Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of July 25, 2017 through July 30, 2017.

Tuesday

07/25/2017

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Steward Ron Church will supervise entries, declarations and record the minutes for this reporting period.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Friday's eight race program was completed at 2:30 p.m. consisting of six Quarter Horse, one Thoroughbred and one mixed Quarter Horse/Thoroughbred race.

(3) CAL-BRED

The fourth race in the condition book, for Cal-Bred maiden three year olds claiming \$2500 at a distance of 300 yards, was called off with no entries.

Wednesday

07/26/2017

(1) SCRATCHES AND CHANGES

Friday's scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in two jockey changes and three equipment changes.

(2) ENTRIES AND CAL-BRED REPORT

Saturday's entire program will be comprised of twelve CAL-BRED Quarter Horse races, with a total of 91 entries. Highlighting the program will be the \$390,000 Governor's Cup Futurity and the \$203,000 Governor's Cup Derby.

(1) SCRATCHES AND CHANGES

Scratch time was completed at 9:00 a.m resulting in three jockey changes for Saturday's program.

(2) THE DRAW

Four Quarter Horse, two Thoroughbred and two mixed Quarter Horse/Thoroughbred races will complete Sunday's eight race program.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The first race in the condition book, for Cal-Bred maiden two year olds claiming \$10,000 at a distance of 300 yards, was called off with three entries.

Friday

07/28/2017

(1) SCRATCHES AND CHANGES

Scratches were completed at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one scratch and no other changes for Sunday's program.

(2) FILMS – ROBERTO HERNANDEZ

Jockey Hernandez was in to review the sixth race from Saturday July, 22, when his mount drifted out. He was cautioned a better effort is required. Hernandez was in agreement with us and offered he would do a better job in the future. A warning was issued.

(3) GARCIA RULINGS #191 AND #192

RULING # 191

JOCKEY EDDIE S. GARCIA IS FINED THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(2) (USE OF RIDING CROP). PRIOR TO THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 23, 2017.

RULING # 192

JOCKEY EDDIE S. GARCIA IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND – FIRST OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD). DURING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 23, 2017.

After reviewing the seventh race from Sunday July 23, with Jockey Eddie Garcia, the foregoing rulings were issued.

(4) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards immediately posted the inquiry sign following the running of the fourth race, to review an incident shortly after the start. Involved were #4 "California Courage" (4th – Jockey M. Ramirez), #3 "Sadies Jett" (7th – Jockey R. Arvizu) and #2 "One Eagle B" (6th – Jockey C. DeAlba). After reviewing the video replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #4 from fourth to seventh. Replays reflect #4 shifting into #3, bumping and impeding #3 down and into #2, costing the latter two an opportunity at a better placing.

(5) SEVENTH RACE – VOIDED CLAIM

After a soundness inspection by official veterinarian Dr. Nolton Pattio in the seventh race, #3 "Race Lyn" was placed on the veterinarian's list as unsound. The claim was voided, and the horse was returned to the stable of Lin Melton.

(1) CHRB RULE #1683 INVOKED

Trainer Scott Willoughby representing his owner Edward Allred, visited the Stewards office to invoke CHRB Rule #1683, maximum overweight and removed Jockey Carlos Huerta from Mr. Allred's horses on Saturday July 29th and Sunday July 30th.

(2) RULING #193

RULING # 193

JOCKEY MINOR ARANA WHO RODE "BLU RUNNER" IN THE SIXTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FRIDAY, JULY 28, 2017, IS SUSPENDED FIVE (5) RACING DAYS (AUGUST 5TH, 6TH, 11TH, 12TH AND 13TH 2017) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES – CARELESS RIDING).

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766 (DESIGNATED RACES), THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The foregoing ruling was issued after the Stewards reviewed the sixth race from Friday night with Mr. Arana who failed to control his mount from drifting out using his right arm to interfere with the momentum of #3 Magic Toshiko Magic.

(3) RULING #194

RULING # 194

JOCKEY MARCIAL RAMIREZ, WHO RODE "CALIFORNIA COURAGE" IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON FRIDAY, JULY 28, 2017, IS SUSPENDED THREE (3) RACING DAYS (AUGUST 5TH, 6TH AND 11TH 2017) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE AT THE START, CAUSING INTERFERENCE WHICH RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF HIS MOUNT FROM FOURTH TO SEVENTH POSITION. THIS CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES – CARELESS RIDING).

PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766 (DESIGNATED RACES), THE TERM OF THIS SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES IN CALIFORNIA.

The foregoing ruling was issued after the Stewards met with Jockey Marcial Ramirez concerning his ride in Friday night's fourth race. Mr. Ramirez allowed his mount to break in sharply, impeding the horses to his inside, resulting in his disqualification.

