**Report for the week of Wednesday, July 30, 2025, through Sunday, August 3, 2025.**

### **WEDNESDAY**

07/30/25<sup>1</sup>

#### **ENTRY DAY**

The racing office was open today accepting entries for Saturday August 2. Racing Secretary David Jerkens and his staff put together an attractive eleven (11) race card. Ninety-nine (99) horses are scheduled to face Starter Jay Slender. Steward Kim Swayer was on duty overseeing matters for the CHRB today.

#### **TRIPLE M RACING STABLE LLC (CASE #25SR0010)**

The Stewards held an informal hearing today for the stable name, Triple M Racing Stable LLC. This hearing originated on July 3, 2025, at the recently concluded Los Angeles County Fair Meet at Los Alamitos. On this date McKinley McPherson sent the Stewards a letter requesting a continuance. She also stated in the letter that she would pay the bill in question (\$11,470.00).

We conducted a hearing on Microsoft Teams today. Trainer Monte Schvaneveldt appeared in the CHRB Investigators office at San Luis Rey Downs. CHRB Investigator Steven Manilla prepared the complaint in this matter and also assisted with the Microsoft Teams set-up at San Luis Rey Downs. CHRB Investigator Anne Dillon assisted the Stewards here at Del Mar. Trainer Schvaneveldt told the Stewards that the father of McKinley McPherson, Owner (suspended) Steve McPherson handed Trainer Schvaneveldt a check for \$16,050 this morning at San Luis Rey Downs. Trainer Schvaneveldt was told by Steve McPherson that the check would clear after 2:00 p.m. Friday August 1.

McKinley McPherson failed to appear for today's hearing. The Stewards will now wait until this weekend to see if the check clears before reaching a final decision in this matter.

**DR. KIM KUHLMANN COMPLAINT (CASE #25SA0060)**

The CHRB has filed a complaint against Veterinarian Kim Kuhlmann for alleged violation of CHRB Rule #1842 (Veterinarian Report) and Rule #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Racing). This complaint was originally heard on June 5, 2025 (REF: SA Minutes 06/25/25 (2) at Santa Anita Park. Due to time constraints that hearing was continued to today's date. CHRB Investigator Anne Dillon prepared today's twenty-six (26) page complaint. Along with Ms. Dillon, Respondent Kuhlmann was accompanied by Attorneys Drew Couto and Leif Kleven. CHRB Staff Counsel Jacquelyn Loyd represented the CHRB. Witnesses called by Dr. Kuhlmann's attorneys today were CHRB Official Veterinarian Nolton Pattio and Santa Anita Racing Coordinator Steve Martinelli, who testified via telephone. Court Reporter Michelle Derieg (Weinstein's Court Reporters LLC) transcribed the proceedings. Today's portion of this hearing lasted 3 ½ hours. Documents were marked as exhibits. Witnesses and Dr. Kuhlmann were examined by the lawyers and Stewards. Steward Grant Baker chaired the hearing. The Stewards will now deliberate before rendering a decision. More to follow.

**ARMANDO AYUSO FILM REVIEW (REF: 07/27/25 (4))**

Jockey Armando Ayuso appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the second race on Sunday July 27. He was accompanied today by his agent Mike Ciani. Jockey Ayuso was aboard #4 Arrowthegreat who finished first but was disqualified and placed second in the second race on July 27.

Today's review shows #4 Arrowthegreat drift out prior to Jockey Ayuso making contact with second place finisher #3 Ultimate Guide (Kazushi Kimura). Following the contact, Jockey Ayuso straightened his mount. The correction after contact and Jockey Ayuso's own accountability at today's hearing today were mitigating factors in our decision following this review. Jockey Ayuso was issued a 'Warning' in what was a unanimous decision.

**DEBRA BARKLEY RULING**

Debra Barkley a partner in GMT Racing Stables,' was issued the following penalty. Ms. Barkley told her trainer that she did not want to run #5 Ashcroft in the 2nd Race, Sunday July 27. The Stewards therefore scratched this horse at her request. Ms. Barkley had an issue with Trainer Robert Hess Jr., in a matter that was unrelated to the horse Ashcroft. This scratch reduced the field of horses for this race down to four (4). All show wagers made in this race were refunded in accordance with CHRB Rule #1954 (Parimutuel Pools). This decision was unanimous.

