**ENTRY DAY**

Entries for racing for Saturday, May 5, 2018 were taken today in the racing office. Steward Scott Chaney was on hand to oversee matters. Eleven (11) races were drawn for this Kentucky Derby day card. Ninety-five (95) horses are scheduled to face Starter Jay Slender. First post will be 12:00 PM.

**POST TIME CHANGE**

Post time for the races will now switch back to 12:30 PM. Sundays had an 11:30 AM post time the last several weeks. Thursday, Friday and Saturdays had been at 12:00 PM. Racing on the Triple Crown days will remain at Noon.

**TYLER BAZE FILM REVIEW (REF: 4/29/18)**

Jockey TYLER BAZE appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the third race on Sunday, April 29, 2018. Jockey Baze was aboard #3 FOXTAIL who finished first but was disqualified and placed sixth for stretch interference. Inside the sixteenth pole of this one (1) mile turf race Jockey Baze uses his riding crop twice (left handed) while racing in first position. This action resulted in his mount bearing out and interfere with two (2) rivals to her outside, subsequently leading to a disqualification from first to sixth. Film review today shows Jockey Baze quickly straighten his mount after she left her straight course. In a unanimous decision Jockey Baze was excused from the informal hearing without penalty.

**FIFTH RACE STEWARDS' REVIEW**

Public Address Commentator Michael Wrona announced that a Stewards' Review would be conducted into the start of the fifth race which was conducted at one (1) mile on the main track. Of interest were the actions of sixth (last) place finisher #2 TAPITHA BONITA (Franklin Ceballos) who broke in the air. Apprentice Ceballos lost his left iron and was away very slowly. After a film review, that was broadcast to the public, the Stewards determined the horse received a fair start and a formal Stewards' inquiry was not needed.

**NADINE ANDERSON COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0071)**

Owner Nadine Anderson appeared in office today along with her attorney Mark Boykin (Woodland Hills CA). The complaint in matter reads as follows:

Owner Nadine Anderson is indebted to EF 1 Farms for board and care of (82) thoroughbred race horses. Total \$49,263.00.

Also present at the hearing were Horse Owner/Farm Owner Paul Brazeau and Eric Yohan Knipe, who is in the process of purchasing EF 1 Farm from Mr. Brazeau, and Bookkeeper Maria Delao. Owner Anderson, who previously managed the farm, recently removed several dozen of her horses from the farm. Former licensee Danny Alameda, who has been suspended for roughly 20 years, was mentioned as being involved in this matter, which was a highly contentious and complicated hearing. Mr. Knipe indicated he was taking action in civil court regarding other board bills and issues. After deliberation, the Stewards

recommended this matter be addressed in civil court. We subsequently dismissed this case without prejudice. Nadine Anderson, who we suspended for failing to appear in this matter before us (REF: 4/14/18<sup>1</sup>) was reinstated in the following ruling after appearing here today.

**LATS RULING #163**

Owner NADINE ANDERSON, having appeared for a hearing pertaining to California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – \$49,263.00 to EF1 Farms) is restored to good standing. Ruling LATS #139 issued at Santa Anita Park Winter/Spring Meet on April 14, 2018, is set aside.

**ERIC KRULJAC COMPLAINT (CASE NO. 18SA0046)**

The CHRB filed a complaint against Trainer ERIC KRULJAC for violation of CHRB Rule #1843.6 (D)(2)(Total Carbon Dioxide Testing), Rule #1887 (Trainer or Owner to Insure Condition of Horse), Rule #1843 (A)(D) (Medication, Drugs and other Substances) and 1843.1 (B) (Prohibited Drug Substances). The complaint in this matter reads as follows:

*On February 10, 2018 the horse 'Fortune of War' trained by Joseph Eric Kruljac finished seventh in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race at Santa Anita Race Track. The official blood sample #TC395083 was analyzed by U.C. Davis Laboratory and was found to contain the Class 3 drug 'Total Carbon Dioxide' (TCO2-40.8 Millimoles per liter). The permitted level is 37 millimoles per liter.*

