**Report for the Week of Monday, November 1, 2021, Through Sunday, November 7, 2021**

**MONDAY**11/01/21<sup>1</sup>**BREEDERS' CUP ENTRY DAY**

Stewards Baker, Jauregui and Sawyer were on duty today in the Del Mar Stewards' office. The Stewards had numerous conversations today with several Racing Officials including Tom Robbins (Breeders' Cup-Racing Panel Charmain), David Jerkens (DMTC Racing Secretary) and other Breeders' Cup Staff. (Racing & Executive).

The draw for the 14 Breeders' Cup races commenced at 2:00 p.m. in the Del Mar paddock. All three (3) Stewards attended the draw. Brittney Eurtion and Nick Luck from NBC TV emceed the event. Assistant Clerk of Scales Charlie McCaul and Backup Announcer/Racing Office Clerk/Timer John Lies shook the pills and drew the entries. This event was sponsored by Rood and Riddle Clinic from Kentucky.

There was a total of 198 Breeders' Cup horses entered for the two (2) days of racing. There are forty-six (46) horses scheduled to start that have made the trip from outside of the United States. That is the most horses from overseas in the 38 years that the Breeders' Cup has been held. There will a total of ten (10) races scheduled for Friday November 5. One hundred twelve (112) horses are scheduled to start. There will be twelve (12) races slated for Saturday, November 6 and a total of one hundred twenty (120) horses are scheduled to start.

There was approval of jockey silks advertising, workout eligibility review, riding crop enforcement etc. CHRB Chief Steward Darrel McHargue and CHRB Executive Director Scott Chaney also met with the Stewards today.

#### **RIDING CROP MEETING**

Jockeys Guild Regional Manager Darrel Haire came to the Stewards' office at our request today. Also present was CHRB Chief Steward Darrel McHargue and CHRB Safety Steward David Nuesch. The main focus of today's meeting was enhancing penalties for riding crop violations (CHRB Rule #1688) in the fourteen (14) Breeders' Cup races at Del Mar. Mr. Haire said he would do his best to 'spread the word' to the many jockeys riding this weekend not only from out of state but from outside the United States. A large copy of the full text of CHRB Rule #1688 will be posted in the jockey's room for all riders to read.

#### **JOE BRAVO RULING**

Jockey Joe Bravo rode #9 Mesut to a second-place finish in the fifth race on October 31, 2021 at Santa Anita Park and was directed to meet with the Stewards here at Del Mar today. The Stewards observed Jockey Bravo use his riding crop four (4) consecutive times in the stretch drive of this race. Jockey Bravo contacted the Stewards waived his right to a hearing and pled guilty to a violation of CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop)

#### **DFTD Ruling #01**

Jockey JOE BRAVO is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(7) (Use of Riding Crop – more than two times in succession – first offense within the past sixty days) during the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 31, 2021.

**GEOVANNI FRANCO FILM REVIEW (REF: SA10/31/21 (2))**

Jockey Geovanni Franco appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the fifth race on closing day at Santa Anita Park which was October 31, 2021. Jockey Franco was aboard #4 Johnny Podres who finished fifth and was disqualified and placed tenth for interference in mid-stretch. This race was contested at six (6) furlongs on the infield turf course.

Today's film review shows Jockey Franco drift in from the middle of the turf course down towards the rail. This action forces original tenth place finisher #3 Silardi (Kyle Frey) to steady his mount sharply. Following deliberation the Stewards, in a unanimous decision, informed Mr. Franco of the following penalty issued for careless riding.

**DFTD Ruling #02**

Jockey GEOVANNI FRANCO, who rode JOHNNY PODRES in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on October 31, 2021, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (November 12, 13 and 14, 2021), for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference, which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from fifth to tenth place. This constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – careless riding).

**ADDITIONAL PATROL JUDGE**

Racing Official Jacob Wipfli will serve as an additional Patrol Judge for this Breeders' Cup week at Del Mar. Heather Correra, who has been an extra set of eyes on the far turn for eighteen (18) years, will work her usual location. The grizzled veteran Ed Reese will work the finish line tower and also serve as an Assistant Paddock Judge on both Breeders' Cup Day cards. Mr. Wipfli, who took out his racing officials license here at Del Mar last summer, will be stationed on the 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile patrol stanchion.