**DMTD Ruling #14**

Owner DEBRA BARKLEY, who was scheduled to start ASHCROFT in the second race on July 27, 2025 at Del Mar Race Track, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration- Owner didn't want to run.)

**NOTEWORTHY CLAIM**

In today's second race the Hector Palma trained #6 Mr. A. P. finished second in this 5 ½ furlong race. Trainer Vladimir Cerin claimed this two-year old ridgling, who is a son of American Pharoah, for \$150,000.

07/31/25<sup>3</sup>

**SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident in this race, inside the final 1/16th of a mile. This was a 1 1/16th mile race contested by ten (10) horses on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course.

Several horses were involved in a race that had significant confusion in the final 1/16th of a mile. Fifth place finisher #5 Johanny (Kyle Frey), attempted to enter a tight opening prior to 'checking' his mount. Second place finisher #10 Vibeze (Hector Berrios) was bumped by #5 Johanny who was attempting to enter a tight opening. Fourth place finisher #9 Candy Bar (Tyler Baze) drifted out in final stages of this race.

In a unanimous vote, there was 'No Change' made in the original placings. Jockey Kyle Frey and Tyler Baze were ordered to film review.

**RICHARD MANDELLA HEARING (CASE #25SA0111)**

Trainer Richard Mandella appeared in our office today to respond to a complaint filed by the CHRB for alleged violations of CHRB Rule #1878 (Workouts). CHRB Investigator Hiroshi Yokoyama, who prepared today's complaint, participated on the Microsoft Teams format, from Santa Anita Park. CHRB Investigator Anne Dillion assisted with technical support here at Del Mar. The cover page of today's complaint reads as follows:

*An audit of workouts performed at Santa Anita Park showed Trainer Richard Mandella recorded five (5) timed workouts in May 2025 without a corresponding clearance by an attending veterinarian.*

Steward Luis Jauregui chaired this hearing. Trainer Mandella pled guilty to the alleged rule violations. He accepted full responsibility and said he would do his best not to let it happen again. Decision to follow.

**TYLER BAZE/KYLE FREY FILM REVIEW (REF:07/31/25(3))**

Jockeys Kyle Frey and Tyler Baze appeared in our office together to review their rides in the seventh race yesterday July 31. There was an Inquiry, with no change made, following this 1 1/16th mile (Turf) event.

TYLER BAZE REVIEW

The Stewards viewed the final one hundred (100) yards of this race with Jockey Baze, who was aboard fourth place finisher #9 Candy Bar (Tyler Baze). This horse drifted out late and tightened things up to rivals on her outside. Jockey Baze was steering his horse by going from left-handed to right-handed riding crop. He was told that steering with his riding reins were preferable. A warning was issued.

KYLE FREY REVIEW

Jockey Frey was aboard fifth place finisher #5 Johanny. Jockey Frey attempted to enter a very tight opening in the final stages of this race. #5 Johanny bumped into second place finisher #10 Vibe (H. Berrios) when trying to 'thread the needle' late. Other horses were affected in this incident. Jockey Frey was cautioned to take more care when attempting to enter very tight openings.

NOTE: This was a ten (10) horse field. The inner turf rail was set at 24 feet.

SECOND RACE INQUIRY

Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident shortly after the start of this five (5) furlongs main track event. Film review shows ninth place finisher #8 Surf Ranger (Abel Lezcano) veer inward and contact first-place finisher #7 Marcos Performance (Kazushi Kimura). Following this significant bump Jockey Abel Lezcano was nearly unseated. Stewards unanimously ruled that the ninth place finisher initiated the interference. Therefore 'no change' was made in the order of finish.

THIRD RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION

Stewards posted the Inquiry sign in order to review two (2) incidents at the start of this five furlong (Turf) event.

INCIDENT ONE First-place finisher #5 Proletariat (Kyle Frey) breaks inward and bumps third place finisher #3 B G Bullet (Antonio Fresu) shortly after the start.