(4) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards immediately posted the inquiry sign following the running of the fourth race (Quarter Horse 350 yards) to review an incident at the break. Involved were #4 "Beach Bum Foose" (5th – Jockey Tony Guymon) #3 "Unblemished" (6th – Jockey Jesus Ayala) and #2 "Live it Up" (10th Jockey G. Jairo Rangel). After reviewing the tape replays the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #4 from fifth to tenth. Replays show #4 ducks in sharply, bumping and impeding #3 and #2 off stride, costing the latter an opportunity of a better placement.

(5) NINTH RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards had the inquiry sign posted following the running of the ninth race (Quarter Horse – 400 yards) to review an incident nearing the 1/16th pole. Involved were #7 "Renewed" (5th – Jockey Eduardo Nicasio) and #8 "Ajs Anna Smoke" (9th Jockey Cesar DeAlba) After reviewing the tape replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #7 from fifth to ninth. Replays show #7 shifts out sharply, and impedes #8, costing the latter an opportunity of a better placement.

(6) ELEVENTH RACE – CLAIM VOIDED

The eleventh race claim of “School Prez” by Trainer Adriana Aceves was voided after Dr. Pattio placed the horse on the Vet’s list as unsound. The horse was returned to the stable of Trainer Valentin Zamudio.

APPRENTICE JOCKEY CESAR FRANCO IS FINED FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$400.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1688(b)(6) (USE OF RIDING CROP-MORE THAN THREE TIMES IN SUCCESSION, WITHOUT GIVING THE HORSE A CHANCE TO RESPOND – FOURTH OFFENSE WITHIN THE PREVIOUS 60 DAY PERIOD). DURING THE EIGHTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 29, 2017.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey Cesar Franco violated CHRB Rule #1688(b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop).

(2) RULING #196 AND #197

RULING # 196

JOCKEY TONY GUYMON IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1683(MAXIMUM OVERWEIGHT) IN THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 29, 2017.

RULING # 197

JOCKEY TONY GUYMON, WHO RODE “BEACH BUMN FOOSE” IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 29TH, 2017, IS SUSPENDED FOR THREE RACING DAYS (AUGUST 6TH, 11TH AND 12TH, 2017) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE AT THE START, CAUSING INTERFERENCE WHICH RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF HIS MOUNT FROM FIFTH TO TENTH POSITION. THIS CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES—CARELESS RIDING). PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766(DESIGNATED RACES) THE TERM OF SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES.

The foregoing rulings were issued after Jockey Tony Guymon met with the Stewards, and offered his explanation of the preceding rules violations.

(3) RULING #198

RULING # 198

JOCKEY RAMON SANCHEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT-AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR IN THE JOCKEYS’ ROOM) FOLLOWING THE SEVENTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 29TH, 2017.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Sanchez, failed to offer a reasonable explanation for his behavior.

(4) RULING #199

RULING # 199

JOCKEY EDUARDO NICASIO, WHO RODE "RENEWED" IN THE NINTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 29TH, 2017, IS SUSPENDED FOR THREE RACING DAYS (AUGUST 6TH, 11TH AND 12TH, 2017) FOR FAILURE TO MAKE THE PROPER EFFORT TO MAINTAIN A STRAIGHT COURSE, CAUSING INTERFERENCE WHICH RESULTED IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF HIS MOUNT FROM FIFTH TO NINTH POSITION. THIS CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1699 (RIDING RULES—CARELESS RIDING). PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1766(DESIGNATED RACES) THE TERM OF SUSPENSION SHALL NOT PROHIBIT PARTICIPATION IN DESIGNATED RACES.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Jockey Eduardo Nicasio, allowed his mount to drift out, impeding horses to his outside.

(5) STEWARDS - INQUIRY - ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign immediately following the running of the first race. (Thoroughbreds 4 ½ furlongs) to evaluate an incident near the 1/16th pole in which #8 "Amazing Lady" (Jockey R. Guce) racing on the lead, fell, unseating Jockey Guce. #1 "Sharpest One" (Jockey J. Sanchez), who was chasing the leader, fell over #8 unseating her rider, and #3 "Lucky Feelin" (Jockey S. Arias) was trailing and could not avoid the two fallen rivals, unseated her jockey. Huntington Ambulance was quickly on the scene to attend to the fallen riders, Jockeys R. Guce and J. Sanchez were complaining of shoulder pain and were transported to UC Irvine Medical Center for evaluation. Jockey S. Arias walked back to the Jockeys room uninjured. #8 Amazing Lady was euthanized.

(6) FIRST RACE – VOIDED CLAIMS

After a soundness inspection by official veterinarian Dr. Nolton Pattio in the first race. #1 "Sharpest One" was placed on the veterinarians list as unsound. The claim was voided and the horse was returned to the stable of Jesus Nunez.

(7) FOURTH RACE – VOIDED CLAIMS

After a soundness inspection by Dr. Pattio #2 Trickortreat was placed on the vets list as unsound. The claim was voided and the horse was returned to former trainer Jesus Nunez. #4 "RULE HE WILL" was also found to be unsound. The claim was voided and the horse was returned to former trainer Mark Glatt.