**HALL OF FAME PRESENTATION**

Following today's third race retired jockey and current CHRB Chief Steward Darrel McHargue was in the winners' circle to be presented a beautiful plaque for his induction, as a jockey into the National Racing Hall of Fame. McHargue, accompanied by his wife Robin and son Jason, was inducted into the Hall last August in Saratoga Springs NY. In 1978 he was the leading money-winning jockey in the United States. This plaque will be placed on his mantle along with an Eclipse Award, the George Woolf Memorial Award and the Pete Pedersen Award for outstanding officiating. Darrel was assigned at the California Horse Racing Boards first Chief Steward in December 2015.

Retired Jockeys Don Pierce and Frank Olivares were on hand for today's presentation which was emceed by Del Mar CEO Joe Harper. CHRB Commissioners, current and former Executive Directors were also on hand to show their support.

**FOURTH RACE INQUIRY DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident at the ¼ pole. Race replays show fourth place finisher #1 Foothill (Joel Rosario) drift out and make contact with fifth place finisher #7 Tropical Terror (Geovanni Franco). This race had five (5) runners and was contested at one (1) mile on the turf course. The contact between these two (2) aforementioned rivals was significant. In a unanimous vote #1 Foothill was

disqualified and placed fifth (last). Jockey Joel Rosario was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

We reviewed CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop) with these two riders. We showed them films of riding crop violations from the recently concluded Santa Anita meeting. These riders were also told that Breeders' Cup riding crop potential penalties will be much stronger than non-Breeders Cup races.

**JOEL ROSARIO FILM REVIEW (REF: 11/2/21 (5))**

Jockey Joel Rosario appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #1 Foothill who finished fourth and was disqualified and placed fifth (last) for interference at the ¼ pole in yesterday's fourth race. There was significant contact in this incident. The majority felt that Jockey Rosario was in a 'tight situation' and his horse got 'away from him'. Steward Jauregui voted for a 3 day riding suspension. Warning issued.

**OFFICIAL PROGRAM ISSUE**

The Official Program for today's race was late arriving at Del Mar today. The issue was attributed to a mix up in the program delivery process. The Stewards worked off a program proof that contained all accurate information sans morning line odds.

**RICARDO SANTANA JR. RULING**

In the second race yesterday November # 4 Jockey Ricardo Santana rode #5 Adens Dream who raced to victory in a six (6) furlong main track event, The Stewards observed Jockey Santana uses his riding crop four (4) consecutive times in the stretch drive of this race. The Stewards unanimously ruled that Jockey Santana, who waived his right to an informal hearing, violated CHRB Rule #1688 (b)(7) by using his riding crop four (4) consecutive times. The following ruling was issued.

**DFTD Ruling #03**

Jockey RICARDO SANTANA, JR. is fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(7) (Use of Riding Crop – more than two times in succession – first offense within the past sixty days) during the second race at Del Mar Race Track on November 4, 2021.

**BREEDERS' CUP JOCKEYS MEETING**

The Stewards met with members of the Jockey's colony on the patio above the Jockey's room one (1) hour before this afternoon's ten (10) race card. Along with the Stewards were DMTC Track Veterinarian Dana Stead, Breeders' Cup Veterinarian Will Farmer,

CHRB Safety Steward David Nuesch and Jockey Guild Regional Manager Darrell Haire. CHRB Enforcement/Licensing Chief Shawn Loehr was also present.

After an introductory welcome to everyone the Stewards went over some protocol for Friday and Saturday's Breeders' Cup races at Del Mar. Most of the time this meeting was spent discussing CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop) and the different portions of the rule. The Stewards wanted to be very clear to the Jockey's that if found guilty of a riding crop penalty in any of these weekends fourteen (14) Breeders' Cup races, the potential penalties would be very significantly increased. We shared this caution with Jockey' Guild Regional Manager Darrell Haire earlier in the week and asked him to 'spread the word'.

'Quick Official' procedures, weighing out procedures were discussed. The Veterinarians spoke to the riders about the post parade warm-up period. The Stewards emphasized jockey's effort at the start and staying straight in the stretch. Caution going into the turns and 'taking care' of fellow riders was also emphasized. Questions were taken at the end of this twenty (20) minute assembly.

### **BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE TURF (GRADE 1) \$1,000,000**

This tenth race today was contested at one (1) mile on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course. During the loading process #2 Albahar (GB), (Lanfranco Dettori) got its feet over its starting gate stall door. DMTC assistant starters came to the aid of Jockey Dettori and #2 Albahar (GB) who eventually was cast under the starting gate. #2 Albahr (GB) was then recommended being scratched by Breeders' Cup Veterinarian Dr. Chuck Jenkins via two-way radio.

