Report for the Week of Monday, August 30, 2021, through Monday, September 6, 2021

WEDNESDAY9/01/21¹**ENTRY DAY/POST TIME CHANGE**

Racing Secretary David Jerkens and his staff were on hand in the backside racing office today creating a racing program for Saturday September 4, 2021. DMTC management has requested permission from the CHRB to change first post time to 1:30p.m. for this Labor Day weekend. (September 4, 5 and 6).

Eleven (11) races will be contested on Saturday. The earlier first post should help out regarding darkness later in the afternoon. One hundred five (105) horses are slated to start. Steward Luis Jauregui was on duty supervising matters for the CHRB.

THURSDAY9/02/21¹**UMBERTO RISPOLI FILM REVIEW(REF: 08/29/21(4))**

Jockey Umberto Rispoli appeared in the Stewards' Office to review his ride aboard #3 Rock Your World who finished second in the \$100,000 Guaranteed Shared Belief Stakes (ninth race) which was contested at one (1) mile on the main track Sunday, August 29, 2021.

There were three (3) horses involved in this Inquiry; #3 Rock Your World (Umberto Rispoli-second place), #6 Stilleto Boy (Kent Desormeaux-third place) and #4 Team Merchants (Mario Gutierrez-fifth place). There was bumping between the latter two (2) horses.

After reviewing the incident, the majority felt that all three (3) horses contributed to the incident inside the 1/4 pole. Steward Baker dissented feeling Jockey Rispoli initiated the incident by altering course and voted for a suspension.

MARIO GUTIERREZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Mario Gutierrez appeared in the Stewards Office to review his ride aboard #4 Team Merchants who finished fifth in the ninth race, \$100,000 Guaranteed Shared Belief Stakes. This horse was involved in a three (3) horse incident (REF: 08/29/21⁴). The majority felt that Jockey Gutierrez had partial blame but was not issued a penalty for the incident.

KENT DESORMEAUX FILM REVIEW (REF: 08/29/21⁴)

Jockey Kent Desormeaux was the third rider in our office this morning to review the ninth race from Sunday August 29, 2021. Jockey Desormeaux was aboard #6 Stilleto Boy, who finished fourth in this race. Today's film review shows Jockey Desormeaux attempting to 'hold his ground' while receiving 'pressure' from the inside. Jockey Desormeaux was issued a warning, the majority felt that he made contact with #4 Team Merchants (Mario Gutierrez) and determined the incident was not worthy of a penalty.

DOUG O'NEILL COMPLAINT (CASE#21SA0066)

Trainer Doug O'Neill appeared in our office for two (2) formal hearings today. He was represented by attorney Darrell Vienna who participated via a Microsoft Teams video format. CHRB Investigator Greg Icamen presented separate complaints at these back to back hearings. Court Reporter Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed all proceedings. Trainer Doug O'Neill was present in our office for both hearings. The alleged Rule violations for this case are CHRB Rule #1843 (a)(b) &(d) (Medication, Drugs or Other Substances). Rule #1843.1(a) (Prohibited Drug Substances). Rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medication Violations, Rule #1844(d)(5) (Authorized Medication) and Rule #1887(a) Owner or Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse. This complaint reads as follows.

The official blood sample #NC42856 taken on June 3, 2021, was reported by Ben Moller Ph. D. of the Ken Maddy Equine Analytical Chemistry Laboratory (EACL) at U.C. Davis to contain Methocarbamol. The sample was obtained from the horse 'Desie Delight' who ran in the 7th Race at Santa Anita and finished 2nd. The trainer of record is Doug O'Neill. Per CHRB Rule 1859.2, O'Neill requested that a split sample be tested. On July 23, 2021, the lab confirmed the original finding of the substance Methocarbamol as reported by the CHRB's official laboratory. Methocarbamol is a Class A drug with a Penalty Category C.

Testimony was given. Documents were marked and moved into evidence. Decision to follow.

SECOND DOUG O'NEILL COMPLAINT (CASE#21SA0067)

The same individuals that participated in the last hearing, participated in this hearing. The alleged rule violations for this hearing are CHRB Rule #1843.1(a) (Prohibited Drug Substances), Rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medication Violations), Rule #1866(h) Veterinarian's List and Rule #1887(a) (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse). The cover page of this complaint reads as follows.

The official blood sample #NC42856 taken on June 3, 2021, was reported by Ben Moeller Ph.D., of the U.C. Davis Laboratory to contain Methocarbamol (13.3 ng/ml). The sample was obtained from the horse 'Team Merchants' who worked on June 3, 2021, for removal from the Veterinarian's List. The trainer of record is Doug O'Neill. A split sample was requested by O'Neill and the laboratory confirmed the original finding of the drug substance Methocarbamol as reported by the CHRB's official laboratory. The violation is a Class 4 drug with a Penalty Category C.

