THURSDAY ARMANDO AYUSO FILM REVIEW (REF: 10/27/24 (4))

Jockey Armando Ayuso appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the ninth race on closing day, October 27, 2024, at Santa Anita Park. He was accompanied by his agent, Rene Amescua.

Jockey Ayuso rode #9 Double Jab, who finished first but was disqualified and placed fourth in this 6 ½ furlong race that was contested on the Hillside Turf Course.

Today's film review shows #9 Double Jab got off his straight course, drifted in and forced the rider on #2 Lemon Sushi (Kyle Frey) to check his mount sharply. The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion that this was a careless ride. Both Jockey Ayuso and Agent Amescua appeared to understand our reasoning for issuing the following ruling.

DFTD Ruling #01

Jockey ARMANDO AYUSO, who rode DOUBLE JAB in the ninth race at Santa Anita Race Track on October 27, 2024, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 8, 9 and 10, 2024) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch, causing interference, resulting in a disqualification from first to fourth place; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699(Riding Rules– careless riding).

KAZUSHI KIMURA FILM REVIEW

Jockey Kazushi Kimura appeared in our office to review his ride in the sixth race at Santa Anita Park on Sunday October 27, 2024. He was accompanied by his agent Brian Beach. Jockey Kimura rode second place finisher #5 American Blessing in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. Shortly after the start #5 American Blessing drifted in and took the path of fifth (last) place finisher #4 This Name's Taken (Antonio Fresu). The Stewards felt Jockey Kimura could have exhibited more care in this race. He was cautioned to do so.

HECTOR BERRIOS FILM REVIEW

Jockey Hector Berrios appeared in the Stewards' office to review his winning ride in the third race on Sunday October 27, 2024 at Santa Anita Park. Jockey Berrios was aboard #5 Irideo (ARG) in this 6-furlong turf course event. The Stewards wanted to review Jockey Berrios' use of the riding crop during the stretch drive of this race. He was very active using his crop by taking his hand off his horse's neck and striking his mount left-handed. The majority felt today's film was inconclusive regarding the number of strikes. Steward Baker felt a 'crop violation' had occurred.

KYLE FREY FILM REVIEW

Jockey Kyle Frey appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the ninth race at Santa Anita Park on closing day, October 27, 2024. Jockey Frey was aboard #2 Lemon Sushi (placed third via disqualification) in this 6 ½ furlong downhill event. Jockey Frey broke out in this race. The Stewards excused Jockey Frey without a penalty.

JOCKEY'S GUILD REPRESENTATIVE

JUAN HERNANDEZ RULING

DFTD Ruling #02

Having violated the Horseracing and Safety Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3-second offense) Jockey JUAN HERNANDEZ, who rode NEWS AT TEN (GB) in the second race at Del Mar Race Track on October 31, 2024, is suspended for TWO (2) days (November 8 & 9, 2024), and fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)* for two (2) strikes over the limit.

(DMTD #19 8/10/2024 - Previous Crop Violation)

Yesterday, October 31, the Stewards took note of Jockey Juan Hernandez using his riding crop excessively. In the second race on this opening day card Jockey Hernandez rode #2 News At Ten (GB) to a second place finish in this five (5) furlong turf event. The Stewards observed Hernandez use his riding crop seven (7) times which is one strike over the limit.

This is Juan Hernandez' second riding crop violation in a six (6) month period. He waived his right to a hearing today and accepted the penalty.

BREEDERS' CUP JOCKEY MEETING

One (1) hour before the first race the Stewards met with the majority of jockey's that would ride during today's ten (10) race card. Safety Stewards David Nuesch and Paul Atkinson attended this meeting. CHRB Chief Steward Darrel McHargue was also in attendance, Three (3) representatives of the Japanese Racing Association (JRA). They are serving as interpreters for the six (6) Japanese jockeys that are in attendance this Breeders' Cup weekend. Proper use of the riding crop, how to lodge an objection and logistics surrounding the Jockey's Room, Paddock area and racing oval were discussed. Track Veterinarian Brent Cassady was also introduced to the majority of the forty-eight (48) jockeys that are scheduled to ride here today.

TENTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the 18th Running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (Grade 1, \$1,000,000 Guaranteed). This race was contested at one mile on the turf course.

This Stewards' Inquiry involved three (3) horses. In numerical order those horses were:

#4 Al Qudra (IRE) (James Doyle—8th Place)

#7 Seagulls Eleven (IRE) (Luis Saez—9th Place)
 #11 New Century (GB) (Oslin Murphy—4th Place)

In the stretch run of this race #4 Al Qudra (IRE) attempted to ‘split horses’ at the 1/8th pole location. While doing so #4 Al Qudra makes contact with #7 Seagulls Eleven (IRE) and #11 New Century (GB). Al Qudra (IRE) then clips heels, bobbles and Jockey James Doyle loses his right iron. The Stewards closely analyzed the actions of all three (3) horses while reviewing all camera angles of the incident. We received reports from the three (3) Patrol Judge’s and spoke to the three (3) Jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision the Stewards made no change in the original order of finish.

PAUL MC ENTEE INFORMAL MEETING

Yesterday November 1, Horse Identifier Jennifer Paige called the Stewards and reported that #6 Jet Sweep Joe was late to the receiving barn for the sixth race. This race was the \$1,000,000 Breeder’s Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint (Grade 1). Trainer Paul McEntee was told to appear in our office to discuss the situation.

