ENTRY DAY

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Sunday, May 25, 2025. Steward Kim Sawyer was on duty in the Stewards' office. Seventy-seven (77) horses are scheduled to start.

Racing Secretary Jason Egan and his staff compiled a good eleven (11) race card for Monday May 26. Steward Grant Baker was on duty in the Stewards' office. Ninety (90) horses are scheduled to start on this Memorial Day card.

GABRIEL MARTINEZ HEARING (CASE # 24-HI-208)

The CHRB has filed a complaint against Stable Foreman Gabriel Martinez for alleged violation of HISA Rule #2230(e) (Treatment Restrictions). The alleged incident in this case took place on June 22, 2024, at Los Alamitos Race Course. CHRB Investigator Barrett Halcromb prepared a twenty (20) page complaint packet for this hearing. This hearing was chaired by Steward David Nuesch, who heard the matter along with Stewards Baker and Sawyer. Steward Jauregui was not working this hearing as he was a potential witness. The cover page of this complaint reads as follows:

CHRB Investigators conducted a vehicle search of Foreman Gabriel Martinez vehicle after he was observed with a syringe approaching a horse entered to race later that day. Investigators discovered contraband, including syringes, needles and injectable medication in the center console of the vehicle.

Present for today's hearing was CHRB Supervising Investigator Mike Barker, CHRB Investigator Barrett Halcromb, HISA Attorney Rebecca Price (Microsoft Teams), HISA Interpreter Brenda Jones (Microsoft Teams), Court Reporter Andy Hsiao (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) and Respondent Gabriel Martinez.

At the opening of the hearing, Stable Foreman Martinez requested to have this formal hearing continued to give him time to obtain legal counsel. This Stewards took a short recess, reconvened and announced that this matter will be continued on Thursday, July 3, 2025, at Los Alamitos Race Course. Start time will be 9:30 a.m.

OCTAVIO MENDOZA COMPLAINT (CASE #25SA0028)

The CHRB has filed a complaint against Groom Octavio Mendoza for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and Rule #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing). The cover page of this complaint reads as follows.

On February 20, 2025, at approximately 1000 hours, the Arcadia Police Department arrived at Santa Anita investigating a carjacking and theft that occurred off the property. APD tracked the stolen vehicle's location at Santa Anita. APD obtained video surveillance footage of the stolen vehicle, and it showed the vehicle entering Santa Anita's Association gate. Santa Anita Security identified the suspect as the Groom Octavio Mendoza. Mendoza was arrested by APD and confessed to stealing the vehicle and victim's property.

CHRB Investigator Octavio Vergara Jr. appeared for this case before the Stewards. Groom Octavio Mendoza failed to appear for today's hearing. More to follow.

STEWARDS' COMMITTEE MEETING

Our quarterly CHRB Stewards Committee Meeting was held today utilizing the Microsoft Teams format. The members of the CHRB Stewards Committee are CHRB Chairman Dr. Greg Ferraro, Commissioner Dennis Alfieri and Commissioner Brenda Washington Davis. CHRB Executive Director Scott Chaney and Chief Steward Darrel McHargue chaired today's meeting. Seven (7) agenda items were discussed.

SERGIO SALGUERO RULING (REF: CAL EXPO RULING #73 – 05/01/25)

Owner Sergio Salguero failed to appear for a hearing at the Cal Expo Standardbred Meet in Sacramento. Kim Kuhlmann DMV/ San Francisco Equine, Inc. has alleged that Owner Salguero owes his equine medical group \$10,825.32 for services provided. A Financial Complaint agreement signed by Sergio Salguero and Dr. Kuhlmann has now been implemented.

Owner Salguero agrees to pay Dr. Kuhlmann \$1000.00 a month until the entire bill is paid in full. The following ruling reinstates the license privileges of Sergio Salguero.

LATS RULING #84

Owner SERGIO SALGUERO, having complied with the provisions of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility - \$10,835.32 to Dr. Kim Kuhlmann/San Francisco Equine, Inc.) is restored to good standing. Ruling CHRC #073, issued at Cal Expo Harness Racing Association on May 1, 2025, is set aside.