INCIDENT TWO Shortly after Incident #1, third place finisher #3 B G Bullet (Antonio Fresu) bore in and put significant pressure to inside rivals, #2 Rich Night (Ricardo Gonzalez-4<sup>th</sup> Place) and #1 In the Mix (Kazushi Kimura). These two rivals were squeezed significantly and lost much ground in the process.

After speaking to every jockey in this six (6) horse field, receiving a Patrol Judge Report and viewing all camera (including drone) angles the Stewards made a change in the original placing. In a majority vote #3 B G Bullet was disqualified and placed fifth. Steward Jauregui dissent (DQ #5 Proletariat / place 5<sup>th</sup>). Kyle Frey and Juan Hernandez (#7 Sendit Mo-Sixth place) were ordered to film review. Jockey Fresu was held blameless as blame was placed solely on his horse's action.

Today's film review shows #7 Sendit Mo angle in and pressure eventual first-place finisher #5 Proletariat (Kyle Frey) after the start. He was issued a 'warning' for this sub-par effort.

**KYLE FREY FILM REVIEW (REF:08/01/25(6))**

Jockey Kyle Frey appeared in our office to review his ride in yesterday's third race. Jockey Frey rode first-place finisher #5 Proletariat in this five-furlong (turf) event. Race replays show #5 Proletariat break inward and make contact with third place finisher #3 B G Bullet (Antonio Fresu). Jockey Frey did not receive a penalty for this ride.

**MCKINLEY MCPHERSON RULING (REF:08/02/25(2))**

Trainer Monte Schvaneveldt called the Stewards' Office today. He informed us that a check given to him by suspended Owner Steve McPherson did not clear today. The check was issued on behalf of Owner McKinley McPherson (dba Triple M Racing LLC). Ms. McPherson failed to appear for a hearing in our office on July 30, 2025. Both Mr. McPherson and now his daughter Ms. McPherson are suspended following the issuance of the ruling below.

**DMTD Ruling #15**

Owner MCKINLEY MCPHERSON (Triple M Racing Stable LLC) having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Del Mar Race Track on or before July 30, 2025, is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) pending an appearance at a hearing before the Board of Stewards to answer to charges alleging violation of CHRB rule

#1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$11,470.00 to trainer Monte Schvaneveldt).  
Suspension to commence on August 16, 2025.

During the term of this suspension, all licenses and license privileges of McKINLEY McPHERSON are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**FOURTH RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing Long Legged Babs (Ruben Silvera) dwelt (refuse to break) in this 5 ½ furlong main track event. Starter Jay Slender and his crew had to work quick to move this horses out of the gate prior to moving the starting gate, Our review showed that no mechanical or human error was involved. In a unanimous decision this horse was declared a starter.

**SEVENTH RACE INQUIRY/ACCIDENT**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident approaching the ¼ pole (turf).#5 Uncrowned King (Alfredo Bautista) was injured in a single horse incident, in which there was no contact with other horses. Apprentice Bautista bailed off while attempting to pull up his mount while still going at a high rate of speed. He was taken to the Del Mar First Aid department for observation. The horse was captured shortly thereafter.

**ELEVENTH RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW**

Track Announcer Larry Collmus told racing fans that a Stewards' Review would be conducted into the start of this race that was contested at one (1) mile on the turf. The Stewards were viewing the actions of sixth place finisher #1 Winning Patriot (Ricardo Gonzalez). This horse reared as the twelve (12) horses were being dispatched by Starter Jay Slender. The horse then trailed in the early stages. No human or mechanical errors were observed. This horse was declared a starter.

**FELIX GONZALEZ COMPLAINT (CASE #25LT0003)**

Trainer Felix Gonzalez appeared in the Stewards' office today to answer to an alleged Violation of CHRB Rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). CHRB Investigator Hiroshi Yokoyama appeared via Microsoft Teams from Santa Anita Park to present a twenty-one (21) page complaint for this hearing. The cover page of the complaint reads as follows.

