**Report for Monday, June 2, 2025 through Sunday, June 8, 2025.**

**MONDAY**06/02/25<sup>1</sup>**DARK DAY ENTRIES**

Luis Jauregui was in attendance to oversee the entry process for Saturday (10 races) and to approve the program for Friday (9 races).

**TUESDAY**06/03/25<sup>1</sup>**STEWARD DUTIES**

Grant Baker was present to observe the entry routine in the Racing Secretary's office for Sunday (9 races) and make necessary decisions when needed.

**THURSDAY**06/05/25<sup>1</sup>**MARAVILLA FORMAL HEARING CASE 25SA0056**

In attendance before the Board of Stewards were CHRB Staff Counsel Jacquelyn Loyd, CHRB Investigator Anne Dillon and Court Reporter Andy Hsiao of Weinstein Court Reporters, LLC. Appearing via Microsoft Teams were respondent Jorge Maravilla and translator Aura Tinoco-Abba. Also observing via Teams was CHRB Supervising Investigator Mike Barker.

The complaint read as follows:

*On March 25, 2025, Trainer Jorge Maravilla entered ROY HOBBS to run in the 9th race at Santa Anita Park on Sunday March 30, 2025. The racing program was published and ROY HOBBS was one of the two favorites with 9/2 odds, along with another horse trained by Maravilla named MAJOR TOM with 5/2 odds. According to ship in/out records, Maravilla shipped ROY HOBBS to Emerald Downs later that same day. On March 29, Veterinarian Dr. Kim Kuhlmann reportedly examined the horse at Pleasanton and recommended it should be scratched from the race the next day because of a respiratory infection. ROY HOBBS was not in California when this exam was reportedly performed. Dr. Kuhlmann sent a recommendation for veterinary*

*scratch to the Official Veterinarian at Santa Anita at approximately 07:52 hours on March 30, which was received and processed before wagering opened for the day.*

Grant Baker chaired the hearing, testimony was given and considered, documents were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed. Decision to follow.

**KUHLMANN FORMAL HEARING CASE 25SA0060**

Present before the Board of Stewards were CHRB Staff Counsel Jacquelyn Loyd, CHRB Investigator Anne Dillon, Attorneys Leif Harrison Kleven and Drew Couto for respondent Veterinarian Kim Kuhlmann, and Court Reporter Andy Hsiao of Weinstein Court Reporter, LLC.

The complaint read as follows:

*On March 25, 2025, Trainer Jorge Maravilla entered ROY HOBBS to run in the 9th race at Santa Anita Park the following Sunday. Attending Veterinarian Dr. Kim Kuhlmann examined ROY HOBBS in Pleasanton on March 25th, and issued a health certificate clearing the horse for shipment to Emerald Downs in Washington the following day. ROY HOBBS arrived at Emerald Downs on March 26, 2025.*

*According to the Recommendation for Veterinary Scratch completed by Dr. Kuhlmann, he examined ROY HOBBS at Pleasanton on March 29, and recommended scratching the horse from the race at Santa Anita the following day because of a respiratory infection. Dr. Kuhlmann reportedly examined the horse and treated it with oral antibiotics. ROY HOBBS was not in California when this exam was reportedly performed. Dr. Kuhlmann did not document the health certificate or the examination that led to the scratch in the Electronic Treatments Records Database (EquiTAPS).*

Again, Steward Baker chaired the hearing, testimony was given by, Santa Anita Director of Racing/ Racing Secretary Jason Eagan (subpoenaed by attorney of respondent) out of order due to time limits. CHRB Investigator Anne Dillon testified next for the CHRB. As the testimony given was lengthy, a continuance of this hearing was necessary. The CHRB calendar for hearings is full until the Del Mar summer meet; therefore, this hearing will be continued until then.

After a review of the videos, a report from the Patrol Judge and conversation with the jockey, the original order of finish was made official. #2 on her own started to false break prior to the stall doors opening, causing her own problems. In a unanimous decision, the horse was declared a starter.

**MARAVILLA RULING ref-06-05-25<sup>1</sup>**

The following ruling was issued after aggravating and mitigating evidence was taken into consideration. It was validated Mr. Maravilla entered his horse, "Roy Hobbs" on May 25, 2025 to race on May 30, 2025 and then shipped that horse to Emerald Downs on May 26, 2025. His private veterinarian submitted an official "Recommendation for Veterinarian Scratch" form to the Santa Anita Official Veterinarian's office on May 30, 2025 at 7:52 am.

**LATS RULING #91**

Trainer JORGE MARAVILLA, who was scheduled to start the horse ROY HOBBS in the ninth race at Santa Anita Park on March 30, 2025, is fined FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1581.1 (Entries – Not a bonafide entry).

**INQUIRY /NO CHANGE /FOURTH RACE — ¾ dirt**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the actions of #1 Icy Mischief (K. Frey DNF). Inside the ¼ pole the horse appeared to veer inward and lose her action. After a review of the video and a report from the Patrol Judge, it was verified no other horses were involved and the race was made official.

**INQUIRY /NO CHANGE /SEVENTH RACE — 1 1/8 turf**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident approaching the finish line. Involved were #1 Final Boss (J. Hernandez 1<sup>st</sup>) and #7 Genius Jimmy (K. Kimura 2<sup>nd</sup>). After a review of the videos, a report from the Patrol Judge and conversation with both jockeys, in a unanimous decision the original order of finish was made official. There was contact between the two horses close to the finish line; this action did not warrant a disqualification as the original order of finish was not affected.
