07-04-18¹ **NOLAN RULING- REF (6/28/18⁴)**

RULING NO. 17

Trainer **WILLIAM J. NOLAN** is hereby suspended sixty (60) days, July 9, 2018 through September 6, 2018 inclusive and placed on probation for the term of his license (12/25/2018) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489 (a) (8) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License – refusal to test per signed testing agreement), and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing) and #1930 (Obedience to Security and Public Safety Officers) on May 25, 2018. Prior to reinstatement of his license privileges **MR. NOLAN** must show proof of completion of a minimum thirty (30) day in-house rehabilitation program acceptable to this Board of Stewards and provide a negative test result.

As conditions of probation **MR. NOLAN** must remain on a testing program as long as he is licensed by the California

Horse Racing Board and abide by the terms of a contract with Winners Foundation. Failure to comply with the terms of probation will be grounds for actions against **MR. NOLAN'S** license privileges pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1485 (License Subject to Conditions and Agreements).

During the term of the suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **WILLIAM J. NOLAN** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards) subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after discussion over Mr. Nolan's refusal to test on May 25, 2018 at Golden Gate Fields. Mr. Nolan walked out of the Investigators office while the paperwork for processing the test was being filled out. Mr. Nolan was suspended in March of 2015 for thirty days for testing positive.

07-04-18² **INFORMAL HEARING – CASE 18GG0077**

Trainer Jerry Puertas Jr. appeared with Exercise Rider Faustino Garduno to resolve a minor conflict concerning One Hundred and Fifty dollars (\$150.00). Puertas Jr. claimed Garduno picked up cash from an owner and a check from him for the same bill. Essentially a double payment. Garduno offered One Hundred dollars (\$100.00) to make the matter go away and Puertas Jr. accepted the One Hundred (\$100.00) dollar bill immediately. Case closed.

07-04-18⁴ **FIRST RACE (MULE) JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE**

Jockey Hugo Herrera aboard #5 BAR JF RED TICKET (4th) lodged a claim of foul against #6 PENELOPE (2nd) and Jockey Shawn Spikes for allegedly bearing in causing interference in this 350 yard stake race.

After talking to the Patrol Judge and riders and a thorough review of the race the Stewards unanimously voted to make no change. While #6 did come in slightly, room always existed for #5, so there was no reason for a disqualification.

07-04-18⁵ **4TH RACE INQUIRY – NO CHANGE**

#6 WICKED OLD FASHION (Irving Orozco) failed to leave the starting gate when the doors opened. The Inquiry sign was lit to determine if #6 was afforded a fair start. No reason, other than her refusing could be found. Jockey Orozco said "when I tried to urge her she just turned and looked at me." "WICKED OLD FASHION" has started twelve (12) times and been first or second in nine (9) of those starts. She has been placed on the Stewards and Starters List for schooling and, hopefully, Trainer Victor Trujillo can figure out the problem.

07-04-18⁶ **8TH RACE INQUIRY/ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE**

#3 MY FRIEND EMMA stumbled slightly at the start and Jockey Ricardo Gonzalez lost his balance and fell off. The Inquiry sign was posted to determine if #3 was afforded a fair start. She got a fair break and was declared a starter. As odds on favorite she disappointed a majority of the crowd.

07-06-18² **ARRIAGA RULING**RULING NO. 19

Jockey **JESUS ARRIAGA** who rode **FOOSE DEPENDENT** in the second race at Oak Tree at Pleasanton on Wednesday, July 04, 2018 is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the Horse a chance to respond).

The above ruling was issued when Mr. Arriaga accepted the penalty by phone. He didn't realize he used the crop four times in a row.

07-06-18³ **MARTINEZ RULING**RULING NO. 20

Jockey **HERIBERT MARTINEZ** who rode **QUEEN OF TEQUILA** in the fourth race at Oak Tree at Pleasanton on Wednesday, July 04, 2018 is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the Horse a chance to respond).

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Martinez came in and reviewed the film with the Stewards. Martinez said he just got excited to win the race and apologized for overuse of the crop.

Jockey **HUGO HERRERA** who rode **STARBUCK'S BABY** in the first race at Oak Tree at Pleasanton on Friday, July 06, 2018 is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred dollars (\$100)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (use of Riding Crop – used more than three times without giving the Horse a chance to respond).

The above ruling was issued after Herrera appeared and accepted responsibility. He miscounted and ended up using the crop four times in succession.

07-07-18² **FILM REVIEW**

Jockeys Francisco Monroy and Heribert Martinez were in to review films. Jockey Monroy was cautioned to keep a straight course in the stretch and not switch to left handed cropping when his horse is getting out. Martinez was cautioned to be sure his mount is interfered with severely enough to claim foul. Martinez was on a tiring horse and the winner came in slightly while passing, but clearly did not affect the outcome.
