Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of January 25, 2011 through January 30, 2011.

TUESDAY

01/25/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

James Dreyer will have morning duties and will record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fifth race in the book for Friday, allowance three year olds, was called off with no entries.

The seventh race in the book for Friday, four year olds for a claiming price of \$8,000, was called off with two (no Cal-Breds).

(3) THE DRAW

Three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races will be offered Friday evening. Highlighting the program will be the Los Alamitos Winter Derby Trials which attracted thirty-four horses and will go in four divisions.

(1) SCRATCHES

Scratch time was completed at 9:00 a.m. resulting in one rider change.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The third race in the book for Saturday, three year olds for a \$4,000 tag, was called off with one (no Cal-Breds).

The seventh race in the book for Saturday, four year olds for a claiming price of \$10,000, failed to attract a single entry.

(3) THE DRAW

Four trials for the Los Alamitos Winter Championship will be included in the six Quarter Horse and four Thoroughbred races for Saturday evening.

Scratch time was completed at 9:00 a.m. with three rider changes being the only adjustments to Saturday's program.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book for Sunday, maiden three year olds for an \$8,000 tag, was called off with two (2 Cal-Breds).

The fourth race in the book for Sunday, maiden three year olds, was called off with no entries.

(3) THE DRAW

After a very difficult day in the entry booth ten races were finally compiled consisting of three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races.

FRIDAY

(1) SCRATCHES

There were no changes or scratches on Sunday's program.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Gerardo Pimient Gavica was in to review the first race Sunday evening in which his mount was disqualified from fifth to seventh. After reviewing the films the Stewards felt that a warning would suffice since a minimal effort was made.

(3) SANTIAGO RODRIGUEZ HEARING (CASE# 10LA0305)

An informal telephonic hearing was held with trainer Santiago Rodriguez this evening. Santiago explained that his vet was late giving the Bute to the horse. He said that in the future he will be more diligent about overseeing his operation. The ruling was issued based on the trainer's previous three year history in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1844 (Authorized Medication) (c) (1), (2), (3), Category "C" Penalties.

(4) GARCIA RULINGRULING #22

GROOM EDGAR GARCIA IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* AND PLACED ON PROBATION FOR THE TERM OF HIS LICENSE FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT).

The above ruling was issued after groom Edgar Garcia accepted full responsibility for his actions while intoxicated although he had no recollection of what those actions were.

(5) CLEAR SAILING

Friday's card was conducted with nothing of reportable significance to report.

(1) ELMER JANUARY HEARING (CASE# 10LA0303)

An informal hearing was conducted to discuss his extremely high Clenbuterol test. Elmer explained that at eighty four he has become very forgetful and must have given the horse a second dose without realizing it. He gives the Clenbuterol orally and always does it himself. I can attest to his forgetfulness having talked to people doing business with him who have confirmed the fact. Elmer was told that all the information will be taken into consideration with a decision to follow at a later date.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Alex Bautista represented Rodrigo Aceves at the films this evening. In the tenth race his mount drifted out while Rodrigo continued riding. The incident did not require the Stewards' involvement however Rodrigo was warned a better effort was expected on his part.

(3) TENTH RACE – INQUIRY - DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards posted the Inquiry following the tenth race to review an incident approximately thirty yards out of the gate. #6 "AJS Kissntell" (A. Loza – 3rd) began drifting in causing #5 "Shake And Bake TR" (E. Nicasio – 4th) to take up. After speaking with the involved riders and examining the replay the Stewards felt "Shake And Bake TR" was definitely deprived the opportunity at a better placing. The vote was unanimous to disqualify and place him behind "AJS Kissntell."

GROOM JUAN FLORIAN IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* AND PLACED ON PROBATION FOR THE TERM OF HIS LICENSE FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1874 (DISORDERLY CONDUCT - INTOXICATED). FUTHER JUAN FLORIAN SHALL BE EVALUATED BY THE TRACK CHAPLAIN.

The above ruling was issued after meeting with groom Juan Florian to address his drunk in public charge. He explained that he was having personal problems addressing a recent death in his family. It was pointed out drinking was not the answer.

(2) FILMS

Jockey Adrian Loza was in to review the tenth race last evening in which his mount was disqualified. The Stewards felt that an adequate effort was made by Adrian and no further action was necessary.

(3) FOURTH RACE – INQUIRY – NO CHANGE

The Inquiry was posted following the fourth race to examine an incident at the start. #6 "Polar Country" (C. De Alba – 7th) broke in as #2 "Squeezed By" (O. Peinado – 3rd) broke out. Both #4 "Excalibur King SA" (R. Sanchez – 6th) and #5 "Beduinos Dynasty" (S. Mendez – 8th) were away slowly. After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing the films the Stewards voted to make no change in the original order of finish.
