**Report for the Week of Monday, August 26 through Monday, September 2, 2024.**

**TUESDAY**8/27/24<sup>1</sup>**SCRATCH TIME**

Assistant Clerk of Scales Charlie McCaul was handling all changes on the 'Scratch Board' this morning in the racing office. Steward Grant Baker was on duty in the Stewards office and the backside racing office. All changes were activated after 10:00 a.m.

8/27/24<sup>2</sup>**PACIFIC CLASSIC DRAW**

About 50 or 60 people attended a very nice event at the nearby Brigantine Restaurant. This gathering took place on the beautiful back patio overlooking the Del Mar racetrack. DMTC Chief Operating Officer Joe Harper introduced FanDuel TV talent Mike Joyce who went on camera live to announce the draw for the Grade 1 \$1,000,000 FanDuel Racing Pacific Classic. Veteran racing officials Ed Reese and Charlie McCaul, who was celebrating his birthday, were on hand to draw the nine (9) horse field. Steward Grant Baker was on hand to oversee the entries and draw for the CHRB.

**WEDNESDAY**8/28/24<sup>1</sup>**ENTRY DAY**

Steward Kim Sawyer was on hand today overseeing entries for Pacific Classic Day, Saturday August 31, 2024. An excellent card of eleven (11) races will be contested. One hundred ten (110) horses are scheduled to face Starter Keil Travis. Five (5) graded stake races, highlighted by the \$1,000,000 FanDuel Pacific Classic, will be held on this day.

**THURSDAY**8/29/24<sup>1</sup>**PETER MILLER RULING**

Trainer Peter Miller told the Stewards last week that "his owners" did not want to race #8 Cheeky Gal in the sixth race on Sunday August 25. This telephone conversation with Mr. Miller took place after the official scratch time which was 10:00 a.m. on Friday August 23, 2024. The

following ruling penalizes Trainer Miller for a late declaration. Having had several similar violations, Steward Sawyer dissented and voted for a \$1000 fine.

**DMTD RULING #32**

Trainer PETER MILLER, who was scheduled to start CHEEKY GAL in the sixth race on August 25, 2024, at Del Mar Race Track, is fined SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration – didn't want to run – multiple violations).

**FRANK ROBERTS RULING (REF: 8/25/24 (2))**

Owner Frank Roberts failed to appear for an informal hearing heard at Del Mar on August 25, 2024. The ruling below suspends the license privileges of Mr. Roberts.

**DMTD RULING #33**

Owner FRANK ROBERTS, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Race Track on August 25, 2024, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear), pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer to charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility \$500.00 to K C Horse Transport). Suspension to commence September 5, 2024.

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of FRANK ROBERTS are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**EDGAR ARRIAGA INFORMAL HEARING**

Exercise Rider Edgar Arriaga appeared in our office for an informal hearing today. Safety Steward David Nuesch also participated in this hearing. Morning Track Veterinarian Chuck Jenkins and Morning Outrider Enrique Alferez both witnessed Exercise Rider Arriaga use his riding crop during morning training. He understood the reasoning for the following ruling to be issued.

**DMTD RULING #34**

Exercise Rider EDGAR ARRIAGA is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* For violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(1) (Use of Riding Crop - use of crop during a.m. training) on August 25, 2024, at Del Mar Racetrack.

**SANTIAGO GONALEZ INFORMAL HEARING**

Jockey Santiago Gonzalez appeared in our office to discuss a DMTC Violation Notice that was issued on August 24, 2024. Safety Steward David Nuesch witnessed Jockey Gonzalez gallop a horse along the inner rail with two (2) horses performing an official workout behind them. Jockey Gonzalez said his horse was tough to control. The trainer of the horse involved in this matter, Ruben Gomez, was contacted on the telephone and stated his horse was often unruly. The majority dismissed this case. Steward Baker voted for a \$100 fine.

**THIRD RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident in mid-stretch in this 5-furlong event. The Stewards observed third place finisher #6 Commander (FR) attempt to enter a tight opening. This attempt led to ping-pong style contact between this horse and two rivals. They were first place finisher #3 Terry's Boy (Reylu Gutierrez) on the outside and fourth place finisher #5 Hot Box (Abel Cedillo) on the inside. We reviewed all camera angles of the incident, received a patrol judge report and spoke to the three (3) jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made 'no change' in the order of finish.

