PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (TRAINER OR OWNER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE), TRAINER PAUL JONES, WHO STARTED THE HORSE "HAWKS VALENTINE", THE FIRST PLACE FINISHER IN THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JUNE 5, 2021, IS FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* AND ASSESSED ONE HALF POINT (1/2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843.4 (MULTIPLE MEDICATION VIOLATIONS-EXPIRES 7-24-2022) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843(A & D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), AND #1843.1 (PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES- ISOFLUPREDONE- CLASS IV).

Ruling # 145

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1887 (TRAINER OR OWNER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) AND #1588 (A)(14) HORSE INELIGIBLE TO STARTE IN A RACE), TRAINER BRIAN CUNNINGHAM, WHO WORKED THE HORSE "WINDANDSEA", ON JUNE 13, 2021, IS FINED TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00)* AND ASSESSED ONE HALF POINT (1/2) IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1843.4 (MULTIPLE MEDICATION VIOLATIONS-EXPIRES 7-24-2022) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULES #1843(A, B & D) (MEDICATION, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES), AND #1843.1 (PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCES- PHENYLBUTAZONE- 3RD VIOLATION WITHIN A TWELVE MONTH PERIOD).

Ruling # 146

JOCKEY JOSE M. NICASIO IS SUSPENDED FOR TWO (2) RACING DAYS (JULY 31ST

AND AUGUST 1ST, 2021) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688 (c)(2) (USE OF RIDING CROP IN THE COCKED POSITION) DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 18, 2021.

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766 (DESIGNATED RACES), THE TERM OF SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES.

(5) OBJECTIONS/INQUIRIES

Following the running of the 9th race, the Stewards posted an inquiry involving the #7 horse Perrys Everlasting (jockey Cruz Mendez) (trainer Jose Flores) falling and dislodging his jockey a few strides after leaving the gate. Upon review, the stewards determined that Perrys Everlasting fell on his own.

(6) HEARINGS

(7) INCIDENTS

In the first race, #1 Angel Of The City, Jockey Cerapio Figueroa lost his inside iron shortly after leaving the gate. Following the running of the 9th race, the #7 horse Perrys Everlasting was running loose and was captured after loping three quarters of the way around the track changing direction and loping back around to the winner's circle area. Perrys Everlasting was vanned off after being caught.

In the 9th race, the Stewards caused an inquiry to be posted for the #6 Apollitical Patty (trainer Monty Arrossa) who upon leaving the gate lost her jockey (Jesus Rios Ayala). The Stewards determined that

to no one else's fault Jesus Rios Ayala lost his left rein and pulling on the right causing him to become unseated.

(6) INCIDENTS

In the 8th race, #1 Watch Over Bella (trainer Elena Andrade) was vanned off after the race as a precaution.