After the scratch of #2 Albahar (GR), #1 Modern Games (IRE) (William Buick) was let out of the starting gate by an assistant starter who opened the front doors of his stall. Shortly after the initial incident Dr. Jenkins radioed the Stewards and recommend that #1 Modern Games (IRE) be scratched. The Stewards activated both scratches after individually reading back (double checking) the number, name of horse and trainers name of both participants. Less than two (2) minutes later DMTC Track Veterinarian Dr. Dana Stead contacted us via two-way radio and by cell phone. He told us that #1 Modern Games (IRE) was fit to race.

After more time had passed the Stewards told Track Announcer Larry Collmus to broadcast that #1 Modern Games (IRE) would be allowed to race as a non-wagering interest for purse only pursuant to CHRB Rule #1974 (Wagering Interest). The Mutuel Department was also informed of this. The DMTC Video Department and NBC were asked to provide graphics informing the public #1 Modern Games (IRE) would not be considered in any wagering pools and race for purse money only. For a yet to be determined reason, #1 Modern Games (IRE) was temporarily reinstated in the tote system and eventually removed again.

DMTC Assistant Starter Carl (Dink) Woods who handled #2 Albahar (GB) was injured during the original mishap in the starting gate. He was attended to by trackside paramedics and examined by the first aid department before being released. Unfortunately, Mr. Woods was not able to work on Breeders' Cup Saturday due to the incident in this race.

#1 Modern Games (IRE) went on to finish first in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (Grade 1)-\$1,000,000 Guaranteed as a non-wagering interest.

Mr. Chaney and Dr. Blea gave statements and took questions from members of the media.

The same individuals that were in our office at yesterday's scratch time (REF:11/5/21 (1)) appeared today for the special 8:00 a.m. Breeders' Cup announcement of changes. One (1) jockey corrected weight and six (6) scratches were activated shortly after today's early morning meeting

11/06/21<sup>2</sup>

**E.T. BAIRD FILM REVIEW**

Jockey E.T. Baird appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride aboard #9 One Timer who finished ninth in yesterday's sixth race. This event was the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint (\$1,000,000-Grade 1) which was contested at five (5) furlongs on the turf. In the stretch drive of this race Jockey Baird used his riding crop a total of nine

(9) times. His mount was drifting out while Jockey Baird was striking his horse right-handed. Jockey Baird said he was using his crop for safety purposes. The Stewards felt that grabbing the left bridle rein would suffice as far as straightening his mount. Jockey Baird did grab a left rein late in this race and his mount straightened fine. The Stewards, in a unanimous vote, issued the following penalty. Riding crop penalties for all Breeders' Cup races will be enhanced significantly. This was shared with Jockey's Guild Representative Darrell Haire earlier this week and shared at our jockey's room meeting yesterday. Our decision in this matter was unanimous.

**DFTD Ruling #04**

Jockey E. T. BAIRD is fined FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(8) (Use of Riding Crop – more than six times during race – first offense within the past sixty (60) days) during the sixth race at Del Mar Race Track on November 5, 2021.

**LUIS SAEZ FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Luis Saez appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the second race yesterday November 5. He was accompanied by Darrell Haire from the Jockey's Guild. In this one (1) mile turf race Jockey Saez was aboard #5 Detroit City who finished eighth. Race replays this morning show #5 Detroit City crossing over into the path of #2 Thirty Four Coupe (Mike Smith) who finished ninth (last). Jockey Smith was forced to steady his mount as #5 Detroit City and Jockey Saez were not sufficiently clear of that rival. In a close call and unanimous vote Jockey Saez was cautioned to give more room before crossing over. Warning issued.

**TOM EAVES FILM REVIEW & RULING**

11/07/21<sup>1</sup>

Jockey Tom Eaves appeared in the Stewards' Office before heading to the airport for a return trip to the United Kingdom. The Stewards wished to review Jockey Eaves' ride aboard #1 Glass Slippers (GB), who finished sixth in the \$1,000,000 Guaranteed Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint which was contested at five (5) furlongs.