**FLAVIEN PRAT RULING**

Attorney Darrel Vienna has told the CHRB that he would like to cancel his participation in an appeal hearing on behalf of Jockey Flavien Prat. This appeal hearing was scheduled for Wednesday September 4, 2024. Jockey Prat was suspended three (3) days for a ride at Santa Anita Park May 27, 2024 (Ruling #100—May 31, 2024). Jockey Prat will now be suspended equivalent days of the week (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) that he was issued in his original ruling.

**DMTD RULING #35**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3 - first offense), Jockey KYLE FREY, who rode DORINE’S WILD CAT in the fourth race Purse (\$27,000.00) at Del Mar Race Track on August 30, 2024, is suspended for ONE (1) day (September 7, 2024), and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for one (1) strike over the limit.

**SECOND RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards conducted a Stewards Review into the start of this six (6) furlong race. The primary focus of this review were the actions of fourth place finisher #5 Thirst for Passion (Jeremy Laprida) who was off very slowly. After speaking with Starter Keil Travis the Stewards determined that there was no reason to conduct a formal Inquiry into this race.

**FIFTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the start of this one (1) mile turf event. At the start original second place finisher #8 Call Me Sir (Antonio Fresu) breaks in sharply. This action causes interference to several rivals to his inside. The horse that was affected the most, in the opinion of the stewards, was original third place finisher #5 Uncle Evco (Umberto Rispoli) who lost much ground at the start of this race. #5 Uncle Evco was beaten by a ‘head’ margin for second position.

The Stewards received a Patrol Judge report, reviewed different camera angles and spoke to Jockeys Fresu and Rispoli In a unanimous decision #8 Call Me Sir was disqualified and placed third.

**PEDRO ZAVALETA VIOLATION NOTICE**

Exercise Rider Pedro Zavaleta appeared in the Stewards office to address a ‘violation notice’ that was issued to him on August 30 here at Del Mar. Exercise Rider Zavaleta was observed using his riding crop during a morning workout. However, after viewing a video tape of the morning workout the Stewards felt that Zavaleta was flagging (showing) his riding crop and not striking his mount with his riding crop. In a unanimous decision the Stewards dismissed this matter.

**KYLE FREY RULING**

The Stewards observed Jockey Kyle Frey use his riding crop seven (7) times in the fourth race yesterday, August 30. Jockey Frey was aboard second place finisher #7 Dorine’s Wild Cat in a one (1) mile main track event. We spoke to Jockey Frey following the race. He watched a video replay and informed the Stewards that he agreed with our analysis that he went one strike over the limit. We issued the following ruling.

**DMTD RULING #36**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3 - first offense), Jockey KYLE FREY, who rode DORINE’S WILD CAT in the fourth race Purse (\$27,000.00) at Del Mar Race Track on August 30, 2024, is suspended for ONE (1) day (September 7, 2024), and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for one (1) strike over the limit.

**JUAN D. LOPEZ VIOLATION NOTICE**

Jockey Juan Lopez appeared in our office after receiving a ‘violation notice’ that was issued to him by DMTC Security on August 30. The Stewards reviewed a videotape where Jockey Lopez is viewed using his riding crop on a John Sadler trainee. After watching the video with the Stewards, Jockey Lopez understood the reasoning for the following ruling.

**DMTD RULING #37**

Jockey JUAN D. LOPEZ is fined THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(1) (Use of Riding Crop - use of crop during a.m. training) on August 19, 2024, at Del Mar Racetrack.

**ADDITIONAL OFFICIAL**

Del Mar management assigned Racing Official Jakob Wipfli to serve as an additional Patrol Judge for today’s eleven (11) race Pacific Classic day card. Mr. Wipfli will be located at the 1/8-

mile marker. Patrol Judge Heather Correa is at the 3/8<sup>th</sup> location. Ed Reese is positioned at the finish line stanchion.

Chief Steward Darrel McHargue visited us at Del Mar today. He spent a good portion of the morning with us. He also went up to the Judges' Stand for a visit between races. Current horse racing matters were discussed.

**THIRD RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards conducted an Inquiry into the running of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Race. The stretch drive of this Maiden ten (10) horse field was very chaotic. No change was made in the original placings. Of particular interest were the actions of sixth place finisher #12 Nation (Reylu Gutierrez) who drifted in and bumped third place finisher #9 Middleburg (Kazushi Kimura) in mid-stretch. Jockey Gutierrez has been ordered to attend a film review in our office tomorrow.