CHRB Investigator Jim Hamilton was on hand to present a 38 page complaint packet. Michelle Derieg (Weinstein Court Reporters LLC) transcribed the proceedings. Included in the complaint packet was a 'SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND MUTUAL RELEASE'. This agreement is between Trainer Eric Kruljac and the California Horse Racing Board (Rick Baedeker-Executive Director & Chuck Winner-Chairman). Trainer Kruljac was not represented by counsel regarding this agreement. The Stewards will issue a ruling that memorializes the terms of this agreement on Sunday, May 6, 2018. More to follow.

**ASA ESPINOZA FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice Jockey ASA ESPINOZA appeared in our office along with his agent Brian Beach. The purpose of this informal hearing was to review Espinoza's use of the riding crop in yesterday's first race. He was aboard #5 MAGIC MUSKETIER who finished first in this one (1) mile turf event. Film review shows Espinoza use his riding crop four (4) consecutive times in the last sixty (60) yards after this race. Espinoza, who won two (2) races on the day's card, understood the reason behind the following unanimous decision.

**LATS RULING #164**

Apprentice Jockey ASA ESPINOZA is fined ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule 1688 (b)(6) (Use of Riding Crop – more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond), during the first race at Santa Anita Park on May 3, 2018.

**MATT GARCIA FILM REVIEW**

Jockey MATT GARCIA used his riding crop four (4) consecutive times while leaving the starting gate while aboard #4 AWE POLLONIA in the first race yesterday May 4. In this 4 ½ furlong race Jockey Garcia kept his hand on his right rein while striking his horse. There was no penalty issued as a group of Stewards and jockeys, at a recent meeting (REF:4/12/18(2)) agreed that penalties would not be issued if a jockeys' hand is still on a riding rein when going over the three (3) strike minimum. Other portions of 'the rule book' allow other avenues of enforcement regarding misuse of the riding crop.

**ANDREW LERNER RULING**

Yesterday May 4 Horseshoe Inspector Victor Tovar informed the Stewards that the ANDREW LERNER trained #6 RUN LIKE RHETT had arrived at the receiving barn wearing 'toe grabs'. These 'grabs' were filed down at the receiving barn prior to the fourth race to comply with Santa Anita's turf course shoe policy. In a unanimous decision the following penalty was issued.

**LATS RULING #165**

Trainer ANDREW LERNER who started the horse RUN LIKE RHETT in the fourth race at Santa Anita Park on May 4, 2018 is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1853 (Examination Required – improperly shod).

**BRYAN PENA RULING**

Jockey Agent Patty Sterling called the Stewards' office to inform us that one of her clients, Jockey BRYAN PENA would not be able to fulfill his riding commitment aboard #5 TAP THE WIRE in today's second race. She stated this was due to 'bad traffic' between San Luis Rey Downs Training Center and Santa Anita. This first time starter won this race with Jockey Matt Garcia. The purse was \$54,000. The Stewards issued the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #166**

Jockey BRAYAN PENA who was scheduled to ride #5 TAP THE WIRE in the second race on May 5, 2018 at Santa Anita Park is fined TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

**NICE CROWD**

An announced crowd of 26,151 attended the races on this Kentucky Derby day card. Today's first post was 12:00 p.m. Starter Jay Slender dispatched the field for the 11<sup>th</sup> race at 6:29 p.m. Total handle for the day was \$19,228,508.00.

