Santa Anita Park on June 13, 2024. Decision to follow.

**MICHAEL J. MACY COPLAINT (CASE #24SA0102)**

The CHRB has filed a complaint on behalf of Trainer Ricky Agarie against Owner Michael J Macy for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). CHRB Investigator Hiroshi Yokoyama prepared a twenty-eight (28) page complaint packet for today's hearing. Complainant Agarie appeared today along with Respondent Macy and a witness Groom Julian Aguirre. The cover page of today's complaint reads as follows.

*Michael Macy is the owner of Soul Sweet (Foaled in 2018) who has been trained by Ricky Agarie since June 2022. Owner Michael Macy was sent invoices and account statements from*

*trainer Ricky Agarie for training fees since inception. Mr. Macy received a monthly invoice and statements via email with an outstanding balance of \$4,712.00 for training services since April 2024 and continuing until present day.*

This 'financial hearing lasted longer than a 'normal' informal hearing involving a CHRB Rule #1876 alleged violation. The Stewards took a recess and gave both parties some time to work out their debate after the Stewards delved into this matter. That did not work so well.

Ultimately this hearing will be continued to a later date. The Stewards requested that more documents be provided to us until we are able to make an equitable decision in this matter. More to follow.

### **RON BREWER RULING (REF: 7/18/24 (2))**

Owner Ron Brewer failed to appear for a hearing on July 16, 2024. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

#### **DMTD RULING #1**

Owner RON E. BREWER, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Race Track on July 18, 2024, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear), pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer to charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility \$773.62 to Veterinarian San Dieguito Equine Group-Dr. Manno). Suspension commences July 27, 2024.

### **JOE TALAMO INFORMAL HEARING**

Jockey Joe Talamo appeared in our office to discuss his ride on closing day at the recently concluded Los Angeles County Fair at Los Alamitos Race Course. Jockey Talamo rode #10 Rhino in the ninth race on July 7, 2024. Race replays show Jockey Talamo using his riding crop eight (8) times while finishing in second place. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

#### **DMTD RULING #2**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3), Jockey JOSEPH TALAMO, who rode RHINO in the ninth race at Los Alamitos Race Course on July 7, 2024, is suspended for ONE (1) day (July 27, 2024) and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for two (2) strikes over the limit.

**ELEVENTH RACE ACCIDENT/INQUIRY/ DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an accident in this one (1) mile turf course event. #11 Fausto (Edwin Maldonado) fell in this race.

Race replays show #10 The Old Nine (IRE) (Anthony Fresu) racing in eighth position Inside the 1/8 mile marker. This horse begins to shift out forcing Jockey Abel Cedillo, aboard eighth place finisher #8 Rostovsky, to get his horse off the heels of #10 The Old Nine (IRE) thereby having to shift outward himself. #11 Fausto (Edwin Maldonado) then clips the heels of #8 Rostovsky, forcing both horse and jockey to fall to the turf course.

The Stewards received a patrol judge report, reviewed all camera angles of the incident and spoke to Jockey Fresu and Cedillo. In a unanimous decision original fifth place finisher #10 The Old Nine (IRE) was disqualified and placed unplaced. Jockey Anthony Fresu was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

Following this race, it was reported both the horse and jockey in this accident were in good condition.

**PETER MILLER RULING (REF: 7/19/24 (1))**

Trainer Peter Miller appeared in our office for an informal hearing on Friday July 19. He told us he didn't like CHRB Rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). He also told the Stewards that he was guilty of violating this rule. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

**DMTD RULING #3**

Trainer PETER MILLER, who started the horse STYLE CAT, in the seventh race on June 16, 2024, at Santa Anita Park is fined SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1865(e) (Altering Sex of Horse - true sex not identified).

**ARTURO GAMBOA RULING (REF: 7/19/24 (3))**

CHRB Investigators were informed that Hot Walker Arturo Gamboa was in possession of a bag of Methamphetamine in the stable area of Santa Anita Park on June 13, 2024. Mr. Gamboa told us during his hearing that he was “only” currently using marijuana. The Stewards requested that CHRB Enforcement test Mr. Gamboa following his hearing on July 19. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

**DMTD RULING #4**

Hot Walker ARTURO GAMBOA is suspended for one hundred and eighty days (180) from July 21, 2024, to January 18, 2025, pursuant to and California Horse Racing Board #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) and California Horse Racing Board #1489 (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct- Positive for Amphetamines, Methamphetamine, THC and PCP and possession of Methamphetamine) on June 13, 2024 at Santa Anita Park.