*APOLINAR GRAYDAR ran the 2nd Race at Los Alamitos Race Course on Saturday, July 5, 2025 and was listed on the racing program as a colt. Trainer Felix Gonzalez entered the horse on July 2, 2025 and the entry as a colt. The Horse Identifier conducted a pre-race examination on July 3, 2025, and determined the horse to be a gelding. Trainer Felix Gonzalez confirmed with the Horse Identifier that he knew the horse was gelded at the farm prior to it shipping to Los Alamitos on March 28, 2025. Trainer Gonzalez said the discrepancy may have occurred due to the paperwork that shipped with the horse may have stated it was a colt.*

CHRB Investigator Octavio Vergara Jr. helped us with setting up Microsoft capabilities in our office. The Felix Gonzalez trained Apolinar Graydar finished sixth in the second race at Los Alamitos on July 5, 2025.

This horse was a first-time starter. The 21-page complaint before us today had a copy of the official Entry Blank. The box on the Entry Blank listing the sex of the horse was left blank. By listing the correct sex of the horse on this Entry Blank a hearing for Mr. Gonzalez could have been averted in this matter. The Stewards will now deliberate on the report that was prepared for this case and the testimony of Trainer Felix Gonzalez. Decision to follow.

**RICHARD MANDELLA RULING (REF:08/01/25(1))**

The following ruling was issued, in a unanimous decision, following a hearing that was held for Trainer Richard Mandella on August 1.

**DMTD Ruling #16**

Trainer RICHARD MANDELLA is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violations of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1878 (Workouts – No seventy-two (72) hour pre-workout Veterinarian examinations [Non-compliance for five workouts]) during May 2025.

\* California Horse Racing Board Rule #1532 requires that fines shall be paid (to the paymaster of purses) within seven calendar days from the date of the ruling, or the license of the person upon whom the fine has been imposed shall be suspended.

**DR. KIM KUHLMANN DECISION (REF: 07/30/25 (3))**

This matter was heard in what amounted to over a combined seven (7) hours of hearing testimony. (REF: SA Minutes 06/05/25 (2) & DM Minutes 07/30/25 (3)). The Stewards were of the unanimous opinion that Private Veterinarian Kim Kuhlmann was not guilty of violation of CHRB Rules #1842 (Veterinarian Report) and #1902 Conduct Detrimental to racing. The Stewards reached this decision following unanimous vote. This case was dismissed.

**THIRD RACE INQUIRY**

Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident inside the final 1/16th mile of this one (1) mile main track event. Fifth place finisher #5 Zagreus (Armando Ayuso) steadied while tiring and the Stewards investigated the reason why. #1 Non Domicille (Umberto Rispoli-third place) Drifted out following 'the incident', while approaching the finish line. #4 Fix It Quick (Kazushi Kimura-first place) Drifted in slightly in final 1/16th mile #6 Keithing Thunder (Tyler Baze-second place) raced inside of #4 Fix It Quickly, while that rival was drifting in slightly.

Stewards reviewed all camera angles, received a Patrol Judge report and spoke to the Jockeys involved. In a unanimous decision the Stewards allowed the original placings to stand. No Change.

### **TENTH RACE INQUIRY/DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing the start of this five (5) furlong main track event (\$100,000 Guaranteed CTBA Stakes). Fourth place finisher #6 Liberation (Hector Berrios) clipped heels and lost ground shortly after the start. The Stewards reviewed the actions of three (3) horses.

A. Original First Place Finisher-#5 My Love Caroline (Armando Ayuso) breaks straight, then drifts out for several strides, before having her heels clipped by #6 Liberation (Hector Berrios).

B. Original Second Place Finisher-#7 Jasmina (Kyle Frey) breaks in and may have made contact with fourth place finisher #6 Liberation (Hector Berrios).

C. Original Fourth Place Finisher-#6 Liberation (Hector Berrios) clips the heels of #5 My Love Caroline, stumbles and loses ground.

#6 Liberation re-rallied from last position down the backstretch to finish fourth. She was defeated ½ length for third position by #3 Tapatia Mia (Ruben Silveria).

The Stewards spoke to all three jockeys involved, received a Patrol Judge report and watched every available camera angle. In a majority vote (Steward Sawyer dissent) #5 My Love Caroline was disqualified and placed fourth, for drifting out in the path of #6 Liberation without sufficient clearance. Steward Sawyer voted for the disqualification of both #5 My Love Caroline and #7 Jasmina placing them third and fourth respectively. Jockey Armando Ayuso was ordered to film review with the Stewards.