OCTAVIO MENDOZA RULING (CASE # 25SA0028)

Groom Octavio Mendoza failed to appear for a hearing in the Santa Anita Stewards' Office yesterday, May 22 (REF: 05/22/25²). The following ruling suspends his license privileges.

LATS RULING #85

Groom OCTAVIO MENDOZA having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Santa Anita Park on or before May 22, 2025, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear), pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer to charges alleging violation of CHRB rules #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing – Theft) and #1874 (Disorderly Conduct). Suspension to commence on May 23, 2025.

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of OCTAVIO MENDOZA are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

FIRST RACE ACCIDENT/INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an accident in this 6 ½ furlong turf (chute) event. #1 The Old Nine (IRE) (Umberto Rispoli) finished first in this five (5) horse field and was not involved in this incident.

Approaching the 1/16th pole second place finisher #3 Mongolian Altai (Armando Aguilar) angles in to the rail in front of #5 Navy Jack (GB) (Kyle Frey). The early race leader, #4 White Mountain (Adrian Escobedo) was racing erratically while in front of the field. Jockey Kyle Frey steadied sharply in an attempt to avoid the heels of #3 Mongolian Altai. He failed to do so, clipped heels and unseated Jockey Frey. #5 Navy Jack (GB) fell in this incident and slid for a distance after the fall.

Jockey Kyle Frey was transported to a local hospital for examination. #5 Navy Jack (GB) was vanned back to Trainer Peter Miller's barn for examination. Early reports of Jockey Frey and Navy Jack (GB) were encouraging as neither horse nor rider sustained significant injuries.

The Stewards spoke to Jockeys Aguilar and Escobedo following the incident. We also reviewed several camera angles and received a Patrol Judge report. In a majority vote, second place finisher #3 Mongolian Altai was disqualified and placed as unplaced. Steward Jauregui voted to disqualify fourth place finisher #4 White Mountain and place that horse unplaced for his actions. Jockeys Armando Aguilar and Adrian Escobedo were ordered to film review tomorrow with the Stewards.

SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident at about the 5/16ths marker. This race was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. Race replays show first place finisher #4 Beef Winslow (Abel Lezcano) make contact with fifth place finisher #3 Heart Headed (Juan Hernandez). This brush causes #3 Heart Headed to make contact with the inner turf rail.

The Stewards reviewed all camera angles, received a Patrol Judge report and spoke to both jockeys involved. In an unanimous decision, there was no change made in

the order of finish. Jockey Abel Lezcano was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

ARMANDO AGUILAR FILM REVIEW (REF: 05/23/25³)

Jockey Armando Aguilar appeared in the Stewards’ office to review his ride in the first race yesterday, May 23. In this 6 ½ furlong (turf-chute) event, Jockey Aguilar was aboard original second place finisher #3 Mongolian Altai who was disqualified and placed unplaced for his involvement in an accident.

Today’s film review shows #3 Mongolian Altai angle inward towards the rail approaching the 1/16th pole. Jockey Aguilar failed to give rival #5 Navy Jack (GB) (Kyle Frey) sufficient clearance and forced this rival to clip his heels and fall to the turf. Jockey Aguilar did “point out” another erratic rival in this race but ultimately accepted responsibility for his own actions, which led to the accident. He also displayed remorse for this incident to the Stewards. We are fortunate to report that Jockey Frey has been medically cleared to return to riding. Track Veterinarian Jay Deluhery reported that #5 Navy Jack (GB) has no significant injuries.

Following deliberation Jockey Aguilar was informed of our unanimous decision listed below in ruling form.

LATS RULING #86

Jockey ARMANDO AGUILAR, who rode MONGOLIAN ALTAI in the first race at Santa Anita Park on May 23, 2025, is suspended for SEVEN (7) racing days (June 7, 8, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 20, 2025) for crossing over without sufficient

clearance in the stretch, causing an accident, resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to unplaced; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

ADRIAN ESCOBEDO FILM REVIEW (REF: 05/23/25³)

Jockey Adrian Escobedo appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the first race yesterday May 23. Jockey Escobedo was aboard fourth place finisher #4 White Mountain who was placed third following a Stewards' Inquiry. The Stewards wanted to review Jockey Escobedo's actions in the stretch drive of this 6 ½ furlong event on the turf course.

