CROP VIOLATION

Jockey **Pedro Flores** met with the Stewards this morning to review his actions in the fifth (5) race on Friday, November 8, 2024. After watching the race replay with the Stewards, Jockey **Flores** agreed that he struck his horse once (1) over the allowed limit.

GSRP RULING #5

Jockey **PEDRO FLORES** who rode **AFTER MY OWN HEART** in the fifth race at Pleasanton (Golden State Racing) on November 8, 2024, is suspended two (2) days, November 16 & 17, 2024 and fine FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) pursuant to Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority (HISA) Rule #2282 (Riding Crop Violations and Penalties – Class 3, one strike over the limit). For violation of HISA Rules #2280 (Use of Riding Crop) and #2283 (Multiple Violations of Rule #2280 – second offense within 180 days).

Big Fresno Fair Ruling #08, dated October 12, 2024

California Horse Racing Board Rule #1766 (b) – The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in Designated Races in California.

Jockey **Francisco Monroy** came into the Steward’s office this morning to apologize for not fulfilling his Jockey Engagement.

GSRP RULING #6

Jockey **FRANCISCO MONROY** who was scheduled to ride on November 8, 2024, at Golden State Racing (Pleasanton), is fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) * for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Engagements).

STEWARDS INQUIRY – 5TH RACE

The Stewards ordered the inquiry lit to look at the actions at the start of the race. After reviewing the race, the Stewards found that #6 **Leedsthesky** caused her own problem and was declared a starter.

LATE SCRATCH – 8TH RACE

Jockey **Antongeorgi** who was scheduled to ride #1 **Montana** in the 8TH race was excused from riding after the first race when he was experiencing back spasms. **Dr. Seftel** recommended that he not ride the rest of the day.

Jockey **Luis Jimenez** accepted the mount and while loading into the starting gate, #1 **Montana** became fractious in the gate and **Jimenez** injured his hand. **Jimenez** was examined by the doctor who recommended to the Stewards that he be excused from riding the race. Jockey **Epifanio Garcia** accepted the mount, however the four-year-old gelding

continued to act up in the starting gate and was a late scratch by order of the Stewards, on advice of **Dr. Cloninger**.
