A meeting was held to review the protocol regarding the extreme heat expected in Southern California today. Present in the office were Senior Vice President & General Manager Nate Newby, Director of Racing & Racing Secretary Jason Egan, Senior Vice President Amy Zimmerman, Safety Steward Paul Atkinson, CTT Executive Director Alan Balch, Equine Medical Director Dr. Jeff Blea and Jockeys Guild Darrell Haire. We set up a procedure that will protect all horses and riders participating today.

05/30/25³**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE**

We posted the inquiry sign to review the sixth race involving the top two finishers, the winner #6 Cupid's Crusaders (H. Berrios) and the second-place horse #8 Pratchett (A. Ayuso) in the stretch. After speaking to both riders and reviewing the race several times, we made no change to the order of finish. We unanimously voted that the contact between both horses was mutual and did not warrant a disqualification.

We conducted a Stewards' review to look at the #4 Kid Dynasty (A. Fresu) who stumbled as he left the starting gate for the third race. After a review of the race, we determined that the #4 stumbled on his own, at no fault of any other participant; therefore, no inquiry was conducted.

JOCKEY OBJECTION/NO CHANGE

The objection sign was lit after the jockey of the second-place horse #5 Halo Rando (T. Pereira) against the winner #2 Haywood(E. Maldonado) for an incident turning into the stretch. After speaking to both riders and reviewing the video several times, we made no change. In our opinion (Unanimous) the #5 drove into a spot without sufficient space, consequently, no change was made.