Today's film review shows Jockey Eaves raise his riding crop three (3) times above shoulder level which is a violation of CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop). The Stewards have enhanced penalty levels for this weekend's fourteen (14) Breeders' Cup races. In a unanimous decision the following ruling was issued.

#### **DFTD Ruling #05**

Jockey TOM EAVES is fined ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(c)(2) (Use of Riding Crop – above the shoulder level – first offense within the past sixty days) during the fifth race at Del Mar Race Track on November 6, 2021.

#### **FLORENT GEROUX FILM REVIEW RULINGS**

Jockey's Guild Representative Darrell Haire was in our office this morning to represent Jockey Florent Geroux on two (2) matters. Jockey Geroux failed to appear at a film review with the Stewards yesterday. The reason for the hearing was to review his use of the riding crop in the NetJets Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (Grade 1-\$2,000,000 Guaranteed) which was the seventh race on Friday November 5. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

#### **DFTD Ruling #06**

Jockey FLORENT GEROUX is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1930 (Obedience to Security Officers and Public Safety Officers - failure to attend Stewards' film review) on November 6, 2021.

Darrell Haire represented Mr. Geroux in today's film review. Race replays show Jockey Geroux use his riding crop seven (7) times in the stretch drive of this 1 1/8-mile main track event while finishing second aboard #5 Juju's Map. This horse defeated #4 Tarbi (Javier Castellano) by the margin of a 'neck' for the place position. #5 Juju's Map earned \$340,000 for her second-place finish. #4 Tarbi earned \$120,000 for her third-place finish. In a unanimous decision the Stewards issued the following ruling.

#### **DFTD Ruling #07**

Jockey FLORENT GEROUX is fined FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688(b)(8) (Use of Riding Crop – more than six times during race – first offense within the past sixty (60) days) during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on November 5, 2021.

#### **IRAD ORTIZ JR. FILM REVIEW**

Jockeys' Guild representative Darrell Haire met with the Stewards for Jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. at an informal film review today. Jockey Ortiz rode #4 Raging Bull (FR), who finished fourth in the ninth race on the card yesterday November 6. This was the FanDuel Breeders' Cup Mile (Grade 1-Purse \$2,000,000 Guaranteed). #4 Raging Bull (FR) drifted out in the final furlong of this race and impeded eleventh place finisher #10 Blowout (GB) (Joel Rosario). Jockey Ortiz eventually straightened his mount. We (the Stewards) wished he would have taken corrective measures earlier. In a majority vote (Steward Sawyer dissent) Jockey Ortiz was issued a warning for this sub-par effort.

#### **RICARDO SANTANA JR. FILM REVIEW**

Darrell Haire (Jockey's Guild) represented Jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. at a film review this morning. This film review was of the tenth race on Saturday November 6. This 1 1/8-

mile main track event was the \$2,000,000 Guaranteed Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (Grade 1).

Jockey Santana was aboard #5 Claire who finished fourth. Upon initial review it appeared Jockey Santana used his crop seven (7) or eight (8) times. Two (2) of the Stewards felt there was some doubt that two (2) of the strike motions actually made contact. In a majority vote (Steward Jauregui voted for a fine) Jockey Santana was issued a warning.

**RONALD MCANALLY, DEBORAH MCANALLY & GEOVANNI FRANCO  
COMPLAINT (CASE #20DM0069)**

A formal hearing was held for trainer Ronald McAnally, Owner Deborah McAnally and Jockey Giovanni Franco. None of the parties appeared today. Assistant Trainer Danny Landers was an observer on behalf Mr. & Mrs. McAnally. CHRB Investigator Steven Manila presented a fifteen (15) page complaint at the hearing. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed the proceedings. The cover page of the complaint reads as follows.

*The official urine sample #DN16675 taken on 11/22/2020 at Del Mar was reported by Dr. Ben Moller of UC Davis Laboratories to contain 7-Carboxy-Cannabidiol, a metabolite of cannabidiol. The sample was obtained from the horse ROSES AND CANDY which ran in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race at Del Mar finishing first. The trainer of record is RONALD MCANALLY. A requested split sample confirmed the finding of 7-Carboxy-Cannabidiol. The violation is a Class 1 drug with a penalty category A. The owner of ROSES AND CANDY IS DEBORAH MCANALLY. The jockey during the race was GEOVANNI FRANCO. Per rule 1859.5 the horse shall be disqualified and any purse money forfeited.*

Testimony was given and documents were marked as exhibits and then moved into evidence. Ruling to follow.
