Proceedings of the Board of Stewards for the period of Monday, July 02, 2007 through Sunday, June 08 2007. Steward Michael W. "Wayne" Oke was the Reporting and Duty Steward for the enclosed period.

The race office was open today taking entries for Friday July 06, 2007 and Saturday July 07, 2007. One hundred and two (102) horses were drawn into twelve (12) races for Friday July 06, 2007 with scratch time at the draw.

Ninety three (93) horses were drawn into twelve (12) races for Saturday July 07, 2007 with scratch time Thursday July 05, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.

Scratch time for Saturday July 07, 2007 was at 9:00 a.m. today. There were eight (8) driver changes for Saturday's card.

Additionally, twenty one (21) horses were drawn into four (4) qualifying races to be contested at 4: 00 p.m.

07/05/07 (2) Film Review

L. Pena attended with the stewards to review the films of Race #3 on Saturday June 30, 2007. Mr. Pena appeared to not be very aggressive in his drive on #4 "Speedy Feldy". Mr. Pena explained that the horse himself was not very aggressive and additionally had soundness problems.

The stewards suggested Mr. Pena be more aggressive and if the horse is not sound don't enter him. Mr Pena agreed to be more aware in the future.

07/05/07 (3) Qualifying Races

Sixteen (16) out of twenty (20) horses competing were successful in their qualifying effort.

The qualifying races were compromised by a malfunctioning timer.

07/05/07 (4) Fourth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification

The stewards posted the 'inquiry' immediately after the finish of Race #4 to investigate an incident in mid-stretch when #1 "Ridgeline", driven by G. Herrera, broke stride and veered to his right and appeared to interfere with #2 "Red Star Baron", driven by R. Johnson, and then in attempting to correct his path, impeded the progress of #4 "D Jokerman", driven by L. Plano.

After viewing the films and speaking with the drivers involved the stewards concluded that #1 had in fact caused interference with #2 and impeded #4. #1, who finished third (3rd), was disqualified and placed fourth (4th). Driver G. Herrera was held blameless in the incident and no further sanctions were deemed necessary.

07/05/07 (5) Lou Pena Ruling – Race #2

Driver L. Pena programmed to drive "Avid Sportsmind" did not appear in the paddock to post parade his horse until two (2) minutes to post. Driver L. Pena is fined Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) late to post parade.

07/05/07 (8) **Eighth Race – Inquiry/Disqualification**

During the stretch drive #7 "Kudette", driven by Scott Cisco, broke stride and continued through the finish. Utilizing films and the photo finish, the stewards determined that #7 was 'lapped on' by #3 "Direct Alberta" and #5 "Indigo Franco N". #7 finished third (3rd) and was placed fifth (5th) for violation of the 'breaking rule'.

07/06/07 (1) **Fifth Race – Dead Heat for Fourth (4th)**

The stewards were unable to separate #3 "Pebble Beach Rod" and #4 "Something New" at the wire, resulting in a dead heat for fourth (4th).

07/06/07 (2) **Fifth Race – Driver Cautioned**

During the stretch drive, R. Wojcio on #8 "Frank The Bank" was observed with his right foot out of the stirrup. Driver Wojcio was contacted by telephone and stated that the sulky he was using was not setup for him and he had trouble keeping his foot in the stirrup. Driver Wojcio was advised that no further instances of this nature would be tolerated. Since Driver Wojcio had no history of this infraction the stewards felt a warning would suffice on this occasion.

07/06/07 (3) **Eighth Race – Disqualification**

During the running of the Race #8, in an incident just past the half mile pole #7 “Life’s Honor” made a break and impeded the progress of #9 “Pink Stilettos”, driven by R. Plano. The stewards, after reviewing the films, disqualified #7 and placed him behind #9 in the official order of finish. Driver Svendsen was held blameless in the incident.

Herrera who was being assisted by the outrider refused to go to the gate. #8 was left as the remainder of the field was in position and the start proceeded. The 'inquiry' sign. At the conclusion of the race and after conferring with the starter and the outrider, the stewards declared #8 "Enzed Girl N" a 'non-starter'. Driver G. Herrera was held blameless in this incident. "Enzed Girl N" was placed on the Stewards' List.

07/07/07 (4) Twelfth Race – Inquiry/Accident

Approaching the 3/4 pole #2 "Police Cadet", who was first over in the two path, suffered broken equipment 'front left halter hanger came unfastened' causing him to fall. In quick succession #6 "Liner", #7 "Fitch Inter Letrado", #8 "Alison Alison", #9 "Flash The Sign" and #10 "King Of War" fell. #4 "Beast Coast", while bothered, stayed on his feet. The stewards' immediately posted the 'inquiry' and after consultation with other officials and reviewing film, it was unanimously decided to declare the race 'no contest' and refund all monies wagered.
