JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Mario Gutierrez met with the Stewards to review the second race on Sunday in which he drifted in the stretch possibly causing interference. After a review of the available angles of the race, in a majority opinion, Gutierrez was clear when he shifted out in front of #1 King Abner (H. Figueroa 3rd) who was closing with a rush. Mr. Baker felt this was a careless ride and voted for a suspension. Warning.

INQUIRY/ACCIDENT FIFTH RACE NO CHANGE 1 mile-dirt

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start and an incident inside the 1/4 pole. Involved at the start was #2 Wise Curlin (M. Pedroza DNF) who stumbled and unseated its jockey. No other horses were involved in the accident. The second incident involved #1 Taniko (S. Gonzalez 1st), #9 Hard Arch (A. Espinoza 4th). After a review of the available video angles and conversation with both jockeys involved in a unanimous opinion no action was taken. Near the 3/16 marker, #1 while passing #9

on the outside, leaned in, #9 at the same time leaned out and had to steady. Both horses were involved in the incident. The original order of finish was made official.

VOIDED CLAIMS

Apprentice Heriberto Figueroa joined the Stewards to discuss a possible crop violation in the second race on Sunday. After a review it was confirmed he did not violate the rule (1688) but was warned it would benefit him to be less aggressive with the crop. Apprentice Assael Espinoza was directed to meet with the BOS to review the fifth race (ref 08-01-18 (3) that involved an inquiry. Although his ride did not rise to the level of a suspension, the incident was viewed and discussed. Warning. Santiago Gonzales also met with the Stewards to review the fifth race yesterday (ref 08-01-18 (3). The same inquiry as with Espinoza was reviewed and discussed. Warning.

08-02-18²**JOCKEY OBJECTION FIRST RACE NO CHANGE 1 Mile Turf**

Following the running of the race jockey Gary Stevens aboard #3 Streak of Luck who finished second (neck) lodged an objection against #2 Clearly Gone (F. Prat 1st) for possible interference in the stretch. After a review of the video and conversation with both jockeys it was a unanimous opinion that the majority of the minor contact came from #3 and the original order of finish was made official.

Santiago Gonzalez joined the BOS to discuss his ride approaching the first turn in the fifth race yesterday in which two horses to his inside were in tight quarters. He was told moving forward he needs to be more aware of his surroundings, he agreed. Warning.

DMTD RULING #009

Expired Licensee (Exercise Rider) Luis Hernandez having now appeared for a hearing to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rule #1489 (8) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License) is deemed eligible for relicensing and Los Angeles Turf Club ruling #39, dated February 13, 2014, suspending Mr. Hernandez for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is set aside. Further, Luis Hernandez must sign a testing agreement with the CHRB and shall abide by the terms of that agreement.

JOCKEY FILM REVIEW

Israel Ocampo met with the Stewards to review the start of the eighth race in which he was warned he needs to react more quickly correcting his mount at the start. Also to discuss the designated time to report his weight to the Clerk of Scales. He was an hour late reporting his weight yesterday, his penalty is listed in the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #010

Jockey ISRAEL OCAMPO is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100)* for late reporting of weight for the fifth race on August 3, 2018 at Del Mar Race Track; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1682 (Weighing Out).

TRICAR STABLE INC. (DANIEL CARDENAS) HEARING CASE 18SA0186 ref 7-22-18 (5)

This hearing was continued when it became apparent a formal setting was necessary after the parties involved could not reach an agreement on the alleged money owed by Daniel Cardenas (Tricar Stables, Inc) to veterinarian practice, von Bluecher, Blea, Hunkin Inc.

In attendance before the BOS were, Dr. Jeff Blea, Dr. Helmuth von Bluecher, their counsel Steve Schwartz, Daniel Cardenas, Sal Gonzalez, trainer and interpreter for his owner and court reporter Michelle Derieg recorded the proceedings.

The practice alleges \$23,917.00 is due for services rendered. Daniel Cardenas, owner of Tricar Stables, countered that he is due financial consideration for alleged negligence pertaining to an insurance form improperly filled out when filed with an insurance company.

All witnesses were sworn in, exhibits were entered into evidence and the hearing was closed with a decision to follow.

INQUIRY/ACCIDENT DISQUALIFICATION TENTH RACE 1 mile turf

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an accident that occurred near the 1/8 pole. Involved were #4 Aussie Fox (A. Espinoza 3rd), #8 Irish Spring (C. Nakatani DNF) and #11 Bitter Ring (G. Franco DNF). In a unanimous decision, #4 crossed over in front of #8 without sufficient clearance causing #8 to clip heels and fall. #11 fell over the top of #8. #4 was disqualified from third position and placed unplaced.

08-05-18²**JOCKEY FILM REVIEW ref 08-04-18 (5)**

Apprentice Assael Espinoza along with his agent Brian Beach met with the Stewards to review the accident in the tenth race yesterday. Mr. Espinoza stated his horse veered inward when it saw his crop. The BOS could not agree with his assessment. It was a unanimous opinion that when he took his right hand off of the rein his horse drifted into the path of the horse to his inside who clipped heels and fell. It was a unanimous decision to issue the penalty listed in the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #011

Apprentice Jockey ASSAEL ESPINOZA, who rode AUSSIE FOX in the tenth race at Del Mar Race Track on Saturday, August 4, 2018 is suspended for TEN (10) racing days (August 12, 15,16,17,18,19,22,23,24 and August 25, 2018) for altering course without sufficient clearance and causing interference entering the stretch resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to unplaced; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) (e) (Riding Rules - Careless Riding). The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.
