07-24-18¹

SCRATCH DAY

Scratches and changes for Wednesday, July 25, 2018 took place in the backstretch racing office. Steward Grant Baker was on duty. Three (3) scratches, six (6) corrected weights, three (3) jockey changes and three (3) equipment changes were taken by Assistant Clerk of Scales Charlie McCaul. All changes were activated after the 10:00 a.m. deadline.

GARY STEVENS FILM REVIEW

Jockey Gary Stevens appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the sixth race (Wickerr Stakes-\$75,000 Added) which was contested at one (1) mile on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course. Jockey Stevens was aboard first place finisher #13 Double Touch (GB) who survived a Stewards' inquiry (REF: 7/22/18(6) in this race. The purpose of the Inquiry was to investigate an incident at or just before the finish line with second place finisher #14 Bombard (Flavien Prat).

Today's film review shows Jockey Stevens and his charge #13 Double Touch (GB) drift out roughly five (5) or six (6) horse paths from the 1/8th pole to the wire where he brushes second place finisher #14 Bombard. Jockey Stevens was applying his riding crop (right-handed) during this time. The Stewards reviewed all replay angles with Jockey Stevens who felt he made his best riding effort possible. In a majority decision Stevens was issued a warning. Steward Baker dissented (3 day suspension) feeling the drift was too substantial and that Mr. Stevens' ride was careless.

MARTIN PEDROZA FILM REVIEWS

Jockey Martin Pedroza appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his rides' in two (2) races on Sunday, July 22, 2018. These were the fourth and eighth races.

RACE 4- Jockey Pedroza was aboard #8 Silken Spy who finished sixth in this five (5) furlong turf event. At about the 4½ furlong marker Jockey Pedroza was riding aggressively away from the starting gate. This film review was conducted in order to check on Jockey Pedroza's involvement with #7 Ruby Trust (Gary Stevens) steadying. Some outside 'pressure' from eventual winner #13 Kentan Road (Asa Espinosa) mitigated Jockey Pedroza's involvement. Warning issued.

RACE 8- Jockey Pedroza was aboard #8 Multiplier, who finished fifth, in the \$250,000 Eddie Read Stakes (Grade 2) which was congested at 1 1/8th miles on the Jimmy Durante Course (Turf). In the stretch run of this race Jockey Pedroza was applying his riding crop (right-handed) when he drifted into the path of seventh place finisher #1 True Valour (IRE) (Jamie Spencer) forcing that rival to 'check' his mount. #8 Multiplier was tiring at the time of the incident. The Steward's felt this was Jockey Pedroza's second sub-par effort of the afternoon. Once again, in a unanimous decision, another warning was issued.

ASA ESPINOZA FILM REVIEW

Apprentice Jockey Asa Espinoza appeared in the Stewards' office in order to review his ride aboard #6 Italiano, who finished first, in the third race on Sunday, July 22, 2018. #6 Italiano finished a half-length in front of #5 Goodwillambassador (Geovanni Franco). In the final sixteenth of a mile in this race #6 Italiano drifts out somewhat before Apprentice Espinoza straightens his mount approaching the wire. The Stewards' told the young apprentice, who has never received a sanction for careless riding, that in order to stay 'out of our office' he must maintain a straighter course. Warning issued.

THIRD RACE OBJECTION

Following the running of this race 'Quick Official' employee Larry Gilligan informed the Stewards that a jockey's claim of foul had been lodged. Jockey Evin Roman, aboard second place finisher #9 Lambo Luxx claimed 'foul' against first place finisher #6 Bow and Arrow (Ruben Fuentes) for alleged stretch interference. This was a 5 ½ furlong event with a claiming price of \$8,000.

Both of these aforementioned horses were locked in a stretch duel from the 3/16ths pole to the finish. #6 Bow and Arrow drifts inward in this stretch drive and makes contact with #9 Lambo Luxx forcing this one off of his straight path. The official margin between these two (2) rivals at the finish was a 'head'. In a majority vote (Steward Baker dissent DQ 1st to 2nd) the original placings were allowed to stand. No change. Jockey Ruben Fuentes film review.

FOURTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards' posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an incident between the first two (2) finishers in the stretch drive of this Five (5) furlong turf event. The official margin between first place finisher #7 Stormy Liberal (Drayden Van Dyke) and second place finisher #5 Tribalist (Tyler Baze) was a nose. These horses were 'head and head' during the entire stretch drive of this race. Film review shows #5 Tribalist drifted out twice and made contact with #7 Stormy Liberal. In the first 'incident' #7 Stormy Liberal may have contributed to the contact by stepping in slightly. After reviewing all camera angles the Stewards, in a unanimous decision allowed the original placings to stand. Jockey Tyler Baze was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

SIXTH RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW

Following the running of the 6th race (One Mile-Turf) the Stewards called for a Stewards'

Review in order to 'take a look' at the start. Of particular interest were the actions of #1 Kinematico (Joesph Talamo). This horse threw its head in the air and was off very slowly. The Stewards determined that this tardy dispatch was not due to mechanical failure nor human error. There was no reason for a formal Inquiry.