Entering the stretch #4 White Mountain drifted out and then later drifted in while racing in this five (5) horse field. There was an accident approaching the 1/16 pole and the Stewards wanted to determine if Jockey Escobedo has any involvement in the incident. While Steward opinions varied, what was agreed upon is that that Jockey Escobedo failed to keep a straight course in the stretch and that this was a careless ride. Jockey Escobedo understood the Stewards analysis.

The majority voted for the following ruling. Steward Jauregui voted for a 5 day riding suspension.

LATS RULING #87

Jockey ADRIAN ESCOBEDO, who rode WHITE MOUNTAIN in the first race at Santa Anita Park on May 23, 2025, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 7, 8, and 12, 2025) for failure to maintain a straight course in the stretch; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

ABEL LEZCANO FILM REVIEW (REF:5/23/25⁴)

Jockey Abel Lezcano appeared in the Stewards office to review his involvement in yesterday's seventh race. He was accompanied by his agent Ryan Glatt. There was a Stewards' Inquiry in this race.

Race replays show Jockey Lezcano, aboard first place finisher #4 Beef Winslow, lay on fifth place finisher #3 Heart Headed (Juan Hernandez) going into the far turn of this one (1) mile turf race. The Stewards told Jockey Lezcano that his ride yesterday was not safe and future efforts of this nature could likely result in disciplinary action. Warning issued.

JOCKEY KYLE FREY

Jockey Kyle Frey made an unannounced visit to the Stewards' Office today. Jockey Frey wanted to review yesterday's first race in which he was involved in an accident. Jockey Frey was aboard #5 Navy Jack (GB), who clipped heels and fell in this race. Jockey Frey looked well and will be re-evaluated by the Track Physician before participating in today's races.

FIVE O COCKTAIL DISQUALIFICATION

HIWU (Horseracing Integrity and Welfare Unit) notified our office that the time to appeal for Trainer Miguel Ramirez has expired. The following ruling involves a disqualification from Race 6 at Santa Anita Park on January 17, 2025.

LATS RULING #88

After receiving notice from Horseracing Integrity and Welfare Unit (HIWU), the following horse, FIVE O COCKTAIL, was disqualified for a positive test sample from Race 6 at Santa Anita Park on January 17, 2025, Case #ECM2025-34/ECM. The Consequences of Disqualification results included forfeiture of all purses and other compensation, prizes, trophies, points and rankings and repayment or surrender (as applicable) of such to the Race Organizer (ADMC Program Rule 3321 – Disqualification of the Covered Horse's Results).

It is further ordered that all purse monies earned or awarded to Owners BASELINE EQUINE LLC, NATHANIEL GORHAM and JANALIN SHULER, Jockey HUGO HERRERA and Trainer MIGUEL RAMIREZ be returned to the Paymaster of Purses at Santa Anita Park on or before June 24, 2025, for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to Be Withheld).

Revised Order of Finish:

5th TIGER QUEEN

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) neither pari-mutuel payoffs nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.

FIRST RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW

The Stewards announced that a Stewards' Review would be conducted into this race that was contested at 4 ½ furlongs on the main track. The Stewards wanted to review the actions of fourth place finisher #6 Southern Melodee (Edwin Maldonado) who literally stood in the starting gate after Starter Jay Slender dispatched the field. After review, the Stewards felt there was no reason for a formal Inquiry. Stewards unanimously determined that this colt caused his own issues.

SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the ¼ mile pole. Stewards viewed fourth place finisher #3 Cee's the Image (Welfin Orantes) clip the heels of third place finisher #2 Gypsy Lynn (Edgar Payeras).

The Stewards spoke to both Jockeys involved, received a Patrol Judge Report and viewed all camera angles of the incident.

The Stewards determined that Apprentice Jockey Orantes was nearly unseated after racing up onto the heels of #2 Gypsy Lynn. There was 'no change' made to the order of finish. Apprentice Orantes was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

SEVENTH RACE VOIDED CLAIM

#3 Cee's the Image was claimed for \$10,000 in today's seventh race. After an examination following the race CHRB Veterinarian Nolton Pattio informed the Stewards that this horse was lame. We voided the claim and informed the proper officials involved. This horse now returns to the barn of original trainer Felix Rondan.

TENTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the ¼ pole location. This race was contested at 6 ½ furlongs (Turf-Chute). Race replays show fourth place finisher #2 Ride Elbow Ranch (Abel Lezcano) drift in and bump eighth place finisher #1 Butterfly Beach (Armando Aguilar). The bump was significant, but the Stewards felt that #1 Butterfly Beach was tiring at the time of the incident.

The Stewards received a Patrol Judge Report, spoke to both Jockeys involved and reviewed all camera angles of the incident. In a unanimous vote, the Stewards made no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Abel Lezcano was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

ARMANDO AGUILAR FILM REVIEW

Jockey Armando Aguilar appeared in our office, for the second time this racing week, for a film review with the Stewards. The race we reviewed was Race 1 yesterday Sunday May 25. This race was contested at 4 ½ furlongs on the main track.

Jockey Aguilar rode third place finisher #1 Mr. Pippins. While racing at the ¼ pole location this horse drifts out and bumps seventh (last) place finisher #5 Mesa Verde (Kyle Frey). Jockey Aguilar was issued a warning for this ride. Steward Sawyer believed a suspension was in order for this ride. He was issued a seven (7) day suspension (REF: 5/24/25¹) for a ride on May 23 here at Santa Anita.

WELFIN ORANTES FILM REVIEW (REF: 05/25/25³)

Apprentice Jockey Welfin Orantes appeared in our office to review his ride in the seventh race yesterday, May 25. Apprentice Orantes was aboard #3 Cee's the Image, who finished fourth in this six (6) furlong main track event. In this race #3 Cee's the Image races up behind third place finisher #2 Gypsy Lynn (Edgar Payeras) and clips her heels. This causes #3 Cee's the Image to stumble and nearly unseat Apprentice Orantes. He was cautioned to 'pick his head up' and utilize more caution as similar actions could lead to unsafe conditions for both him and other jockeys and horses. Warning issued.

ABEL LEZCANO FILM REVIEW

Jockey Abel Lezcano appeared in the Stewards Office to review his ride in the tenth race yesterday, May 25. Jockey Lezcano was aboard #2 Ride Elbow Ranch, who finished fourth, in this 6 ½ furlong (Turf) event. There was a Stewards' Inquiry (REF: 5/25/25⁵) held after this race. Today's review shows Jockey Lezcano strike his mount on the shoulder, with his riding crop in the downward position. This caused his horse to drift in and bump #1 Butterfly Beach (Armando Aguilar) inside the ¼ mile pole. The Stewards felt Jockey Lezcano's ride was careless. On May 23 Jockey Lezcano was also involved in a Stewards Inquiry (REF: 5/23/25⁴). For his ride yesterday, the following ruling was issued in a unanimous decision. Jockey Lezcano displayed some anger in our office when informed of the decision

LATS RULING #89

Jockey ABEL LEZCANO, who rode RIDE ELBOW RANCH in the tenth race at Santa Anita Park on May 25, 2025, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 12, 13, and 14, 2025) for failure to maintain his path in the turn; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules-careless riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

SECOND RACE VOIDED CLAIM

Fifth place finisher #3 Looks Rare was claimed for \$16,000 in today's second race. Following examination of the horse in the Receiving Barn CHRB Veterinarian Nolton Pattio VMD informed us this horse was determined to be unsound. The Stewards subsequently voided the claim and informed all of the proper parties.

FOURTH RACE JOCKEY OBJECTION

Following the running of this race Jockey Assael Espinoza lodged a Jockeys Objection against first place finisher #2 Wound Up (Kyle Frey) for alleged interference in the stretch. Jockey Espinoza finished second aboard #3 Grubauer in this 6 ½ furlong main track event. Film review of this race shows #2 Wound Up drift out for various portions of this race.

The Stewards felt that #2 Wound Up was always 'clear' of #3 Grubauer during the stretch drive of this race. After speaking to both Jockey's involved and talking to the Patrol Judges, the Stewards made 'no change' in the order of finish. Jockey Kyle Frey was ordered to film review with the Stewards.