Testimony was given. Documents were marked and moved into evidence. Decision to follow.

PETER MILLER DECISION (REF: 08/29/21²)

The Stewards contacted Trainer Peter Miller and informed him of our decision following a formal hearing that was held in our office on Sunday August 29. Our ruling is listed below.

DMTD Ruling #062

Trainer PETER MILLER, who worked out the horse MO FORZA at San Luis Rey Downs on June 19, 2021 is fined ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$1,500.00)* and assessed one half (1/2) point in accordance with California Horse Racing Rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medication Violations – Expires 9/02/22) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1868 (Authorization Medication During Workouts) and Rule #1843.1 (b) (Prohibited Drug Substances – Phenylbutazone (Class 4) – Second Offense in 365 days).

CROPPING VIOLATION

Jockey Kyle Frey used his riding crop eight (8) times while aboard #1 Paige Runner, who finished third in the first race on Sunday August 29, 2021. This race was contested at one (1) mile on the main track. Jockey Frey pled guilty to violation of CHRB Rule #1688 and waived his right to a hearing. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

DMTD Ruling #063

Jockey KYLE FREY who rode PAIGE RUNNER in the first race at Del Mar Race Track August 29, 2021, is fined SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (b)(8) (Use of Riding Crop-used more than six (6) times in a race-second offense within the past sixty day period).

FIFTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW

The Stewards conducted a Stewards' Review into the start of the fifth race which was conducted at 5 ½ furlongs on the main track. Post time favorite #9 Taming the Tigress (Flavien Prat) threw her head at the start and was off quite slowly. Race replays showed no mishandling of the horse nor mechanical malfunction of the starting gate. After a brief review the Stewards determined that there was no reason to post the Inquiry sign.

Apprentice Jockey Jessica Pyfer appeared in the Stewards' office to review her ride aboard #2 Bound to Bet, who finished fourth in the eight race yesterday September 2. This race was contested at five (5) furlongs on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course. Apprentice Pyfer's mount was closing well while lugging out slightly at the ¼ mile marker. An opening manifested itself on the rail and Apprentice Pyfer choose to go to the outside and float two (2) rivals to her outside. They were seventh place finisher #1 Mischievous Path (Juan Hernandez) and eighth place finisher #6 El Diablo Rojo (Flavien Prat).

This informal hearing was two-part. First, we want to prevent horses from drifting out into rivals on the turns or anywhere for that matter. Second, we used this film review as a teaching tool showing riders when opportunities to safely save ground present themselves. Ms. Pyfer was receptive to our observations.

Jockey Umberto Rispoli appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #3 Dogtag, who finished second in yesterday's ninth race, The John C. Mabee Stakes (Grade 2), which was contested at 1 1/8 miles on the turf. Jockey Rispoli raised his riding crop (left-handed) well above shoulder level, at least twice, in the stretch drive of this \$250,000 race. Jockey Rispoli said he needs to 'work on' this issue as he is more liable to possibly violate the rule using the left-hand as opposed to the right-hand position. In a unanimous decision we issued the following ruling.

Jockey UMBERTO RISPOLI who rode DOGTAG in the ninth race at Del Mar Race Track on September 4, 2021, is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (c)(2) (Use of Riding Crop- above the shoulder level).

DOUG O'NEILL DECISION (REF: 09/02/21 (4) & 09/02/21 (5))

Attorney Darrell Vienna was contacted via telephone today and informed of the ruling below that was issued to his client Trainer Doug O'Neill. The Stewards found Trainer O'Neill guilty of violations in both cases. However, these cases, for penalty purposes, were combined as allowed by CHRB Rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medications Violations). Trainer O'Neill was not aware of the first medication positive when the second complaint was served by CHRB enforcement. This is Trainer O'Neill's second medication Ruling in the last 365 days.

Trainer DOUG O'NEILL, who started the horse DEISE DELIGHT who finished second in the seventh race on May 30, 2021 at Santa Anita Park and also worked TEAM MERCHANTS for removal from the Veterinarian's List at Santa Anita Park on June 3, 2021 is fined TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000) and assessed one half (1/2) point in accordance with CHRB rule #1843.4 (Multiple Medication Violations – Expires 09-06-22) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1866(h) (Veterinarian's List) and Rule #1843(a)(d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances) and Rule #1843.1(a) (Prohibited Drug Substances – Methocarbamol (Class 4).

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after #7 Honor Award (Ricardo Gonzalez) was injured just inside the ¼ mile maker on the infield turf course. Eighth place finisher #10 Classically (Flavien Prat) clipped heels with #7 Honor Award before galloping out the final furlong. Fourth place finisher #4 Birth of Cool (Mike Smith) also altered course to avoid the incident. After a film review the Stewards determined that no change in the order of finish was warranted.