TYLER BAZE FILM REVIEW (REF: 7/25/18 (5))

Jockey Tyler Baze appeared in the Stewards office in order to review his ride aboard #5 Tribalist who was beaten a nose in yesterday's (July 25) fourth race. Jockey Baze was aboard #5 Tribalist who survived a Stewards Inquiry after contact with eventual winner #7 Stormy Liberal (Drayden Van Dyke) in the stretch drive of this race. Jockey Van Dyke hand rode his horse the majority of the stretch. Jockey Baze used his riding crop very vigorously (left and right handed) and drifted out and made contact with the winner while doing so. Jockey Baze acknowledged that he could have done a better job maintaining a straight course. In a unanimous decision Jockey Baze was issued a 'warning' for this ride.

ACTIONCAT THOROUGHBREDS COMPLAINT (CASE NO.18LT0001)

The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

Owner Actioncat Thoroughbreds is indebted to Bonnie Acres ranch for board and care of thoroughbred race horse 'Incensed'. Total \$549.00.

Accountant Patricia Valenzuela appeared today representing Bonnie Acres (R.K. Mitchell). The Stewards dismissed this complaint in a unanimous decision. The basis for our decision was CHRB Rule #1876 (e)(1). This rule states - *Financial responsibility complaints submitted by horse farms will be considered provided the complaint is for not less than one thousand dollars and is related to the horse operations of a person licensed by the Board.*

G.F. ALMEIDA INFORMAL HEARING

Trainer G.F. Almeida appeared in the Stewards’ office at our request this morning. CHRB Veterinarian Will Farmer notified the Stewards yesterday (July 26) that the Almeida trained #2 Treasure Hunter was not only late to the receiving barn yesterday but also last to the paddock for pre-race saddling. Trainer Almeida told the Stewards that he didn’t hear the "20 minute call’ in the stable area prior to a late arrival in the receiving barn. The other six (6) horses for this race arrived in a timely fashion. After meeting with Trainer Almeida, the Stewards, in a unanimous decision issued the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #004

Trainer G.F. ALMEIDA, who started the horse TREASURE HUNTER, in the fourth race at Del Mar Race Track on July 26, 2018 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn – late to the receiving barn).

ALONSO QUINONEZ MEETING

Jockey Alonso Quinonez visited our office this morning. He wanted to inform us that he was firing his agent J.R. Pegram. We thanked him for that information. We also told him we would not decide any potential disputed monies owed until if and/or when that situation arises.

RUEBEN FUENTES FILM REVIEW (REF: 7/25/18 (4))

Jockey Ruben Fuentes appeared in the Stewards office to review his ride in the 3rd race on Wednesday, July 25. In this 5 ½ furlong main track event Jockey Fuentes was aboard first place finisher #6 Bow and Arrow. This horse and rider survived a ‘jockey’s claim of foul’ in this race made by Jockey Evin Roman who was aboard second place finisher #9 Lambo Luxx (Evin Roman).

Film review this morning shows #6 Bow and Arrow drift in and contact the second-place finisher. The Stewards felt this was a sub-par effort as Jockey Fuentes should have made a better effort to maintain a straight course. All the Stewards felt this ride 'fell short' of issuing a riding suspension. Warning issued.

07-27-18⁴

FIRST RACE INQUIRY/ACCIDENT

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign after viewing an accident at around the ¼ mile marker in this 5 ½ furlong main track event. #3 Back Beauty (Matt Garcia) was 'lugging out' from the start of this race. Film review appeared to show #3 Back Beauty clip the heels of #5 Devil's Beauty who the Stewards held blameless. The actions of second place finisher #9 Gemini Journey (Martin Pedroza) were also investigated. This horse was racing along the rail and shifted outward while Jockey Garcia was having severe control issues (lugging out) with #3 Back Beauty. The Stewards did not hold #9 Gemini Journey responsible for the accident, however this horse did get close to the horse that Jockey Garcia was struggling with.

After Back Beauty fell, she jogged off and was caught by a track outrider. Jockey Matt Garcia was examined at a local medical clinic, and cleared to ride his remaining (8th Race) mount on the day's card. Jockey Martin Pedroza was ordered to film review with the Stewards.

EIGHTH RACE POST PARADE ACCIDENT

Roughly three (3) minutes prior to the eighth (last) race #11 Beat the Chalk (Kyle Frey) reared and fell in front of the grandstand unseating Jockey Frey. This horse was subsequently scratched by the Stewards. The human ambulance transported Jockey Frey to First Aid. There was a nine (9) minute delay to this race as we had to wait for the 2nd human (backup) ambulance to get into position behind the starting gate.

SANTIAGO GONZALEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Santiago Gonzalez appeared in our office to review his ride in yesterday's 3rd race which was contested at one (1) mile on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course. Jockey Gonzalez was aboard #7 The Hunted, who finished third in this race. Films this morning show #7 The Hunted shifted in entering the first turn without sufficient clearance into the path of seventh place finisher #2 Celturian (Martin Pedroza) causing that rival to take up slightly. The Stewards cautioned Jockey Gonzalez to allow more clearance before 'crossing over. Warning issued.