Trainer McEntee told the Stewards that he heard the 20-minute call over the sound system in the stable area. He thought that call was meant for participants (horses) to depart their barns in 20 minutes and head to the receiving barn. The ‘20-minute call’

means that all horses should arrive in the receiving barn in 20 minutes. The field of horses was held up six (6) to eight (8) minutes before all participants were sent to the saddling paddock. Trainer McEntee was very apologetic to the Stewards and understood the reasoning behind the following ruling that was issued in what was a unanimous decision.

DFTD Ruling #03

Trainer PAUL McENTEE, who started JET SWEEP JOE, in the sixth race on November 1, 2024 at Del Mar Race Track is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer) for violation of rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn – late arrival).

PACO LOPEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Paco Lopez appeared in the Stewards' Office to review his ride in yesterday's sixth race. This was the \$1,000,000 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint (Grade I) that was contested at five (5) furlongs on the turf course. Jockey Lopez was aboard third place finisher #10 Governor Sam.

Today's film review shows #10 Governor Sam being involved in two (2) incidents.

Incident 1- #10 Governor Sam drops to his inside quickly, putting pressure and making contact with twelfth (last) place finisher #9 Shareholder (William Buick) This also leads to contact with inside rival, eighth place finisher #8 Ecoro Sieg (Christophe Lemaire).

Incident #2- Several strides further down the backside #10 Governor Sam continues to put pressure on rivals to his inside and as a result of that, both fourth place finisher #3 Big Mojo (IRE) (Tom Marquand) and sixth place finisher #2 Aesterius (IRE). The pressure ultimately led to bumping between these horses.

Four (4) horses were ultimately affected by the actions of Jockey Paco Lopez. He seemed to agree with the Stewards assessment that this was a careless ride. Our decision was unanimous and the following ruling was issued.

DFTD Ruling #04

Jockey PACO LOPEZ, who rode GOVERNOR SAM in the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on November 1, 2024, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 9, 10 & 15, 2024) for failure to maintain a straight course on the backside, causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 Riding Rules – careless riding).

ANOTHER JOCKEY MEETING

Fifty-four (54) jockey's from around the world are scheduled to ride on today's Breeders' Cup Saturday twelve (12) race card. Today the Stewards reviewed the Jockey protocol that was discussed in our pre-race meeting yesterday. We briefly discussed yesterday's racing. We also talked about Paddock, Quick Official , Outrider and Veterinarian protocol.

11/02/24⁴

FIFTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after reviewing an incident approaching the 1/16th pole. The Stewards observed seventh place finisher #10 Isivunguvungu (SAF) steady sharply. First place finisher #4 Starlust (GB) (Rossa Ryan) was closing rapidly in the stretch drive of this five-furlong \$1,000,000 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (Grade

l). Fifth place finisher #9 Cogburn (Irado Ortiz Jr.) drifted out at the 1/16-mile marker. While closing very strongly #4 Starlust (GB) swings out around the drifting out #9 Cogburn thereby forcing #10 Isivunguvungu (SAF) to steady.

The Stewards reviewed all camera angles (including drone-cam) during what was a lengthy Inquiry. We spoke to the Jockeys involved and received a Patrol Judge report. In a unanimous decision the Stewards allowed the original placings to stand. Jockey Rossa Ryan was ordered to film review tomorrow in the Stewards' office.

DRAYDEN VAN DYKE FILM REVIEW

Jockey Drayden Van Dyke appeared in the Stewards' office following his victory in the PNC Bank \$1,000,000 Guaranteed Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. He was accompanied by his agent Ryan Cosato. Jockey Van Dyke rode #8 Soul of an Angel in this seven (7) furlong main track event.

Today's film review shows Jockey Van Dyke strike his mount seven (7) times in this race. That is one (1) strike over what is allowable by HISA rules. Jockey Van Dyke agreed with the Stewards analysis that he violated HISA rule #2282. He has received two (2) riding crop penalties recently (9/14/24 & 10/25/24) in Florida. Jockey Van Dyke's winning jockey fee for this race was \$52,000. Per HISA Rule #2283 (Multiple Violations of Rule 2280) the fine portion (\$15,600) of the ruling listed below is three (3) times 10% of the Jockey fee he received for this race.

Jockey Van Dyke pled guilty to the violation and made no mention of using his crop for safety purposes.

DFTD Ruling #05

Having violated the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3 – third offense), Jockey DRAYDEN VAN DYKE, who rode SOUL OF AN ANGEL in the fourth race (Purse \$1,000,000-Breeders Cup Filly & Mare Sprint Grade 1) at Del Mar Race Track on November 2, 2024, is suspended for THREE (3) days (November 10, 15, & 16, 2024), and fined FIFTEEN THOUSAND AND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$15,600.00)* for one (1) strike over the limit.

ROSSA RYAN FILM REVIEW (REF:11/2/24 (4))

Jockey Rossa Ryan was involved in a Stewards' inquiry in yesterday's (November 2) fifth race. This was the \$1,000,000 Prevagen Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint which was contested at five (5) furlongs. Jockey Ryan was not available as he has returned to the United Kingdom. He was represented today by Dale Gibson who stated he was the Racing Director of the Professional Jockey Association in the United Kingdom.

Jockey Ryan rode #4 Starlust (GB) to a first-place finish. Inside the 1/16th pole #4 Starlust (GB) drifts out and bumps seventh place finisher #10 Isivungungu (SAF) (Manuel Franco), forcing that rival to steady. Prior to this drift fifth place finisher #9 Cogburn (SAF) did not maintain a straight course and #4 Starlust (GB) 'threaded the needle' to get the victory. The Stewards told Jockey Representative Gibson that regardless of the actions of Irad Ortiz Jr., Jockey Rossa needed to be more cautious while passing other horses was the message that the Stewards shared with Representative Gibson. In a unanimous decision no penalty was issued.
