Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of September 28, 2010 through October 3, 2010.

TUESDAY

09/28/2010 (1) DUTY STEWARD

Albert Christiansen will be present for morning duties and shall author the week's minutes.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Friday's program. Two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races make up the card.

WEDNESDAY

09/29/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

Two rider changes completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Saturday's program. Three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races, including the PCQHRA Breeder's Futurity, complete the card.

THURSDAY

09/30/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

Two rider changes and a lasix correction completed scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Sunday's program. Two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races make up the card.

FRIDAY

10/01/2010 (1) SCRATCHES

Three rider changes made up scratch time at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The tenth race on the card for maidens two years old, claiming price \$4,000, going 300 yards, was used open with five Cal-Breds in a nine-horse field.

(3) PURSE REDISTRIBUTION

RULING #104

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT BLOOD SAMPLE# 15653, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "MISSILE MISSILE," THE SECOND PLACE FINISHER IN THE THIRD RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON JULY 18, 2010, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL CLASS III) A PROHIBITED DRUG SUBSTANCE. IT IS ORDERED THAT "MISSILE MISSILE" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE (\$1,631) EARNED BY OWNER UGO DE LA TORRE, TRAINER UGO DE LA TORRE, JOCKEY DANIEL SANDOVAL BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY OCTOBER 31, 2010 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

ALL RECORDS ARE ORDERED TO REFLECT THIS RULING IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1956 (RACE DECLARED OFFICIAL), THIS RULING SHALL NOT AFFECT THE PARI-MUTUEL PAYOFFS.

This ruling was agreed upon after trainer De La Torre agreed to an informal hearing. The trainer is attempting a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and the hearing concerning his culpability was postponed.

(4) MENDEZ RULING

RULING #105

JOCKEY SANTIAGO MENDEZ IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2010.

Jockey Mendez missed his first mount last Sunday, resulting in this ruling. The rider's excuse was unacceptable.

(1) CAL-BRED REPORTS

The sixth race in the book for three year olds, claiming price \$5,000, going 300 yards, failed to fill Cal-Bred.

(2) MORALES RULING

RULING #106

JOCKEY WILBERTH MORALES IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2010.

This ruling was issued after jockey Morales called the Stewards and stated he did not have the call on a first time starter in the first race. After talking with the rider's agent, who had given the call, the above ruling was agreed upon.

(3) NINTH RACE – INQUIRY/ JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

After the finish of the ninth race (PCQHRA Breeder's Futurity – Grade I) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review the start. Also, Jockey Eduardo Nicasio, aboard the sixth place finisher #5 "Tr Eddie," claimed foul against the third place finisher #6 "First Down Illusion" (Jockey Rodrigo Aceves) for alleged interference at the start. After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to make no change in the order of finish. Replays show, at the start, #5 breaks slow as he stumbles slightly, #6 breaks in bumping #5, however, in the Stewards' opinion #5 is not cost the opportunity at a better placing.

Third race in the book, maidens fillies two years old, going 300 yards, failed to fill Cal-Bred.

(2) ANDRADE RULING

RULING #107

JOCKEY JUAN P. ANDRADE IS FINED ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)* FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE # 1872 (FAILURE TO FULFILL JOCKEY AGREEMENT) ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2010.

This ruling was agreed upon when Mr. Andrade missed his first mount Saturday evening. The rider cited traffic problems for being late.

(3) THIRD RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

After the finish of the third race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) the Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to review an incident shortly after the start. Involved were the winner #6 "The Big Dipper" (Jockey Joel Cruz) and the fifth place finisher #5 "Corona To Toast" (Jockey Alejandro Luna). After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the replays, the Stewards unanimously

agreed to disqualify #6 from first and place him fifth, behind #5, for interference shortly after the start. Replays show #6 drift into the path of #5, causing the latter to clip heels and lose the opportunity at a better placing.