**FIRST RACE INQUIRY**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign after viewing an incident involving 3 horses at the 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile marker of this 1 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile turf event. At this location first place finisher #1 TAMMY'S WINDOW (Tyler Conner) entered an opening between eventual third place finisher #3 PROUD 'N' READY (Joesph Talamo) and fourth place finisher #7 KITTY BOO (GB) (Stewart Elliott). Contact between these three (3) horses took place at this location. The opening was tight. #7 KITTY BOO (GB) appeared to drift out slightly and took the worse of the contact. #3 PROUD 'N' READY stepped in slightly. The Stewards watched all camera angles of the incident and spoke to all three (3) jockeys' involved. In a unanimous decision the Stewards' made 'no change' in the order of finish. For their involvement in the inquiry Jockey's Connor and Talamo were ordered to the Stewards' office for film review.

**ELEVENTH RACE STEWARDS REVIEW**

The Stewards announced that a Stewards' Review would be conducted in order to review the start of this race, which was contested at about 6 ½ furlongs on the Hillside Turf Course. Eventual seventh place finisher #2 BOB'S BAD BOY (Stewart Elliott) whipped its head and was off very slowly at dispatch. The assistant starter with this horse threw his hands in the air when the starting gate opened which helped the Stewards determine that this horse caused his own problems and that this horse was given a fair start. A formal Stewards inquiry was not conducted and the race was made official.

**EDWIN MALDONADO FILM REVIEW**

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in yesterday's (May 5) ninth race which was a hillside turf course event going the distance of about 6 ½ furlongs. After the field crossed the turf/dirt/turf transition Maldonado drifts out while aboard sixth place finisher #1 MAKE IT A TRIPLE. This action led to contact with eventual third place finisher #2 SO CONFLATED. #1 MAKE IT A TRIPLE was lugging out and Jockey Maldonado was using his riding crop instead of his reins attempting to avoid drifting out. Maldonado, who was not happy with having to attend this review, was excused with a 'warning'. This decision was unanimous.

**TYLER CONNOR FILM REVIEW (REF: 5/5/18<sup>7</sup>)**

Jockey TYLER CONNOR appeared in the Stewards' office to review his involvement in a Stewards' Inquiry in yesterday's (May 5) first race. Jockey Connor was aboard first place finisher #1 TAMMY'S WINDOW who split rivals, but not without contact in this 1 1/8-mile event. Jockey Connor made significant contact with fourth place finisher #7 KITTY BOO (GB) (Stewart Elliott) who stepped out slightly prior to the contact. #3 PROUD 'N' READY (Joseph Talamo) was also involved in what could be termed a three (3) horse inquiry. Jockey Connor was cautioned to avoid contact in the future and excused following this caution.

**MATT GARCIA FILM REVIEW**

Jockey MATT GARCIA was in our office to review his use of the riding crop while aboard #2 Mac McLovin, who finished sixth in yesterday's tenth race going 6 ½ furlongs on the main track. Jockey Garcia's use of the riding crop was questionable as he appeared to use it over 3 consecutive times. For the second time this week we issued a 'warning'.

**LANCE HELLUM RULING REF: (REF: 4/14/18 (2))**

Trainer LANCE HELLUM appeared in our office as requested for us to inform him of our decision involving an altercation that took place in the Santa Anita stable area on February 26, 2018 (REF: Case No.18SA0061). Santa Anita Stable Security Sgt. Michael Valadez and CHRIB Investigator James Hamilton were also present. Trainer Hellum was not pleased but respectful when informed of the ruling below, which was issued in a unanimous decision.

**LATS RULING #167**

Owner/Trainer LANCE HELLUM is suspended SEVEN (7) DAYS (May 21 to May 27, 2018) and fined FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00)\* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct – physical altercation) on February 26, 2018 at Santa Anita Park. Furthermore LANCE HELLUM is to adhere to the recommendation of the Winners' Foundation regarding anger management education, shall sign a testing agreement and is placed on probation while licensed with the California Horse Racing Board. Failure to do so will result in a suspension of all his licenses.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of LANCE HELLUM are suspended, LANCE HELLUM is prohibited from entering horses during the term of suspension, and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend and Fine), LANCE HELLUM is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**JOESPH TALAMO FILM REVIEW (REF: 5/5/18<sup>7</sup>)**

