Apprentice Jockey ALEXIS CENTENO was summoned to our office after he failed to attend Sunday's Apprentice film review. Mr. Centeno stated that he forgot because he was at breakfast on Sunday morning. He was issued the following ruling:

Apprentice Jockey ALEXIS CENTENO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers – failure to attend film review class).

JOCKEY'S OBJECTION (TURF)

We posted the objection sign after the running of the third race, when the jockey of the fourth-place horse #1 WIND TARTERE (FR) (J. Valdivia Jr.) lodged a claim against the third-place horse #3 LADY ROBIN (A. Centeno) for interference in the stretch. After speaking to the Patrol Judges and the jockey who lodged the objection, we made no change to the original order of finish. In a unanimous opinion, we believed the #1 was not cost a better placing.

SUNDAY05/09/21¹**FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice Jockey EMILY ELLINGWOOD was in our office to review yesterday's second race. Ms. Ellingwood stated that leaving the starting gate her horse ducked out from the gap (6.fur). We felt that she could have grabbed her inside rein a little more to prevent her horse from drifting out further. She had a long hold that prevented her from getting more leverage. She made some effort; therefore, she was just issued a warning.

Jockey FLAVIEN PRAT came in to review yesterday's fifth race to determine whether or not he violated the riding crop rule. Mr. Prat felt he did not violate the rule and was not clear what the interpretation of the rule was. We felt that he could have given a little more time in between the usage of the riding crop. He was issued a warning, and Ms. Sawyer voted for a penalty.

05/09/21²**STEWARDS' INQUIRY/NO CHANGE (4th RACE)**

We posted the inquiry sign to review an incident approaching the ¼ pole involving the first-place horse #3 "Tiz Wonderfully" (G. Franco) and the third-place horse #1 "Stormin Ranger" (E. Maldonado). After speaking to both riders involved and the patrol judges, we made no change to the order of finish. The decision was unanimous. The video shows that the #1 was drifting out and causing his own issues, therefore, we felt no change should be made.
