Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of October 1, 2013 through October 6, 2013.

TUESDAY

10/01/2013

(1) DUTY STEWARD

Ruben Moreno will be on duty this week attending to morning office matters and recording the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Friday night's card consisting of three Thoroughbred and six Quarter Horse events.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Friday, California-bred maiden two year olds, claiming price \$12,500 going 300 yards, failed to fill with one entry (1 CAL-BRED). Sub #1 in the book also for Friday, California-bred two year olds, claiming price \$4,000, going 330 yards, failed to fill with no entries (0 CAL-BREDS).

WEDNESDAY

10/02/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Friday scratches were taken at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, no rider changes and one equipment change for Friday's program.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Saturday night's card consisting of two Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse events. The draw was completed at 2:00 p.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Saturday, California-bred maiden two year olds, going 350 yards, went open with seven entries (3 CAL-BREDS). Sub #5 in the book also for Saturday, California-bred three year olds and upwards, claiming price \$4,000 going 300 yards, failed to fill with no entries.

THURSDAY

10/03/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Saturday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one first time gelding report, no scratches, no rider changes, and two equipment changes for Saturday evening's program.

(2) ENTRIES AND DRAW

Nine races were drawn for Sunday night's card consisting of one Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse events. The eight Quarter Horse events consisted of four regular races and four Wild West Futurity Trials.

(3) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Sunday, California-bred maiden two year olds, going 330 yards, failed to fill with two entries (2 CAL-BREDS). Sub #1 in the book for Sunday, California-bred two year olds, claiming price \$10,000, going 330 yards, also failed to fill with two entries (2 CAL-BREDS).

FRIDAY

10/04/2013

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratches for Sunday were held at 9:00 a.m. resulting in no scratches, one rider change, and no equipment changes for Sunday evening's program.

(2) FISCAL WARNING

Trainer Sergio Fiscal appeared before the Stewards to discuss the phenylbutazone count that was found in the blood sample that was taken from "Paulinas Prayer" after having been worked on August 24, 2013 for removal from the Veterinarian's List. After discussing the high Bute count with Trainer Sergio Fiscal and in considering all mitigating circumstances, a warning was issued in lieu of a fine.

(3) LOPEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey Jose Lopez appeared before the Stewards to review his ride in the fifth race on Sunday, September 29, 2013 aboard #3 "Catzdailydictation." The topic of discussion was the poor ride he demonstrated when he pulled his mount up after being mildly brushed by #4 "Juana Gallos." The Stewards pointed out that film review showed what appeared to be a very lackluster attempt on the jockey's part and that the betting public deserved and expected a better effort. A stern warning was issued.

(4) SEVENTH RACE – OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the race, the trainer of #5 "Vodka With Ice" (3rd – C. De Alba), Pablo Rabasa Jr., claimed an Objection against #6 "Gallant Mystic" (2nd – R. Sanchez). After reviewing the race and speaking with the riders involved, the Stewards could find no evidence of any incident that would warrant a change in the order of finish.

(5) VOIDED CLAIM

Trainer Vince Smith's third race \$2,500 claim on #1 "Pretty Darn Quick" (Tr. R. Hanson) was voided by the Stewards after Track Veterinarian Dr. Gary Beck's examination of the four year old gelding at the Receiving Barn post-race found him to be unsound. "Pretty Darn Quick" was placed on the Vet's List and returned to Trainer Ryan Hanson's barn.

(1) MARQUEZ FILM REVIEW

Jockey's Guild Representative, Jockey Jay Conklin, appeared before the Stewards to represent Jockey Carlos Marquez who was unable to attend due to riding commitments in Arizona. Under review was Jockey Marquez's ride in the first race on October 4, 2013, where his mount, #1 "Paseo De Ramon," drifted out entering the stretch and bumped the horse on his outside. While the damage was minimal in this instance, a warning was issued to advise Jockey Marquez that he needs to keep a straighter course in the future.

(2) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE

During the running of the fourth race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards), at or about the 1/16th pole, while racing in the clear, #6 "This Fire Is Mine" (G. Arriaga – D.N.F.) went wrong behind and fell to the track surface, catapulting Jockey Gregorio Arriaga over his head. "This Fire Is Mine" got back to his feet, galloped off and was caught by the outrider. Jockey Arriaga was immediately attended to by E.M.T.'s and transported by ambulance to U.C. Irvine Trauma Center for evaluation. No change to the order of finish was warranted.

While waiting for the start of the sixth race, #7 "Micato" flipped in the gate and injured Jockey Rodrigo Aceves. Jockey Aceves was immediately attended to by E.M.T.'s and transported to Los Alamitos General Hospital where further evaluation determined his ankle had been broken. "Micato" returned to the Saddling Paddock where he was saddled with Jockey Carlos Marquez's tack and returned to the starting gate. After being delayed, the sixth race was run without further incident. "Micato" finished sixth in an eight-horse field.
