DRIVER **JAMES LACKEY**, WHO DROVE “**GORGEOUS FOR REAL**” IN THE ELEVENTH RACE ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 25, 2017 IS HEREBY FINED THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED **(\$100.00)*** DOLLARS FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE **#1734 (D)** (WHIPPING – DRIVERS MAY NOT USE THE WHIP MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND.) FIRST OFFENSE IN LAST SIXTY (60) DAYS.
