Driver Steve Wiseman came to the steward's office to watch the tenth race on March 14, 2009 at Cal-Expo concerning interference between #1 "Leadmeastray", driven by Mr. Wiseman, and #2 "Jessalilpeace", driven by Luke Plano, at the 3/4 pole.

After watching the tape, Mr. Wiseman agreed with the stewards, who placed his horse third (3rd) for interference.

Mr. Wiseman was fined Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars for the incident and he agreed to the fine.

The stewards hung the inquiry sign concerning possible interference between #1 “Castle Oaks”, driven by Tim Maier, and #2 “Coal Younger”, driven by James Kennedy, past the 3/4 pole. After review by the stewards, #1 was placed fifth (5th) for interference.

RULINGS ISSUED THIS WEEK

- 03/20/09 37 Trainer Robley Johnson, who started the horse “Red Star Engineer” in the First Race at Cal Expo on February 13, 2009, is hereby fined the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer To Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843 (D) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances - Phenylbutazone (6.36 ug/ml) in Excess of Permitted Level) Class IV (Second Offense) that carries a Class C penalty.
- This fine is to be paid in installments of Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars within seven (7) days and Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars by the 15th of April 2009, and Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars by the 15th of May 2009.
- 03/20/09 38 Driver Steve Wiseman, who drove “Leadmeastray” in the Tenth Race on March 14, 2009, is hereby fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1721 (I) (Driving Rules – Commit an Act Which Shall Impede the Progress of Another Horse (3/4 Pole) – Resulting in a Disqualification).
