Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of April 16, 2019 through April 20, 2019.

THURSDAY

4/18/2019

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Tom Ward was in the office for this abbreviated week of racing, as there will be no racing on Easter Sunday. Entries went well, with both cards being drawn in the early afternoon. Even though there were no entries on Thursday, Ward was in for scratches and checking workouts for Saturday. Additionally, there were several items which took place via telephone with respect to the coming week. No Cal-Breds.

FRIDAY

4/19/2019

(1) EARLY DECLARATIONS

5th race- #4 Mister Tornado (Stewards-entered back) refund of \$281.00

8th race- #3 Feature Ms Bo (Vet-sick) refund of \$157.00

(2) ACUNA HEARING

Trainer Nick Acuna was in the office this afternoon in response to a complaint filed by the Board alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1902.5 (Animal Welfare). The complaint alleged that an inspection of his stalls showed that there was insufficient bedding in the four stalls assigned to him. He admitted that the bedding was not up to acceptable standards, but said that the pictures taken of the stall included in the complaint was not one occupied by a horse.

(3) REFUND

A refund was ordered in the second race as #4 Victoriously Jewel was "choppy" in both forelegs during warm up and was declared on the advice of Racing Veterinarian Fitzgerald. The refund amounted to \$12,954.00

(4) CLAIM VOIDED

The claim deposited in the second race by trainer Jesus Uranga for #5 "Holy Plan" was voided as the horse exhibited soreness in the left knee while in the detention barn. The horse was returned to the barn of trainer Jesus Nunez.

(5) REFUND

A refund was ordered in the fifth race as #5 "Bo Times 9" unseated the rider, Erasmo Gasca, and ran off into the stable area. The refund totaled \$11,913.00.

(1) RULINGS

RULING # 96

JOCKEY OSCAR ANDRADE JR. IS FINED ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-SECOND OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON APRIL 19, 2019.

RULING # 97

JOCKEY JAIRO RANGEL IS FINED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND-FIRST OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD), DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON APRIL 19, 2019.

These rulings were issued as neither rider chose to offer an excuse for violating the "crop" rule.

(2) RULING

RULING # 98

TRAINER NICOLAS ACUNA IS FINED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1000.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1902.5 (ANIMAL WELFARE)-(INSUFFICIENT BEDDING).

The foregoing ruling was issued to finalize the case against Mr. Acuna (Ref 4-19-19 #2).

(3) RULING

RULING # 99

JOCKEY RAUL RAMIREZ, HAVING NOW RESPONDED TELEPHONICALLY BEFORE THE BOARD OF STEWARDS AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE, IS RESTORED TO GOOD STANDING. RULING #172, ISSUED AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON OCTOBER 27, 2012, IS SET ASIDE.

This ruling was issued after Mr. Ramirez contacted this Board of Stewards regarding his failure to appear for a hearing in 2012. The original charge was dismissed.

(4) REFUND

A refund was ordered in the seventh race as #7 "Gray Invader" flipped while in the saddling paddock, prompting Racing Veterinarian Becky Fitzgerald to recommend that the horse be declared. The refund amounted to \$2,086.40.