**REYLU GUTIERREZ FILM REVIEW (REF: 08/31/24)**

Jockey Reylu Gutierrez appeared in our office to watch film from yesterday's (Saturday August 31) 3<sup>rd</sup> Race which was contested at one mile on the Jimmy Durante Course (Turf). In this eleven (11) horse field. Jockey Gutierrez was aboard sixth place finisher #12 Nation. This race was for maidens, three (3) year olds and up. In mid-stretch #12 Nation drifts in and bumps #9 Middleburg (Kazushi Kamura). There was a 'General Inquiry' in this race as several inexperienced horses were racing erratically. Experienced horses or not Jockey Gutierrez has an obligation to make his best effort to maintain a straight course. He was cautioned to do so and left our informal hearing without a penalty.

**FRANK ALVARADO RULING**

Yesterday August 31 Jockey Frank Alvarado rode #12 Pineapple Juice to a second-place finish in the second race. While reviewing race replays of this six (6) furlong race the Stewards observed Jockey Alvarado use his riding crop seven (7) times during the race. Following yesterday's race Jockey Alvarado telephoned the Stewards, pled guilty and waived his right to a hearing. The following penalty has now been issued.

**DMTD RULING #38**

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3 - first offense), Jockey FRANK ALVARADO, who rode PINEAPPLE JUICE in the second race Purse (\$28,000.00) at Del Mar Race Track on August 31, 2024, is suspended for ONE (1) day (September 8, 2024), and fined TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)\* for one (1) strike over the limit.

**SECOND RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident in this 1 3/8ths mile turf course incident. As the field was racing down the backstretch a second time original second place finisher #5 Fireman Dan (Santiago Gonzalez) steadied very sharply off the heels of original first place finisher #7 Seven Wonders (Antonio Fresu). Film review of this race shows #7 Seven Wonders drift in with less than a 1/2 mile to the finish. #5 Fireman Dan and Jockey Gonzalez 'took up' sharply to avoid clipping the heels of #7 Seven Wonders. #5 Fireman Dan lost significant momentum following this incident.

The Stewards reviewed all available camera angles during this Stewards Inquiry. We also received a Patrol Judge report and spoke to the Jockeys involved. In a majority decision #7 Seven Wonders was disqualified and placed sixth. Steward Jauregui dissented. Jockey Antonio Fresu was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**ANTONIO FRESU FILM REVIEW (REF: 09/01/24 (3))**

Jockey Antonio Fresu appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the second race yesterday, September 1. He was accompanied at today's informal hearing, with Jockey Umberto Rispoli. Jockey Fresu was aboard original first place finisher #7 Seven Wonders who was disqualified and placed sixth for interference to original sixth place finisher #5 Fireman Dan (Santiago Gonzalez) inside the 1/2 mile pole. (Note: This race was 1 3/8 miles on the turf

course). Replays show #7 Seven Wonders shift in and impede rival #5 Fireman Dan, who lost significant ground in the incident. The majority felt Fresu looked prior to shifting in and that Jockey Gonzalez rushed his mount into harm's way. The minority (Steward Baker) felt this was a careless ride on Jockey Fresu's part He voted for a suspension and placed no blame on Jockey Gonzalez.

**FIFTH RACE INQUIRY-GENEROUS PORTION STAKES**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident approaching the ¼ pole. First place finisher #5 Hot Girl Walk (Antonio Fresu) crossed over in front of third place finisher #4 Cayucos (Kyle Frey) was 'put in tight' and checked his mount. Fifth place finisher #2 Thirsty In Vegas (Tyler Baze) then checked his mount and faded in the stretch.

#4 Cayucos was beaten fourteen (14) lengths for a better placing. #2 Thirsty in Vegas was beaten two (2) lengths for a better placing.

The Stewards spoke to the three (3) jockeys involved, received patrol judge reports and reviewed all camera angles of the incident. In a unanimous decision 'no change' was made in the order of finish. Jockey Antonio Fresu was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

**SIXTH RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW**

Public Address Announcer Trevor Denman announced that a Stewards' Review would be conducted into the start of today's sixth race. This race was contested at five (5) furlongs on the turf course. #5 Rebalation (Ricardo Gonzalez) left the starting gate very slowly. Race replays showed that this horse threw her head when the gates opened. This horse caused its own problems and there was no reason for a formal Inquiry.

**ELEVENTH RACE DELAY**

Today's eleventh race was delayed approximately eight (8) minutes. Three (3) horses broke through the starting gate as the field was just about set for formal dispatch. All the horses were examined by the track veterinarian and were cleared to participate. Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. (#11 Sharp Wonder) was unseated and examined by human ambulance personnel. He was cleared to ride his mount. The race itself was uneventful.
