- 11/03/17 (1) **Fifth Race – Inquiry - Disqualification**
 #1 “Doug’s Hobby Horse” Driver Luke Plano made a break in the stretch. Inquiry sign was posted. After film review, the Stewards determined #1 “Doug’s Hobby Horse” failed to lose ground while off stride. “Doug’s Hobby Horse” finished fourth and placed fifth for violation of the breaking rule at the finish.

 #3 “Winsom Kelly” Driver Luke Plano drove inside a pylon after the ¾ mile marker. After film review the Stewards unanimously agreed no violation of the pylon rule and original order of finish stands.

- 11/04/17 (1) **Film Review – Warning**
 Driver Nick Roland and Terry Kauffman were in the Stewards office to review the second race on Friday, November 3rd. #4 “Zachariahs Honor” (Terry Kauffman) drifted out at the top of the stretch and stable mate #5 “Who’s Dreaming” driven by Nick Roland, raced up the inside and drew away at odds of 3/5. Kauffman pointed out that he was having trouble the whole mile trying to keep his horse from bearing out. After review of the race the Stewards accepted his explanation with a warning to keep the inside protected.

 While driving #6 “HF Card” Driver Nick Roland caused his horse to go off stride after a break after the half. Inquiry sign was posted after film review. The Stewards unanimously decided Driver Roland complied with the ‘breaking’ rule thus original order of finish stands.