Furthermore, ARTURO GAMBOA must be evaluated by the Winners Foundation, abide by the terms set by their recommendations, and ordered to sign a testing agreement while holding a license with the California Horse Racing Board.

**REYLU GUTIERREZ FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Reylu Gutierrez appeared in our office to review his ride in the 9<sup>th</sup> race (\$200,000 Guaranteed) San Clemente Handicap which was contested at one mile on the Jimmy Durante turf course. Jockey Gutierrez was aboard tenth (last) place finisher #11 Flattery, who shifted in and bumped third place finisher #10 Medoro (Antonio Fresu) after entering the stretch. Jockey Gutierrez recently arrived on the West Coast after recent success at Gulfstream Park (FL). Jockey Gutierrez was issued a ‘warning’ for this ride.

**ANTHONY FRESU FILM REVIEWS/RULING (REF:7/20/24 (6))**

Jockey Anthony Fresu was ordered to the Stewards office to review two (2) races from yesterday.

7/21/24<sup>5</sup>

**RACE 5**

Jockey Fresu rode #2 Espirit Enchante, who was racing in mid-pack as this field entered the stretch. This horse, who finished third swung out, and forced ninth place finisher #10 Shin Jidal (GB) (Kazushi Kazmura) and twelfth place finisher #12 She Is Romantic (Edwin Maldonado) off their previous straight path. Jockey Fresu was issued a warning for this sub-par effort.

7/21/24<sup>6</sup>

**RACE 11**

There was an accident in this one (1) mile turf race. Jockey Fresu was aboard fifth place finisher #10 The Old Nine (IRE). At the 1/8-mile marker this horse shifts out into the path of eighth place finisher #8 Rostovsky (Abel Cedillo) forcing that rival to alter course. This causes #11 Fausto (Edwin Maldonado), who is racing between horses, to clip heels, fall, and unseat Jockey Maldonado. The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion that the careless actions of Jockey Fresu were responsible for the accident. The majority voted for the following ruling. Steward Baker voted for a seven (7) day riding suspension.

**DMTD RULING #5**

Jockey ANTONIO FRESU, who rode THE OLD NINE (ire) in the eleventh race at Del Mar Race Track on July 20, 2024, is suspended for FIVE (5) racing days

(July 28, August 1, 2, 3, and 4, 2024) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch, causing interference, resulting in a disqualification from fifth to unplaced; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding)

**JEREMY LAPRIDA FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Jeremy Laprida appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the seventh race (Oceanside Stakes-\$100,00 Guaranteed). Jockey Laprida was aboard fourth place finisher #7 Blue Eyed George. This horse shifted out at the ¼ pole and bumped eleventh place finisher #9 Charge for Gold (Kyle Frey). The Stewards' issued Jockey Gutierrez a warning for his ride in this race. Our decision was unanimous.

7/21/24<sup>8</sup>

**SECOND RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing a multi-horse incident at the ¼ mile marker. This race was contested at one (1) mile on the main track. Tenth (last) place finisher #2 Torleif (Armando Aguilar) bumped, hit the inside rail and clipped heels in this incident. Sixth place finisher #11 Halverson (Abdul Alsagoor) made things tight by applying pressure from the outside. Fifth place finisher #8 Navajo Warrior (Antonio Fresu) raced up into tight quarters, from between horses, and was the horse that made the actual contact with #2 Torleif. Eighth place finisher #10 Citadino (Mario Gutierrez) was bumped from between horses in the incident.

The Stewards spoke to jockeys involved, received a patrol judge report and reviewed all camera angles of the incident. (The drone camera angle was particularly useful). In a majority vote #11 Halverson was disqualified and placed tenth. Steward Baker voted that #8 Navajo Warrior be disqualified and placed tenth. Jockeys Fresu and Alsagoor were ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**SIXTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the start of this 6 ½ furlong main track event. When the gates opened #5 The Big Cheeseola stumbled badly and unseated Jockey Diego Herrera. A film review of this incident showed that no other horses were involved and that this horse received a fair start. The Stewards informed Public Address Announcer Trevor Denman that there would be 'no change' in the order of finish.

Jockey Diego Herrera went to the First Aid department and was cleared to ride his lone remaining mount on the day. #5 The Big Cheeseola was captured by a track outrider and later reported to be in good condition.

**VOIDED CLAIMS**

There were three voided claims on today's eleven race card.

2<sup>nd</sup> Race #8 Navajo Warrior –Trainer T. Yakteen—Claiming \$16,000---Unsound

6<sup>th</sup> Race #8 Villified—Trainer T. Yakteen—Claiming \$12,500—Unsound