Jockey JOE TALAMO appeared in the Stewards' office to review his ride in the first race yesterday May 5. There was a Stewards' Inquiry in this race. Jockey Talamo was aboard #3 PROUD 'N' READY who finished third in this 1 1/8-mile race on the infield turf course. #3 PROUD 'N' READY was on the outside of a three (3) horse spread as these horses were

leading the pack in mid-stretch. Jockey Talamos' mount stepped in very slightly and played a part in interfering with eventual winner #1 TAMMY'S WINDOW (Tyler Conner). In a unanimous decision Jockey Talamo was issued a 'caution' and this informal hearing ended.

**NEW APPRENTICE JOCKEY**

Jockey Agent Nelson Arroyo brought a new apprentice jockey into the Stewards' office for us to meet. Eighteen (18) year old Heriberto Figueroa hails from Puerto Rico. He attended and graduated from the same jockey school that former top Apprentice Jockey Evin Roman attended. Apprentice Figueroa has won a total of eight (8) races. The Stewards handed Figueroa a copy of our jockey procedures and discussed the expectations of race riders here in Southern California.

**JOESPH ERIC KRULJAC RULING (REF: 5/4/18(2))**

Trainer ERIC KRULJAC appeared in our office to go over the terms of a Stipulated Agreement and Mutual Release that was agreed on between Mr. Kruljac and the California Horse Racing Board. The actual suspension days that Trainer Kruljac will served were discussed in detail prior to the Stewards issuing the following ruling.

**LATS RULING #168**

Owner/Trainer JOSEPH ERIC KRULJAC, who started the horse FORTUNE OF WAR that finished seventh in the third race at Santa Anita Park on February 10, 2018, having entered into a Settlement Agreement with the California Horse Racing Board is fined THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)\* and suspended for THIRTY (30) DAYS pursuant to California Horse Racing Board Rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1843.6 (d)(2) (Total Carbon Dioxide Testing – TCO2 level in excess of 37.0 [40.8] millimoles per liter). The suspension will be stayed for FIFTEEN (15) DAYS and JOSEPH ERIC KRULJAC will be placed on probation for ONE (1) YEAR subject to the terms and conditions of the Stipulated Agreement. Actual FIFTEEN (15) DAYS of suspension are to commence on May 13, 2018 through and including May 27, 2018.

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of JOSEPH ERIC KRULJAC are suspended, JOSEPH ERIC KRULJAC is prohibited from entering horses during the term of suspension, and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), JOSEPH ERIC KRULJAC is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

**EIGHTH RACE INQUIRY/OBJECTION**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign to view an incident in the final furlong of this one (1) mile allowance race on the turf course. The actions of the following horses were reviewed.

- #1 Achira (Mike Smith-1<sup>st</sup> Place)
- #6 Helen Hillary (Geovanni Franco-2<sup>nd</sup> Place)
- #8 Siberian Iris (IRE) (Flavian Prat-3<sup>rd</sup> Place)

There was also a jockey's objection in this race as Jockey Geovanni Franco (#6 HELEN HILLARY) lodged a 'claim of foul' against first place finisher #1 ACHIRA (Mike Smith). Inside the 1/16<sup>th</sup> pole #1 ACHIRA drifts out and takes #6 HELEN HILLARY (Geovanni Franco) off her straight course causing Jockey Franco to steady his horse. The margin between these two (2) rivals at the finish line was a ½ length. Third place finisher #8 SIBERIAN IRIS (IRE) was very mildly affected.

The Stewards viewed all camera replay angles, received a patrol judge report and spoke to the jockey involved. In a majority decision (Baker dissent-DQ 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>) the Stewards

allowed the original placings to stand believing that #6 was not cost the opportunity at a better placing. No change. Jockey Mike Smith was ordered to film review on our next racing day, May 10.