MARTIN PEDROZA FILM REVIEW (REF: 7/28/18 (4))

Jockey Martin Pedroza appeared in the racing office to review his ride in the first race Friday, July 27. Jockey Pedroza was aboard #9 Gemini Journey who finished second in this 5 ½ furlong main track event. In the race yesterday #3 Back Beauty (Matt Garcia) who was lugging out throughout the race, fell after apparently clipping heels with another rival. Films today show Jockey Pedroza swing his horse out towards the incident. The Stewards didn't place any blame on Jockey Pedroza, but he was riding aggressively near a horse that wasn't steering well. In a unanimous decision a warning was issued following this film review.

JAMES OLIVER COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18LT0011)

The complaint against Owner James Oliver in this matter reads as follows:

Owner James Oliver is indebted to Trainer Librado Barocio for training fees for Thoroughbred race horses 'Backstreet Lisa', 'My Summer Bird' and 'Prohibition Repeal'. Total \$26, 216.00.

James Oliver was out of state today and sent proof he was attending to a sick relative.

Librado Barocio told the Stewards he didn't know this hearing was scheduled for today. Both parties sent the Stewards separate proposed unofficial payment agreements that could potentially settle this matter. More to follow.

NEW COURSE RECORD

The seventh race today was the \$150,000 California Dreamin' Stakes (Purse \$150,000 Guaranteed). This race was contested at 1 1/16 miles on the Jimmy Durante Turf Course. The Peter Miller trained Fly to Mars (Flavien Prat) finished first, tripping the timer in 139.50. This establishes a New Course Record (NCR) narrowly eclipsing the standard set by Sidney's Candy (139.52) on August 14, 2010.

NINTH RACE INQUIRY

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the Grade 1 Bing Crosby Stakes (\$300,000-Grade 1). The Stewards wanted to investigate the stretch drive of this six (6) furlong main track event. The purpose of the Inquiry was to review the actions of second place finisher #3 Roy H (Kent Desormeaux) and fourth place finisher #9 Edwards Going Left (Drayden Van Dyke).

Race replays show #3 Roy H drift out twice in the stretch drive, once making light contact with #9 Edwards Going Left. The Stewards received jockey and Patrol Judge input. After reviewing all camera angles the Stewards unanimously ruled that this incident fell short of changing the original placings. No change. Jockey Kent Desormeaux was ordered to film review.

R.B. HESS JR. RULING

CHRB Veterinarian Will Farmer informed the Stewards yesterday (July 28) that the R.B. Hess trained 'Smart Dorie' was improperly shod (behind) to race on the turf course. Horseshoe Inspector Victor Tovar replaced the hind shoes on the filly so it would be allowed to compete in this race. The Stewards contacted Trainer Hess later in the afternoon and he accepted the sanction that is memorialized in the following ruling.

DMTD RULING #005

Trainer R.B. Hess Jr. who started the horse SMART DORIE, in the second race at Del Mar Race Track on July 28, 2018 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required – improperly shod).

MIKE SMITH RULING

Mike Smith rode #2 Grecian Fire to a second place finish in the seventh race yesterday (July 28). The Stewards thought Jockey Smith may have violated CHRB Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop) by striking his mount more than three (3) consecutive times without giving his horse a chance to respond. During the races' yesterday Jockey Smith informed the Stewards that he was waving his right to a film review and accepted the penalty listed below.

DMTD RULING #006

Jockey MIKE SMITH is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (B) (6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond – first offense in the last sixty days), during the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on July 28, 2018.

KENT DESORMEAUX FILM REVIEW (7/28/18(5))

Jockey Kent Desormeaux appeared in the Stewards Office to review his ride aboard #3 Roy H in the \$300,000 Grade 1 Bing Crosby Stakes which was the ninth race on the card yesterday (July 28). He drifted out twice in the stretch drive of this race, once making contact with fourth place finisher #9 Edwards Going Left (Drayden Van Dyke). In a unanimous decision Jockey Desormeaux was issued a ‘warning’ for this ride. This is the second warning that Jockey Desormeaux has received following nine (9) previous days of racing.

RECORD MINUS POOL

The Jerry Hollendorfer trained ‘Unique Bella’ (Mike Smith) won today’s \$300,000 Guaranteed (Grade 1) Clement L. Hirsch Stakes. \$742,267 was wagered on this champion filly to show out of a total of \$813,491.29 bet in the pool. Director of Mutuels Bill Navarro reported that the minus show pool following this race was \$143,684. This breaks a Del Mar record when there was a minus show pool of \$136,677.27 when the great ‘Cigar’ finished second to Dare n’ Go in the Pacific Classic on August 10, 1996 according to Del Mar Senior Media Coordinator Dan Smith.

VETERINARIAN REPORT – WEEK OF 7/25/17 TO 7/29/17
